An excavator (JCB), bearing registration number JK02CP7354 and a tractor

trolley, registered under JK02CV9720, was seized at Kathar and handed over

Similarly, a tractor trolley, identified by chassis number JZUDU516492S3, was confiscated in the Kangar Ring Road area and transferred to the SHO of the Police Station Gharota, while a dumper with the registration number IK02RII9287 was saized at Sangani Maira Mandrian and handed over to the

SHO, Police Station Akhnoor. Two tractors with trolleys, bearing chassis numbers MBNGAALDBNR-JO4602 and RNJJ2GCA5461, were seized in the Surya Chack area and promptly delivered to the In-Charge of the Police Post Phalian Mandal. Additionally, two tractor trolleys were confiscated in Khandwal Chatha and

placed under the custody of the In-Charge of the Police Post Chatha. 


