
# SHRADHANJALI



# CRIME REPORT

## Two missing persons traced, reunited with families

JAMMU: Police on Tuesday traced two missing persons and reunited them with their families.

As per details, a written complaint was lodged at Police Station Miran Sahib by legal heirs of a missing person namely Rannik Singh, son of Tarlok Singh, resident of Makhanpur Gujjrian Simbal Morh Miran Sahib Teh RS Pura Distt Jammu stating that he went missing from his home. In this missing report on February 8, 2023 was registered and investigation started. After this, a team of Police Station Miran Sahib led by SDPO R S Pura Nikhil Gogna assisted by SHO Miran Sahib Insp Bopinder Singh did strenuous efforts and finally traced the missing person.

Similarly, another written complaint was lodged at Police Post Sarwal by legal heirs of a missing girl stating that she went missing from her home. In this regard, FIR. No. 73/2023 under sections 363/109 IPC was registered at Police Station Bakshii Nagar and investigation started.

After this, a team of Police Post Sarwal led by SDPO West Vikram Singh assisted by SHO Bakshii Nagar Insp Rakesh Sharma assisted by In-Charge Police Post Sarwal PSI Baljeet Singh Parihar did strenuous efforts and with the help of CCTV footages of the area finally traced the missing girl.

Subsequently families of both the missing persons were informed and the traced persons were handed over to their family members after completing all the legal formalities.

## Police restores lost purse to owner

As per details, a team of Police Post Bahu Fort Mandir while on patrolling duty found a purse containing cash Rs 7250 and other important cards etc. On this, a team led by In-Charge Police Post Bahu Fort Mandir SI Lekh Raj made announcements through Public Announcement system. Finally the lady owner of the purse after hearing the announcement came to the Police Post. After this the purse was handed over to the lady after proper verification of the details.

## Notorious criminal booked under PSA

MIRAN SAHIB: A notorious criminal was arrested and booked under Public Safety Act (PSA) by Miran Sahib Police.

As per details, an information was received through reliable sources regarding one notorious criminal namely Tajinder Singh alias Jinda, son of Darshan Singh, resident of Simbal Camp W.No 2 Miran Sahib Tehsil R.S Pura District Jammu who was evading his arrest in multiple cases including Narcotics and Arms Act etc.

On this, a team of Police Station Miran Sahib led by SDPO RS Pura Nikhil Gogna assisted by SHO Miran Sahib Insp Bopinder Singh raided at the suspected place and rounded up the said person. It is pertinent to mention that the accused was a notorious criminal and was involved in several heinous criminal cases including Narcotics, Arms Act etc and warrant of arrest was also issued against the said accused. Finally today the warrant has been executed and the accused got shifted to Central Jail Kot Bhalwal Jammu.

## Bovine smuggling attempt foiled; top bovine smuggler Shoomi arrested

SAMBA: Police on Tuesday arrested top bovine smuggler Mashoom Ali alias

"Shoomi", registered two FIRs and seized two vehicles in the jurisdiction of Police Stations Bari Brahmmana & Police Ghagwal.

Arrested top bovine smuggler has been identified as Mashoom Ali alias Shoomi, son of Haqam Din, resident of Paswar Sudh Mahadev, Tehsil Chenani, district Udhampur, at present Ramgarh district Samba. Bovine smuggling attempt has been foiled by Samba Police and two separate FIRs have been registered under relevant sections of law.

Notorious bovine smuggler Mashoom Ali nicknamed as "Shoomi" was operating from Ramgarh area of Samba district and had been indulging in illicit business of bovine smuggling from Samba to Kashmir for past five years. He was having several other smugglers to assist him in illegal bovine smuggling and was also owning a vehicle Tata Mahindra 207 bearing No. JK14E-3081 which was being used for the purpose of bovine smuggling. To escape from the eyes of police at naka points, "Shoomi" and his accomplices used to load bovine animals in the vehicle covered by the fodder thereby committing cruelty to animals.

