

# Court rejects pre-arrest bail of habitual thief

JAMMU: Additional Sessions Judge Doda Amarjeet Singh Langleh rejected the pre-arrest bail plea of habitual thief namely Aftab Hussain. Court after examination of police report which would show that on 01.08.2023, complaint in writing was lodged with respondent Police Station by Graduate Engineer, National Highway and Infrastructure Development Corporation Ltd, describing therein that on 20.07.2023 crash barriers, 20 in numbers, sign boards and delineators were stolen by some miscreants from National Highway falling within jurisdiction of respondent Police Station. Based on this complaint, FIR No. 10/2023 for offence under section 379 IPC was registered and investigation was started. During investigation, a person namely Mohd Mudasar was taken into custody and on his disclosure statement four crash barriers and 5 leg

poles were recovered from a place called Lal Pari, Marsoo. It also came to fore during investigation that petitioner herein runs a Kabard shop at Pul Doda and on whose behest crash barriers were stolen from National Highway which were allegedly concealed by petitioner. Further, as per police report petitioner is avoiding arrest in the case and notice under section 41-A of Cr.P.C has also been issued to him. Further, as per police report petitioner is also facing trial in another theft case which is sub-judice. According to investigating Officer present in the Court, petitioner has also moved a regular bail application and same is sub-judice in the Court of Ld. Addl. Special Mobile Magistrate Doda. Court after hearing both the sides observed that investigation indicates that petitioner runs a Kabard (serap) shop at Pul Doda. It is also unfolded that another accused namely Mudsar

Mohd and petitioner herein indulge in stealing crash barriers and poles from Assar to Ragi Nallah with impunity and sell the same as Kabard material. Petitioner is also facing trial in a theft case. He is not co-operating with the investigation either. And again petitioner has concealed the fact that he has also moved a regular bail before another Court. In these circumstance, grant of anticipatory bail to petitioner would not serve the ends of justice and instead a discouraging message would go to public that anticipatory bail is granted to likes of petitioner, who indulge in broad day theft mis-adventures and law does not breathe down the neck of such individuals. Investigating agency shall also hotfoot the investigation if it does not wish to lose public faith in the matter of broad day theft of crash barriers on National Highway. For all what is said hereinabove, this application has no merit and the same, therefore is dismissed.

Whereas, SRO 456 dated: 25.10.2017 provides for demarcation/delineation of water source/course.

Whereas, in pursuance to above said SRO, the Government has defined procedure as well as constituted committee vide Order No. 18-JK-(Rev) of 2022 dated: 04.02.2022.

Whereas, in continuation to above said order, Deputy Commissioner, Samba has constituted committee (s) at Sub-Divisional Level vide Order No. 33 of 2022 dated: 19.02.2022.

Whereas, Revenue department vide Govt. order No. 35-REV(S) of 2018 dated: 15.02.2018 under endorsement REV/S/158/2017 dated: 15.02.2018 accorded transfer of State land measuring 222 Kanals 17 marlas under Khassa nos. 136, 210, 211, 216, 222, 231, 234, 240 & 1348 situated at village Katli, District Samba, in favour of the Industries and Commerce Department, for establishment of Industrial Estate and only Khassa No. 1348 measuring 190 Kanal 05 Marla is entered as Gair-Mumkin khad in revenue record.

Whereas, Possession of land measuring 222 Kanal 17 Marla at revenue village Katli was handed over to General Manager, DIC, Samba vide possession letter No. DG/596 dated: 03.01.2020. General Manager, DIC Samba, further handed over its possession to General Manager, SIDCO and Manager, Estates, SIDCO Samba vide No. DICS/6209-12 dated: 03.01.2020.

Whereas, a team comprising of Executive Engineer FCD, Samba, Tehsildar Samba and field staff of FCS Samba, Revenue and Industries Department vide No. 1147 dated: 10.07.2023 submitted its report wherein it/they reported that Executive Engineer, FCD Samba has issued conditional NOC vide No. FCDS/2623-24/549-553 dated: 25.05.2023 to Industries department. The team member conducted local enquiry to seek history of status of flood behavior during the last 50 years over the subject land at village Katli. Statement of localities was recorded and it is mentioned in the statement that subject land is a seasonal water course and water flow is observed only during rainy season. Further, during 2014 floods the depth of the water in the khad was approximately 1 to 1.5 feet. The team recommended that preparation of DEM/hydrological model study may be dispensed off in case of land under Khassa No. 1348 at village Katli recorded as Gair Mumkin Khad in revenue record as it is a small khad having catchment of 3.72 Sq. Km.

Whereas, Executive Engineer, Flood Control Department, Samba vide No. FCDS/2023-24/1317-19 dated: 02.08.2023, reported that delineation/demarcation of water course for safe discharge of water through seasonal nallah in village Katli during rainy season, a detailed survey has been conducted including local enquiry from prominent citizens/PRI/s as there is no record of discharge/availability of flood data for Katli nallah/khad. The maximum expected discharge of Katli Khad/ Nallah (main) and its 2 No. tributaries (kassi) upstream of main nallah has been worked out on the basis of Empirical calculations, applying Dicken's formula by taking into account the catchment area of nallah/kassi, gradient etc. Tributary no. 1 has catchment area of approx. 1.10 sq. km. and proposed width of 10 meters average shall be sufficient to carry safe discharge during heavy rains. Tributary no. 2 has catchment of area of approx. 1.28 sq. km. and proposed width of 10 meters average shall be sufficient to carry its safe discharge during heavy rains. Tributary No. 1 & 2 merge in Katli nallah whose catchment area is about 3.7 Sq. Kms and width of 16 meter average is proposed for carrying safe discharge of water during high floods in main Katli nallah.

Whereas, joint spot visit was conducted by members of Sub-Divisional Level Committee headed by Assistant Commissioner, Revenue Samba on 15.07.2023, to ascertain the flood history of Gair Mumkin Khad of village Katli from PRIs, Senior Citizens and locals.

Whereas, on the basis of report of Flood Control Department, Khassa number wise report of inclusion/exclusion of area from/in water body was prepared by revenue field staff with the technical assistance provided by authorized consultants vide allotment No. FCDS/2022-23/331-40 dated: 31.05.2022, M/S K. S. Constructors Prop. Kuldeep Singh and some was discussed in a meeting by the Sub-Divisional level committee held on 02.08.2023. The committee recommended to issue public notice for seeking objections from general public, stakeholders and interested parties, if any. The detailed report signed by the members of Sub-Divisional level Committee is enclosed as Annexure-A.

Therefore, the report of committee in respect of village Katli, Nibhat Samba, Tehsil Samba is hereby uploaded on the official website of Deputy Commissioner, Samba (www.samba.jk.gov.in) as well as published in leading newspapers for seeking objections, if any. The objections shall be filed in writing in the office of ACR, Samba and Tehsildar Samba during the office hours within 15 days from publication of this public notice.
