Army retrieves body of man washed away in Munawar Tawi

Notorious drug peddler booked under PSA

REASI: Continuing Nasha Mukat Reasi Abhiyaan and in another major strike on drug peddlers District Police Reasi booked and detained one more notorious drug peddler of Reasi under PSA and lodged him in District Jail Amphalla, Jammu. Suraj, son of Indru, resident of Vill. Serwad, Katra Distt. Reasi who was involved in drug peddling case FIR No. 69/2022 under section 8/20/25 NDPS Act and FIR No. 189/2023 U/S 8/20 NDPS ACT of P/S Katra was detained under PIT NDPS Act under the orders of Divisional Commissioner Jammu vide order no. PITNDPS 28 of 2023 dated 19.08.2023.

Besides booking under NDPS Act a number of times he was warned to shun the path of supplying drugs to the youth of Katra & Reasi. However he remained on con-

tinuous mission of minting money by supplying banned drug to youth of Reasi and Katra. In view of his continuous involvement in drug peddling and to save the health and welfare of the people it was necessary to book him under stringent law.

On the directions of Amit Gupta JKPS Senior Superintendent of Police Reasi his dossiers for PSA were prepared and after getting necessary detention order from Sh. Ramesh Kumar Divisional Commissioner Jammu, Suraj was arrested by the team of Police Station Katra led by Insp. Nishant Gupta and SDPO Katra Surinder Singh under the Supervision of Sh. Vipin Chandran SP Katra. He was lodged in District Jail Amphalla, Jammu. It is pertinent to mention here that Reasi Police booked 63 drug peddlers in 50 NDPS cases registered during first 8 months of this year.

Police destroys wild cannabis

11 missing persons including 8 females traced

SAMBA: Under the guidance of Senior Superintendent of Police Samba Benam Tosh, police has traced 11 more persons including eight females from different areas of Punjab & Jammu and reunited them with their families.

The family members of three missing girls, five missing married young women and three missing men had approached police to trace and reunite them. Accordingly, Police took the cognizance into the incidents of disappearances. Missing reports were registered at concerned Police Stations & Police Posts and strenuous efforts were made by police to trace them expeditiously. By the dint of hard work, Police succeeded in recovering missing persons from different areas of Punjab including TaraGarh, Ludhiana, Moga & Jammu and reuniting them with their families.

The missing reports with regard to their missing were entered at Police Station Ramgarh, Police Station Bari Brahmana, Police Post Supwal and Police Post Mansar.

The missing persons have been traced by the police teams headed by SHO Police Station Samba Rajeshwar Singh, SHO Police Station Ramgarh Sudesh Kumar and SHO Police Station Bari Brahmana Sunil Sharma under the supervision of DySPGaru Ram, SDPO Vijaypur Rohit Kumar, SDPO Bari Brahmana Rahul

Nagar and Addl. SP Samba Surinder Choudhary.

Senior Superintendent of Police Samba Benam Tosh said that 78 missing persons including 55 females have been traced and reunited with their families by Samba Police in past seven months and police is working hard with sincerity to recover missing persons within shortest possible period.

4 vehicles seized, 4 persons arrested for illegal mining

BARAMULLA: Acting tough against the persons involved in illegal extraction and transportation of minerals, police have seized 04 vehicles and arrested 04 persons in Baramulla.

A Police party under the supervision of SDPO Pattan Shri Mohd Nawaz-JKPS led by Incharge Police Post Palhallan seized 2 tractors and arrested 2 drivers identified as Mehrhaj Uddin Dar son of Abdul Aziz Dar resident of Poshwari Naidkhai & Fayaz Ahmad Baba son of Ghulam Mohd Baba resident of Loribal Naidkhai at Dargam Palhallan, for their involvement in illegal extraction and transportation of minerals.

Similarly, Police under the supervision of SDPO Tangmarg Shri Intiaz Ahmed-JKPS assisted by SHO PS Tangmarg seized 2 Tippers and arrested 2 drivers identified as Shahid Ahmad Rather son of Gh Nabi resident of Gani Baba & Ab Rashid Sheikh son of Ab Gani resident of Hajibal involved in illegal extraction and transportation of minerals at Shrai Tangmarg.

Accordingly, cases under relevant sections of law have been registered in respective police stations and investigation have been initiated.

Drug peddler arrested, contraband substance recovered

KULGAM: Continuing its efforts to eradicate the menace of drugs from the society, police have arrested a drug peddler in Kulgam and recovered contraband substance from his possession.
