Excise department destroys 1,050 Kg lahan

NOWSHERA : Excise Department destroyed 1050kg Lahan in forest area's of Nowshera Tehsil during different raids carried out to arrest the menace of illicit liquor in Excise Subrange Rajouri.

On the directions of Excise Commissioner, Pankaj Kumar Sharma and supervision of Deputy Excise Commissioner (Executive) Kusum Sharma and under the direct supervision of Narinder Singh Excise and Taxation officer Excise range Rajouri -Poonch, a team of Excise subrange Rajouri led by ETO and along with Inspector Mohd. Parvez and Excise guard Mohd Azeem Bashir Khan and Niayamatullah conducted series of raids at Chowki Handan Noyal Gohra, Androth and Forest areas of tain mahal and adjoining areas of Tehsil Nowshera. In the process 1050kg of Lahan raw material which is highly hazardous and injurious to health, recovered from state land and later destroyed on spot.

People duped by Hablas-e-Commerce Pvt. Ltd. Rajouri CB Jammu presents charge-sheet against 7 accused in Rs.13.84 Crore fraud case

JAMMU: Economic Offences Wing - CB Jammu Charge-sheeted 7 fraudsters for swindling Rs.13.84 Crore from the gullible people belonging to the Pirpanjal area (Rajouri-Poonch) in case FIR No. 76/2019 U/S 420, 120-B / RPC P/S Rajouri (Now Crime Branch Jammu). 1160 pages charge-sheet has been produced before the Court of law for judicial determination after allegations of involvement against the owner and other employees of Hablas-e-Commerce Pvt. Ltd. Rajouri in the commission of fraud were substantiated during the Investigation conducted by the premier Investigating Agency of the UT of J&K. In the garb of Company, the owner and its employees induced the complainant and other innocent people to deposit money with the promise that the company would double their invested money within a period of 15 days. Charge-sheet has been produced against the accused include Tariq Mehmood, son of Mohd Aziz, resident of Chhungan Mendhar, Poonch (Owner); Mohd Tayab Chowdhary, son of Mohd Bashir Naseem, resident of Panhad, Tehsil Kotranka, Rajouri; Sajjad Ahmed, son of Jaan Mohd, resident of Chambhar Tehsil Kotranka, District Rajouri; Syed Israr Shah Bukhari, son of Jameel Hussain Shah, resident of Bahrote, Tehsil Tahnamandi District Rajouri; Mohd Shairaz alias Shairaz Mir, son of Mohd Rafiq, resident of Village Ujhan Kastian Tehsil Darahall District Rajouri at present Atti Rajouri; Murtaza Mohd, son of Mohd Bashir R/o Chak Banola Mendhar District Poonch and Intiaz Ahmed, son of Mohd Aziz, resident of Chhungan Mendhar District Poonch.

The case was initially registered with Police Station Rajouri on the complaint lodged by Vishal Sudan, son of Tirath Ram, resident of Rajouri on allegations of cheating and fraud committed by the Hablas-e-Commerce Pvt. Ltd. Rajouri after he and other innocent people were induced and cheated by the Company with a false promise of doubling their invested money within a period of two weeks. The case being of immense Public Importance was transferred to Crime Branch Jammu for indepth probe. During investigation the case was thoroughly examined, recorded statements of the complainants and other important witnesses as well as the aggrieved people, seized records including ledgers, receipts, gifts, vehicles (Scorpio) worth Rs 14 Lakh, recovered Rs. 2. 82 Lakhs gathered scientific and circumstan-

tial evidence to substantiate the allegations and charges were proved against the culprits.

6 drug smugglers arrested, contraband substances recovered

BARAMULLA/KULGAM: Continuing its efforts to eradicate the menace of drugs from the society, police on Wednesday arrested 6 drug smugglers in Baramulla and recovered contraband substances from their possession.

A police party led by SHO Police Station Pattan during Naka checking at Nehalpora Cheeksari Pattan intercepted a suspicious person who tried to flee from the spot but was apprehended tactfully. During search, 14Kgs of Poppy Straw was recovered from his possession. He has been identified as Sartaj Ahmad Mir son of Gh Rasool Mir resident of Nehalpora Cheeksari. He has been arrested and shifted to police station where he remains in custody.

Similarly, Police led by SHO PS Baramulla arrested 02 drug smugglers identified as Aijaz Ahmad Gojree son of Abdul Rehman resident of Jalal Sahib Baramulla & Shahid Manzoor Dar son of Manzoor Ahmad resident of Mir Sahib Baramulla during naka checking at Ushkara Crossing who tried to flee but were apprehended tactfully. During search, 20 grams of Brown Sugar like substance was recovered from their possession. They have been shifted to police station where they remain in custody.

Moreover, a police party under the supervision of SDPO Pattan Shri Mohd Nawaz-JKPS assisted by IC PP Mirgund arrested drug smuggler identified as Shabir Ahmad Wani son of Jalal-ud-din Wani @Hubba resident of Singhpora Pattan during naka checking at Jheel Bridge Singhpora Pattan. During search, 168 capsules of SpasmoProxvion Plus was recovered from his possession. He has been shifted to police station where he remains in custody.

Accordingly, cases under relevant sections of law have been registered in respective Police Stations and investigations has been initiated. Police also arrested 02 drug peddlers in Kulgam and recovered contraband substances from their possession.

