CRIME REPORT

12 vehicles involved in illegal Mining seized

JAMMU: District Mineral Officer, Dr. Gulshan Kumar, leading a team of the Mining Department seized eight vehicles engaged in illegal excavation and transportation of minerals from different parts of Jammu District.

An excavator (JCB), bearing registration number JK02CP7354 and a tractor trolley, registered under JK02CV9720, was seized at Kathar and handed over to the In-Charge of the Police Post Chowki Chour.

Similarly, a tractor trolley, identified by chassis number JZUDU516492S3, was confiscated in the Kangar Ring Road area and transferred to the SHO of the Police Station Gharota, while a dumper with the registration number JK02BU9287 was seized at Sangani Maira Mandrian and handed over to the SHO, Police Station Akhnour.

Two tractors with trolleys, bearing chassis numbers MBNGAALDBNR-JO4602 and RNJJ2GCA5461, were seized in the Surya Chack area and promptly delivered to the In-Charge of the Police Post Phalian Mandal. Additionally, two tractor trolleys were confiscated in Khandwal Chatha and placed under the custody of the In-Charge of the Police Post Chatha.

Furthermore, during the operations in Kathar and Maira Mandrian, authorities discovered illegal stockpiles of sand totaling 500 metric tons and 200 metric tons of boulders. The individuals involved in this illicit activity received stern warnings, cautioning them against further engagement in the illegal stocking and dumping of minerals.

Geology and Mining Department also seized 4 vehicles involved in illegal mining activities 2 each in Karara area & Thathri area of sub-division Thathri.

District Mining Officer (DMO) Sunil Kumar Manhas under the supervision of Deputy Commissioner, Vishesh Mahajan, on the strict instructions of SSP Abdul Qayoom, orchestrated the operation with the cooperation of SHO Thathri Amit Katoch. The entire seizure operation was meticulously executed in accordance with the laws outlined in the Mineral Act.

Two drug peddlers nabbed with 990 intoxicating capsules, over 2 Kgs Ganja

JAMMU: Continuing its drive against drug trafficking and substance abuse, Police on Monday nabbed two drug peddlers and recovered 900 psychotropic capsules, 2 Kgs of ganja and 1000 polythene bags from their possession.

As per details, a team of Police Post Rehari led by SDPO North Sunil Kumar Kesar assisted by SHO Pacea Danga Insp. Sushil Kumar and In-Charge Police Post Rehari PSI Anil Kumar while on Naka duty near petrol pump at T Chowk Amphalla rounded up two suspected persons Sunil Kumar alias sunny, sos of Yash Pal, resident of Housing colony Udhampur and Jatun, son of Surjeet Singh, resident of Bapoli District Panipat Haryana at present rented at Paharganj Katra.

During search 700 capsules i.e 700 capsules of (Tramadol) tramadex, 462 grams of ganja and one bundle of plastic poly bag containing 500 plastic polybags having 3*3" inch size of each plastic polybags inside the brown colour carrying bag recovered from the possession of accused namely Jatun. Moreover 1 kg 600 gram of ganja, 200 capsules of tramadex (Tramadol) psychotropic like substance, 90 capsules of pregabalin and one bundle of plastic polybags having 500 plastic polybags inside the bundle having 3*3" inch size of each plastic polybag also recovered from the possession of another accused namely Sunil Kumar.

Duo was arrested and FIR No. 112/2023 under sections 8/20/21/22/29 NDPS Act was registered at Police Station Pacea Danga Jammu.



Man arrested with 150 banned Chinese Manja

JAMMU: Police on Monday nabbed a man and recovered 150 banned Chinese Manja (Gattu) from his possession.

As per details, an information was received at Police Post Narwal regarding one person selling banned synthetic threads for sale in the area. On this, a team of Police Post Narwal led by SDPO East Syed Zaheer Abbas Jafari assisted by SHO Bahu Fort Insp. Shiv Dev Singh and In-Charge Police Post Narwal SI Lalit Sharma while on patrolling duty when reached at transport Nagar rounded up a suspected person who was selling banned synthetic threads at his shop No 271 yard No 06 transport Nagar Narwal. During search, 150 Chinese Manja (Gattu) were recovered from his possession which is banned vide DM Jammu order No. DMJ/LO/22-23/8943 dated 21.07.2022.

