

SKUAST-J hosts Annual Group Meeting of AICRP on Rapeseed Mustard

JAMMU: The 30th Annual Group Meeting of the All India Coordinated Research Project (AICRP) on Rapeseed Mustard commenced at Baba Jitto Auditorium, SKUAST-Jammu on Thursday. Vice-Chancellor SKUAST-Jammu, Dr. BN Tripathi, was the Chief Guest, while ADG (Oilseeds & Pulses), ICAR, New Delhi, Dr. Sanjeev Gupta, was the Guest of Honour.

In his address, Tripathi highlighted the challenges posed by projected population growth and stressed the need for improvement in agricultural practices and sustainable farming techniques. He emphasised that technological interventions and sustainable farming practices must be embraced by all stakeholders to enhance productivity while min-

imising environmental impact. Addressing the alarming deficit in oilseed production, Tripathi highlighted that the country currently faces over 60% annual demand shortfall. Jammu and Kashmir (Union Territory) also reported a deficit in total oilseed production by over 70%.

He praised the role of the ICAR sanctioned AICRP sub-centre at

SKUAST-Jammu in increasing the acreage and productivity of rapeseed mustard crops in the region. The initiative has achieved remarkable results over the past decade, with acreage increasing from 55,000 hectares and productivity from 762 kg/ha in 2012 to 140,000 hectares and 1149 kg/ha, respectively in 2022. He also appreciated the recent sanction of

a Rs 31 crore project by the Jammu and Kashmir Government, focusing on the promotion of oilseeds under the Holistic Agricultural Development Project (HADP). During the meeting, Gupta emphasised the significance of oilseed production and the challenges and opportunities in the sector. He stated that ICAR is actively collaborating with NITI Aayog to

set challenges and goals for the year 2047, aiming to achieve surplus production in oilseeds, pulses, meat, fruits and vegetables. Gupta mentioned that ICAR is actively working on a diverse range of 65 oilseed varieties to develop new and improved varieties to address evolving needs. He stated that the current production scenario as per the 3rd advance estimates for 2023 projected a total of 41 million tonnes of oilseed production during the year.

Director Research, SKUAST-Jammu, Dr. RK Samnotra, highlighted the potential of the Jammu region for rapeseed mustard cultivation and praised the contributions of the AICRP (Rapeseed Mustard) Chatha centre in developing beneficial varieties for the region's farmers.

Whereas land measuring 32 Kanal situated at village Galar & Chak Harkha, Tehsil & District Samba is required for public purpose for Establishment of BOP namely WHALEBACK; and

Whereas on the recommendation of Collector Land Acquisition (ACR) Samba vide No. DC3/ACR/LAS/2022-23/105 Dated: 23/03/2023 sanction was accorded vide order No. 02 of 2023 dated 24/03/2023 under endorsement No. DCS/ACR/LAS/115-122 date 24/03/2023 for land measuring 32 kanal for exemption from undertaking Social Impact Assessment Study u/s 9 by invoking urgency clause under section 40 of Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013; and

Whereas Collector Land Acquisition (ACR) vide No. DCS/ACR/LAS/2022-23/123-129 dated 25/03/2023 issued preliminary notification U/S 11(1) of Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 for calling objection, if any from the interested person/ in respect of land measuring 32 kanal situated at village Galar & Chak Harkha which is under acquisition within stipulated time period of 60 days from the date of publication of the notification personally or through the authorized agent; and

Whereas, in response to notification U/S 11(1), nobody filed any objection within stipulated time period of 60 days from the date of publication of the notification; and

Whereas as per notification issued by Government of J&K Revenue Department vide S.O No.17 Da ted: 14/01/2022 designated Deputy Commissioner (District Collector) has been designated to be the Appropriate Government within their respective jurisdiction for acquiring a land under right to Fair Compensation and Transparency In Land Acquisition Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act.2013. for public purpose for an area not exceeding 400 kanal (50 acre); and

Whereas as per section 19(1) of Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 the Appropriate Government (District collector) is satisfied that the land is required for public purpose viz Establishment of BOP namely WHALEBACK for BSF; and

Now, therefore declaration u/s 19 (1) Right to fair to Fair Compensation and transparency in Land Acquisition Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 is hereby accorded for Acquisition of land measuring 32 Kanal situated at village Galar & Chak Harkha Tehsil & District Samba for public Purpose Viz Establishment of BOP namely Whaleback.