## Drug smugglers' illegally acquired property attached

SRINAGAR: New Delhi authorities (SAFEM (FOP) A & NDPSA) confirmed attachment of drug smugglers' illegally acquired property, following Baramulla Police orders

As per details, On June 27, 2023, a party of Police Station Pattan attached an under construction house on land measuring 10 marlas at Main Mohalla Pattan belonging to drug Smuggler namely Barkat Ali Main son of Mohammad Maqbool Main resident of Mian Mohalla Pattan after obtaining legal sanction from competent authorities. The said house was linked to case FIR No. 84/2023 under section 8/22 NDPS Act of Police Station Pattan. Similarly, another Police party of PS Kreeri attached vehicle (Hyundai i10) bearing registration number DL2AE-2820 belonging to Abdul Rehman Malik son of Ghulam Mohd resident of Kalantra Payeen after obtaining legal sanction from the competent authorities. The said vehicle was linked to case FIR No 33/2023 under section 8/20, 29 NDPS Act of Police Station Kreeri. The investigations proved that the said movable/ immovable properties were gained from illicit trafficking by the drug Smugglers.

Simultaneously, these attachment of property orders of Baramulla Police was referred to Competent Authority & Administrator Smugglers and Foreign Exchange Manipulators (Forfeiture of Property Act, 1976 and Narcotics Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 & Prohibition of Benami Property Transactions Act 1988 New Delhi and same was approved in terms of clause (g) of section 68B of the NDPS Act.

The confirmation order so received regarding attachment of properties from SAFEM (FOP) A & NDPSA, New Delhi has boosted the morale of Police officers who are acting tough against the drug smugglers and drug trafficking in the district.

Moreover, orders regarding attachment of other properties falling within the ambit proceeds of narcotics, shall be forwarded to SAFEM (FOP) A & NDPSA, New Delhi for confirmation in near future.

## Police freezes two bank accounts of a notorious drug peddler

BANDIPORA: Police have frozen two bank accounts having savings of Rs 23,174 belonging to a notorious drug peddler namely Irshad Ahmad Wani son of Habib Ullah Wani resident of Bangar Mohalla Hajin under NDPS Act. All these savings were illegally acquired through the sale of narcotic drugs.

Moreover, Police along with Excise Department carried out Bhung destruction drive in village Buthoo & its adjacent areas in the jurisdiction of PS Bandipora and destroyed Bhung cultivation on 03 Kanals of forest land.

## Man killed after being hit by train

Sources said that, deceased has been identified as Rajan Pandit, son of Sonu Pandit, resident of lower Birpur Bari Brahmmana. He was hit by Sambalpur train as his body was found on the track near Bari Brahmmana on Tuesday. Railway police shifted his body to mortuary room of Government Medical College hospital Jammu for legal formalities. Police have taken cognizance of the matter and started further investigations.

## Two youths attacked with sharp weapons

VIJAYPUR: Two youths were attacked with sharp-edged weapons at Ramgarh road market in Vijaypur.

Sources said that, on Tuesday, afternoon, some unknown persons attacked on two local youths at Ramagrh road Vijaypur with sharp edge weapons and flee from the spot. Both received multiple injuries and were immediately shifted to Vijaypur hospital. After necessary treatment, doctors referred them to Government Medical College and Hospital Jammu for further treatment.

The injured have been identified as Sahil Kumar (26) resident of Vijaypur and Gotam Kumar, (25) resident of Gagore. A case has been registered in this regard by Vijaypur police and investigation has been started.

## Absconder evading arrest for last 2 years nabbed

REASI: Police on Tuesday arrested an absconder who was evading his arrest for last 2 years.

As per details, District Police Reasi apprehended one absconder, who was evading arrest since 2021. Absconder namely Deepak Kumar, son of Thoru Ram, resident of Laiter Tehsil Pouni, Distt Reasi absconding since 2021 in FIR No. 42/2021 under section 279/337/338 IPC 3/181 MV Act of Police Station Pouni was arrested by party of Police Station Pouni. The arrest was made by a team led by SHO Pouni, Insp. Purab Singh under the supervision of DySP HQ Reasi, Neeraj Padyar.

Accused person evaded arrest by disguising and changing locations and couldn't be apprehended since registration of Case FIR against him.

During investigation case was proved & chargesheet produced against him in court of law in the year 2021. Court of Additional Special Mobile Magistrate Reasi has issued a General Warrant of Arrest against him.

## 9 vehicles involved in illegal mining seized

POONCH: In a joint operation, the Department of Mining and police seized 9 vehicles involved in illegal mining.
