


SHRADHANJALI



Cheating case solved, 138 bags of duplicate cement seized

AKHNOOR: Police on Thursday solved a cheating case and seized 138 bags of duplicate cement from a shop.

As per the details, a complaint was lodged at Police Station Akhnoor by one person namely Sudershan Sharma, son of Ramesh Chander, resident of 40 Sawitri Nagar South Delhi (Manager brand protection Iris unit no.11051106 tower-B Unitech Cyber Park Gurugram Haryana) regarding sale of duplicate cement of ultra tech company in Akhnoor area.


In this regard, FIR No.240/2023 under section 420 IPC was registered at Police Station Akhnoor and investigation started. After this, a team of Police Station Akhnoor led by SDPO Akhnoor Mohan Sharma assisted by SHO Akhnoor Insp Zabeer Mushtaq did strenuous efforts and raided at different shops in Akhnoor area and recovered 138 bags of duplicate ultra tech cement bags from Choudhry Traders shop Akhnoor.

Duplicate cement bags were seized on the spot in presence of Executive Magistrate.

Narco smuggler nabbed, heroin recovered

JAMMU: Continuing its drive against drug trafficking and substance abuse, Police on Thursday nabbed a narco smuggler and recovered 6.10 grams of heroin from his possession.

During search 6.10 grams of heroin was recovered from the possession of accused later identified as Shabir Ahmad alias Shoqat, son of Mohd Shafi, resident of Chanderkote near CRPF Camp (Ramban) at present, Jammu.

FIR No. 122/2023 under sections 8/21/22 NDPS Act has been registered at Police Station Kanachak.

Conductor injured, driver missing after accident

KISHTWAR: A conductor of a mini-bus was injured and the driver was reportedly missing after the vehicle rolled down in a gorge on Gulabgarh-Kundail road in Padder.

Though immediately rescue operation was launched and the injured conductor was retrieved from the gorge but the driver could not be traced. A search operation by Police was launched to trace him.

One dead, five injured due to electrocution

Youth drown while taking bath in Tawi river

As he jumped over the bridge in Tawi river to take bath, he went missing. As soon as the information about his disappearance was received, the local people, his family reached, police and SDRF team reached the spot and started searching for him.
