

CRIME REPORT

Theft case solved; 3 arrested, 21 motorcycles, 10 smartphones recovered

KATHUA: Police on Saturday solved a theft case by recovering 21 Motorcycles and 10 smart mobile phones in connection with a theft case and three persons were arrested.
In the instance, an information in written was received on August 9, 2023 at Police Station Rajbagh from the complainant namely Balvinder Singh, son of Parkash Singh, resident of Gujrair Tehsil & Distt. Kathua regarding the theft of his vehicle. Upon receiving this information, FIR No. 211/2023, under section 379 IPC was registered at Police Station Rajbagh, and an investigation was set into motion. After the strenuous efforts of the police team headed by SHO Rajbagh Insp. Tariq Ahmed assisted by PSI Fazal Raja Dev and SI Sunil Kumar Thakur rounded up three suspects namely Vishal Kumar, son of Raj Kumar; Sukhvinder; son of Lovely Kumar and Abay, son of Lovely, all residents of Khanpur Tehsil Marheen Distt. Kathua, who confesses the crime, on their disclosure 21 Motorcycles and 10 smart mobile phones were recovered from different locations in the district. All the motorcycles and smart phones have been stolen from the jurisdiction of District Kathua and neighbouring District. Trio was arrested and 21 Motorbikes alongwith 10 Android Mobile Phones were recovered/seized whereas Investigation of the case is going on more recoveries and arrests cannot be ruled out.

3 notorious drug smugglers booked under PIT-NDPS Act

BARAMULLA: Acting tough against the drug smugglers and to eradicate the menace of drugs from the society, police in Baramulla have booked 03 most wanted & notorious drug smugglers under PIT-NDPS Act after obtaining formal detention orders from the competent authority.
The three accused drug smugglers identified as Khurshid Ahmad Bakshi son of Mohd Rafiq Bakshi resident of Watalpora Tangmarg, Fayaz Ahmad Wani son of Abdul Jabbar Wani resident of Dangerpora Baramulla & Bashir Ahmad Ganai son of Lt. Wali Mohd Ganai resident of Trikanjan Boniyar have been booked under PIT-NDPS Act after obtaining formal detention orders from the competent authority. The booked drug smugglers have been detained and subsequently lodged in Central Jail Kot-Balwal Jail Jammu.
Pertinent to mention here that many cases are registered against the said drug smugglers and they were involved in promoting drug abuse trade by supplying drugs

to local youth of Watalpora Tangmarg, Dangerpora, Heewan, Sheeri, Trikanjan Boniyar & other areas of District Baramulla. Despite their involvement in many FIRs, they did not mend their activities and were again involved in promoting drug abuse trade by supplying drugs to local youth.

6 drug peddlers arrested, contraband recovered

SRINAGAR: Continuing its efforts to eradicate the menace of drugs from the society, police have arrested 06 drug peddlers/smugglers in Baramulla & Budgam and recovered contraband substances from their possession.
In Baramulla, a police party led by SHO Police Station Baramulla under the supervision of DySP Hqrs Baramulla Shri Altaf Ahmad Khan-JKPS at a checkpoint established at Khanpora Baramulla intercepted a suspicious person who tried to flee from the spot but was apprehended tactfully by the alert police party. During search, 60 grams of Charas like contraband substance concealed in a bag was recovered from his possession. He has been identified as Ab Hameed Sheikh son of Ab Khaliq Sheikh resident of Boniyar.
Meanwhile, a police party led by SHO Police Station Baramulla under the supervision of DySP Hqrs Baramulla Shri Altaf Ahmad Khan-JKPS at a checkpoint established at Kralnar new Railway Station Crossing Baramulla intercepted a suspicious person who tried to flee from the spot but was apprehended tactfully by the alert police party. During search, 30 grams of brown sugar-like contraband substance concealed in a bag was recovered from his possession. He has been identified as Safan Shafi Zargar son of Mohammad Shafi Zargar resident of Kanispora Baramulla.
In Budgam, during cordon and search operation (CASO) at village Danseera, a police party from Police Station Beerwah apprehended 03 persons identified as Junaid Ahmed Dar son of Gh Mohi Din Dar resident of Danseera Beerwah, Adil Ahmed Ganaie son of Lt. Gh Ahmad Ganaie and Nasir Ali Dar son of Ali Mohd Dar both residents of Sonaph Beerwah Budgam. Upon their personal search, 50 sticks of charas like substance alongwith three (03) mobile phones were recovered from their possession.
Similarly, specific information was received by the Police Station Beerwah that one person namely Abdul Ahad Wani son of Mohammad Subhan Wani resident of Pethkote is dealing with drugs and has concealed Poppy straw in his cowshed and is about to relocate the same contraband for further distribution among youth of the area etc. Acting swiftly, a police party of PS Beerwah raided the said spot and during search 6Kgs of Poppy straw was recovered. Accused person was also arrested on the spot.
They have been arrested and shifted to police station where they remain in custody. Accordingly, cases under relevant sections of law have been registered at respective police stations and further investigation have been initiated.

Hardcore criminal 'Mansha' involved in attack on police, heroin supplying arrested

Duo was arrested and case FIR under sections 8/21/22/29/60 NDPS Act was registered against them in Police Station Gandhi Nagar.

Police seizes two unclaimed bikes, Court issues proclamation order

AKHNOOR: The Akhnoor Police have seized two unclaimed Motorcycles. Since no one reported to claim ownership of these bikes, two different proclamation notices have been issued by the Court of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Akhnoor under Section 102 Cr.P.C. CRPF jawan found dead inside camp

ASI dies of rabies 3 months after dog bite

BANIHAL: An Assistant Sub-Inspector (ASI) of the Jammu and Kashmir Police died of rabies on Friday, three months after being bitten by a dog in Ramban district, an official said.
ASI Mohammad Raffiq Naik, a resident of Perihinder-Neel area of Ramssoo, was diagnosed with rabies and succumbed to the disease, the officials said.
They said he was attacked by a stray dog while he was performing duty in Ramban town on May 11, trying to save commuters. At least 10 persons including Naik were bitten by the dog.
The body of the deceased was handed over to his family for last rites, the officials said.