In this regard, case FIR no 259/23 U/S 188 crpe got registered at PS Bahu Fort and accused got arrested. The arrest was made in violation of DM order regarding ban on sale of plastic/synthetic threads (manja). The arrested person was later identified as Vijay Kumar, son of Babu Ram, resident of Ramgarh.



16 absconders declared as proclaimed offenders, property of two attached

DODA: Acting tough against the wanted absconders, Doda Police has launched a special drive against the absconders/ wanted criminals and on the proceedings of Doda Police (16) absconders wanted in various cases of heinous nature were declared as proclaimed offenders by the orders of Hon'ble Court and additional property of two absconders after declaring their proclamation was attached by the orders of Hon'ble Court.

Pertinent to mention here that property (land) measuring 12 Kanals and 18 Marlas situated at Mugal Maidan Kishtwar belonging to proclaimed offender namely Lal Din son of Noor Din resident of Dul Mugal Maidan (District Kishtwar) has been attached for his involvement in FIR No. 10/2018 registered against him at PS Dessa wherein he was absconding. Property (land) measuring 4 Kanals 2 ½ Marlas situated at village Phagsoo Thathri belonging to proclaimed offender and hardcore terrorist namely Abdul Rashid son of Arsulla Khanday resident Khanpura Tehsil Phagsoo District Doda presently in PAK/POK was attached for his involvement in FIR No. 23/1997 registered against him in PS Thathri.

In place to mention here that most wanted absconders and hardcore terrorists whose proclamation was ordered by the Hon'ble Court on the proceedings initiated by Doda Police are (1) Mohd Amin @ Khubaib son of Dawood Bhat resident Kathawa Tehsil Phagsoo District Doda and (2) Mohd Ashraf son of Shamas Din resident of Kakoo Tehsil Gandoh District Doda who are also presently in PAK/POK. These terrorists after joining militancy in early nineties and remaining involved in terror related incidents like attack on civilians, security forces, arson had ex-filtrated to PAK/POK and are still there.

Apart from the above, the other absconders who were also wanted in various cases of heinous nature and were declared as proclaimed offenders on the proceedings initiated by Doda Police were Irshad Bashir son of Bashir Ahmed Sheikh resident of Batote A/P Nagar Bhaderwah; Ram Singh son of Dalair Singh resident of Punakar Tehsil Gundna District Doda; Parshotan Sing son of Paras Ram resident of Draman Thanoote Tehsil Rajgarh District Ramban; Parman Singh son of Krishan Singh resident of Mandole Tehsil Kastigarh District Doda; Balbir Singh son of Doulat Ram resident of Kellar Bhaderwah; Rattan Singh son of Swami Raj resident of Choundary Tehsil Bhalla; Sajjad Ahmed son of Ghulam Mohd Bhat resident of Chilli Pingal; Ankush Kumar son of Satpaul resident of Chirya Tehsil Thathri; Shah Din alias Saleem son of Abdul Majeed Bhat resident of Trankal Tehsil Kahara District Doda; Shah Din son of Paqeer Mohd resident of Trankal Tehsil Kahara; Bashir Ahmed son of Mohd Mussa Gujjar resident of Malath Tehsil Chilli Gandoh; Ghulam Qadir son of Mehar Bakash Gujjar resident of Malath Kuti Gehsil Gandoh.

It will not be exaggerated to say that Doda Police is in process of initiating proceedings under section 82/83 CrPC against other local terrorists who have

remained involved in terror related activities in District Doda during militancy in the past and presently in PAK/POK wherefrom they are now alluring the local youth of the District through virtual mode to joint terror fold and revive militancy in District Doda.

DC Udhampur's operator killed in road mishap

UDHAMPUR: The wireless operator of Deputy Commissioner Udhampur was killed in a road accident at NH-44 near Sangoor Chowk on Monday.

Woman's suspicious death, husband booked

JAMMU: Pacea Danga police have registered a case of abetment to suicide against a man after his wife died under suspicious circumstances about three months ago. The police started a case of suspicious death, but now during investigation the case has been changed to abetment to suicide.

According to information, Shivam Thakur died in suspicious condition at his maternal home. The police then started the investigation. During the investigation, a lot of evidence was given to the police by the woman's mother after which the police have now registered a case of abetment to suicide against Aditya Khajuria, the husband of the deceased woman. He is an employee of the Forest Department. Police say that further investigation is being done in the matter.