A police party led by SHO Police Station Kulgam at a checkpoint established at Adapora Crossing intercepted a vehicle (Santro Car) bearing registration No. JK13C-4261 with two persons on board. During search, 10.9Kgs of Poppy Straw like substance, 01 digital weighing machine and cash amount of Rs 13,500/- (pertains to the proceeds of narcotic substances) were recovered from the said vehicle.

The duo has been identified as Bashir Ahmad Khar son of Ghulam Mohammad Khar resident of Qaimoh and Umer Rashid Makroo son of Abdul Rashid Makroo resident of Rahpora, Qaimoh. They have been arrested and shifted to police station where they remain in custody. Vehicle used in commission of crime have also been seized.

Accordingly, a case vide FIR No. 150/2023 under relevant sections of law has been registered in Police Station Kulgam and investigation has been set into motion.

4 notorious drug smugglers booked under PIT-NDPS Act

BARAMULLA: Acting tough against the drug smugglers and to eradicate the menace of drugs from the society, Police have booked 4 most wanted & notorious drug smugglers under PIT-NDPS Act in Baramulla after obtaining formal detention orders from the competent authority.

The four accused drug smugglers namely Mohd Naseer Bhatti son of Nazir Din, Mohd Riyaz Khanday son of Mohd Sharif both residents of Madiyan Kamalkote Uri, Mohammad Hafeez Abassi son of Abdul Rashid & Zahid Hussain Abassi son of Sajawal Khan both residents of Gawhalta Uri have been booked under PIT-NDPS Act after obtaining formal detention orders from the competent Authority. The booked drug smugglers have been detained and subsequently lodged in Central Jail Kot-Balwal Jammu.

It is pertinent to mention here that many cases are registered against these drug smugglers and were involved in promoting drug abuse trade by supplying drugs to local youth of Madiyan Kamalkote, Gawhalta Uri & other areas of District Baramulla.

Despite their involvement in many FIRs, they did not mend their activities

and were again involved in promoting drug abuse trade by supplying drugs to local youth.

Police carries Wild Cannabis destruction drive

Police files chargesheet against two top female heroin smugglers

SAMBHA: Police on Wednesday filed chargesheet in the court of law against two top female heroin smugglers --- "Noori" and "Tuna" of BaloleNallah Bari Brahmana, Samba in NDPSA case. Noori, wife of Wali Mohd alias Gulla, resident of BaloleNallah Bari Brahmana and Juna Bibi alias Tuna, wife of Abdul Rashid alias Bagu, resident of Balole Nallah Bari Brahmana were among the top female heroin smugglers who used to supply deadly heroin to the drug peddlers and individual addicts of Samba, Jammu, Udhampur, Kathua, Reasi, Rajouri, Poonch,Doda, Ramban, Kishtwar and even Kashmir: Noori and Tuna used to collect heroin consignment from Punjab. They had established hideouts at BaloleNallah and used to operate from there. After the changed strategy of Samba Police, Noori and Tuna had been indulging in illicit heroin trafficking during midnight hours under the cover of darkness to escape from clutches of Police. But, Samba Police had succeeded in seeing through their changed modus-operandi and had succeeded in arresting them. During the course of investigation, it came to fore that Noori and Tuna were also involved in abetting, conspiring harbouring and financing illicit narco-trafficking. Noori and Tuna were arrested by SHO Bari Brahmana Sunil Sharma under the supervision of SDPO Bari Brahmana Rahul Nagar and Addl. SP Samba SurinderChoudhary. Senior Superintendent of Police Samba Benam Toshi said that besides thirteen female heroin smugglers arrested by Samba Police, some more female smugglers are wanted in NDPS cases and they would be arrested shortly.

Notorious bovine smuggler, drug peddler booked under PSA

DODA: In a significant move aimed at maintaining public order, District Magistrate Doda, Vishesh Mahajan has issued an order for the detention of an individual under the J&K Public Safety Act 1978 on the basis of the dossier prepared by the district police against him. The decision comes in response to persistent concerns regarding the individual's involvement in a series of unlawful and criminal activities, posing a threat to the peace and tranquility of the region. The order, based on a thorough review of a dossier submitted by the Senior Superintendent of Police, reveals a disturbing pattern of behaviour of the individual, including his involvement in theft, illegal bovine smuggling, and drug peddling. The individual's activities have not only led to a heightened sense of insecurity among local residents but have also raised communal tensions in this sensitive district. Despite previous encounters with the law, the individual continued to escalate his involvement in criminal activities, particularly in drug peddling, posing a severe risk to the well-being of the district's youth and society at large. This consistent engagement in criminal behaviour left the authorities with no choice but to invoke the J&K Public Safety Act to ensure the safety and peaceful coexistence of all citizens in the district. The decision to detain the individual, whose identity remains undisclosed for privacy reasons, was made to safeguard the region from further disturbances and to protect the community from the perils of drug addiction. The administration's commitment to maintaining law and order, preventing crime, and ensuring the well-being of its citizens remains paramount in this challenging situation. The duration of the individual's detention will be determined by an Advisory Board, following the provisions outlined in the J&K Public Safety Act. This decisive action by the District Magistrate underscores the administration's dedication to create a secure and prosperous environment for all residents of District Doda.

It was informed that some more such dossiers are being considered to ensure that the District remains peaceful and drugs free.
