The Pharmacy Council of India which is the apex body entrusted with the mandate to regulate the practice and profession of Pharmacy in the country has undertaken the under reference correspondence with all the stake-holders. The contents of the communication are reproduced as under:

"This is to inform you that in continuation of the earlier Circular No. 14-56/2022-PCI (Approval Process for 2022-2023 a.s)/17710 dt. 08.02.2023 the institutions which have applied by paying the PERC charges for Academic Year 2023-24 were considered for extension of approval for the academic year 2023-24. The institutions which have not applied and not paid PERC charges will not be considered under this decision. The institution where the students have passed out without the approval of Pharmacy Council of India for the Academic Year 2023-24 shall not be considered for the State Pharmacy Council registration".

The matter is being circulated in the interest of stake-holders for necessary adherence and general information.

- For rest of the subjects of classes 11th & 12th, the syllabi shall remain unchanged.

Accordingly, the Question papers for Annual (Regular) examination shall be set as per new scheme of assessment/syllabi scheduled to be held in the month of March- April, 2024. 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Subject: - Fixation, Determination and Regulation of Fee of Private Schools in UT of J&K.

Order No: 03 FFRC of 2023

Dated: 10.08.2023

Whereas, the Committee for Fixation and Regulation of Fee of private Schools vide Order No.35 FFRC of 2021 dated 19-01-2021 directed all Private Schools of UT of J&K to Submit information as per the proforma available on Committees website [www.jkffrc.in](http://www.jkffrc.in) for approval of fee structure, within 30 days.

Whereas, the On the request of Private school Associations and individual schools the time period for submission of files was extended from time to time.

Whereas, various Private schools have submitted files for Fixation and regulation of fee. A good number of Private schools have not submitted files in response to earlier orders and are charging and making enhancement in fee structure on their own in violation of rules and regulations.

The Hon'ble the Supreme Court in case titled Islamic Academy of Education And... Vs state of Karnataka And others on 14 August 2003 in its Judgment at para 213 has held that " each educational institute must place before this committee, well in advance of the academic year its proposed fee structure. Along with the proposed fee structure all relevant documents and books of accounts must also be produced before the committee for their scrutiny. The Committee shall then decide whether the fees proposed by that institute are justified and are not profiteering or charging capitation fee. The Committee will be at liberty to approve the fee structure or to propose some other fee which can be charged by the institute. The fee fixed by the committee shall be binding for a period of three years, at the end of which period the institute would be at liberty to apply for revision. Once fee is fixed by the Committee, the institute cannot charge either directly or indirectly any other amount over and above the amount fixed as fees, if any other amount is charged, under any other head or guise e.g Donations the same would amount to charging of capitation fee."

This issue has already been dealt by the Hon'ble the Supreme Court in the case Modern School Vs Union of India reported 2004 SCC3 page 583. the relevant portion of the judgment is reproduced below :-

"The principles for fixing fee structure of particular institutions have, thus, been illustrated in T.M.A. Pai Foundation (supra) and Islamic Academy of Education (supra) but it must be borne in mind that these principles were laid down in absence of any statute operating in the field. Where, however, a statute operates in the field, regulation of education would be governed thereby. In this case, as the regulation of education is governed by a Legislative Act, the court cannot impose any other or further restrictions by travelling beyond the scope, object and purport thereof."

The Supreme Court in its judgment in case titled Indian School Jodhpur and another vs. State of Rajasthan and others decided on May 3<sup>rd</sup> 2021 (civil appeal No.1724 of 2021) para 19 observed that "After the Jurisprudential exposition, it is not open to argue that the Government cannot provide for external regulatory mechanism for determination of school fees or so to say fixation of 'just' and 'Permissible 'School fees at the initial stage itself."

Whereas the Government of Jammu & Kashmir notified the Jammu and Kashmir Private Schools (Fixation, Determination and Regulation of Fee) Rules, 2022 on 10th May 2022 vide S.O No 233.

Whereas, Rule 5(1) ( c) of Jammu and Kashmir Private Schools (Fixation, Determination and Regulation of Fee) Rules 2022, provides that "Require each Private school to place before the Committee the proposed fee structure of such school with all relevant documents and books of accounts for scrutiny within such date as may be specified by the Committee."

Whereas, the rule 8 (a) of the Jammu and Kashmir Private Schools (Fixation, Determination and Regulation of Fee) Rules 2022, provides that "the private school shall submit a proposal to the Committee on the proforma as may be prescribed by the Committee. The proposal for fixation, determination and regulation of fee for next year shall be submitted three months before the next academic year starts".

Now therefore, All those schools who failed to submit files for fixation and regulation of fee in response to earlier orders and whose fee structure has never been regulated by the Committee are provided final opportunity to submit their files along with documents as prescribed in the proforma including audited accounts of last three years by or before 30<sup>th</sup> September 2023.

The failure to submit requisite information in terms of Rule 8 (a) and 5(1) c will attract action in terms of Rule 8 d ( i), (ii), which is taken note of.

8 d (i). "The committee shall recommend to the appropriate authority to bar the private school from taking any new admission for next academic year or to impose a fine equivalent to 10 percent of total revenue generated by the Private school/society in the preceding year, as applicable";

8 d (ii). "In addition, the Committee may recommend to the appropriate authority for taking the following actions: (a) to take over the management of the private school until it submits a proposal and once the management of the Private school has been taken over, the Government shall appoint an administrator not below the rank of Sub-Divisional magistrate as administrative head of school to ensure its smooth functioning at the cost of schools fund. During this period, no further development / procurement / construction activities related to education and safety of children; (b) the appropriate authority may withdraw permission and the recognition of the Private school as per the procedure laid down".

All other schools who are regularly approaching the Committee for Fixation and Regulation of their Fee structure and whose fee structure stands regulated for Session(s) 2023-24, 2024-25 and 2025-26 shall adhere to the schedule provided under rule 8 (a) of the Jammu and Kashmir Private Schools (Fixation, Determination and Regulation of Fee) Rules 2022 for file submission.
