Sikh Engineer's brutal killing sparks outrage, All J&K POJK 1947 SIF calls for thorough investigation

JAMMU: The shocking and brutal killing of Executive Engineer S. Gurmeet Singh from Baramulla, Kashmir, has sent shockwaves through the community, leading to widespread condemnation and calls for a thorough investigation.

The All J&K POJK 1947 Sharnarhi Intellectual Forum, a prominent organization, held a meeting to address the tragic incident. Under the leadership of Adv. Amrik Singh and with the participation of several key members, including Surjit Singh, Secretary, the forum

strongly denounced the gruesome killing.

Gurmeet Singh had been missing since August 25th, and his body was discovered under mysterious circumstances. The forum expressed deep anguish over the loss of the Sikh Gazetted officer, terming it a direct attack on the minority community. The assailants' intentions are believed to be driven by anti-national and communal elements seeking to undermine the presence of minorities in the region, due to their pro-Indian stance.

Forum members criticized

the delay in appropriate actions by the administration, allowing the culprits to execute their plan. They urgently called upon Lt. Governor Sh. Manoj Sinha to initiate a swift and comprehensive investigation into the matter. The demand is for an inquiry conducted by a reputable organization such as the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) to bring the perpetrators to justice promptly.

Failure to act swiftly could result in a mass exodus of minority employees from the valley, warned the forum. The tragic incident has

raised concerns about the security and safety of minority communities in the region.

The forum further demanded proper compensation for the bereaved family, emphasizing the need for support during this difficult time.

The incident highlights the challenges and complexities faced by minority communities in the region. The call for justice and accountability is resounding, urging authorities to act swiftly to apprehend the culprits and prevent further such incident.