1. **INTRODUCTION:**
These proceedings are under provisions of Section 23 of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 for determination of compensation in respect of net area of land proposed to be acquired measuring 09 kanals -05- ½ Marlas for construction of link road from Padyarna to Lonepora at village Bhagna. The land acquisition proceedings were initiated with the publication of Preliminary Notification under section 11 of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013. The Chief Engineer PW(R&B) Department, Jammu Vide No. CEJ/DB/2159-62 Dated:23-02-2019, submitted proper letter of indent for acquisition of land for construction of link road from Padyarna to Lonepora. Accordingly, the Tehsildar Nagseni Vide No. TN/Gen/LA/2019-20/345 Dated:11-07-2019, had submitted the land acquisition papers to this office duly completed in all respect for further necessary action.

2. **PUBLICATION OF NOTIFICATIONS AND ISSUE OF NOTICES:** The local SIA team was notified as Social Impact Assessment Team (SIA) u/s 4 of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 for conducting Social Impact Assessment Team (SIA) Vide No.ACR/LA/2022-23 Dated:17-02-2022. Accordingly, the concerned committee members had submitted the Social Impact Assessment Study report within a time bound manner and the same was submitted to the District Collector Kishtwar for appraisal under u/s 7 of the RFCTLARR Act 2013 Vide No ACR/LA/2022-23/307-08 Dated:09-01-2022.

The District Collector Kishtwar, constituted a committee of expert group for appraisal of Social Impact Assessment Study report. Accordingly, the Multi-Disciplinary Expert Group for appraisal constituted Vide Notification No. DCK/LA/21/F.No. 102/445 Dated:09-01-2022 submitted its recommendation.

The SIA report and the recommendation of Multi-Disciplinary Expert Group was then approved and a Preliminary Notification No. ACR/LA/2022-23/422-428 Dated:14-03-2023 was issued u/s 11 of the Act stating that the land described in the schedule thereto (hereafter referred to as the said land) was needed or likely to be needed for the public purpose. The notification issued for inviting objections within 60 days.

No objections were received against the Preliminary Notification. The proposal was then submitted to the Appropriate Government i.e Deputy Commissioner (District Collector) Kishtwar, seeking approval to proceed with acquisition process and the same was approved; and

Further, on approval of Appropriate Government i.e Deputy Commissioner (District Collector) Kishtwar, Vide Declaration No. 08 of 2023 Dated: 15-05-2023 read with endorsement No. DCK/LA/23/F.No.287/68 Dated:15-05-2023, it was declared under the provisions of Section 19 of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 that the land was required for the public purpose namely construction of link road from Padyarna to Lonepora at village Bhagna Tehsil Nagseni & District Kishtwar.

To facilitate causation of the above requirements, Notice Vide No. ACR/LA/2023-24/169 Dated:09-06-2023 was served u/s 21 of the RTFCLARR Act, 2013, stating that all person having interest in the said land may submit their objections within 30 days and may appear personally or through an agent.

Under Section 21 of the RTFCLARR Act, 2013, the Government intended to take the possession of the land in 30 days from the date of issue of the Notice and claims to compensation for all interests in the land, had to submitted to the collector for disposal within 30 days from the date of issue of the Notice. No objections were received against the Notice u/s 21 of the Act.

The case file was as such submitted to the Deputy Commission (Appropriate Government) Kishtwar in the shape of Tentative award Vide No. ACR/LA/2023-24/169 Dated:09-06-2023 for approval of rates. The rates so recommended have been approved by the Deputy Commission (Appropriate Government) Kishtwar and conveyed to this office Vide No.DCK/LA/2023/F.No. 297/168 Dated:20-07-2023.

3. **OWNERSHIP:**
Name of the persons of whose land under acquisition is standing in the record of rightswas ascertained from the revenue records and the same are shown in Award statement.

4. **SITUATION, DESCRIPTION AND LOCATION OF THE LAND:**
The total acquired land measuring 09 kanals -05- ½ Marlas, under acquisition is un-irrigated agricultural land and situated in village Bhagna of Tehsil Nagseni District Kishtwar.

5. **VALUATION OF THE LAND:**
The Principal for assessing the amount of compensation to be awarded has been laid down under section 26(1) of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 read withendorsement No. REV/LAJK/254/2020 Dated: 26-08-2020 and accordingly the market value of the land was determined for further determination of compensation,

6. **DETERMINATION OF COMPENSATION:**
As per the provisions of the Section 30 of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013, 100% of the Compensation Amount (including market value multiplied by Multiplication Factor) is to be awarded as Solatium as has been determined in the Award statement.

7. **COMPENSATION OF LAND:**
The compensation of land is to be paid to land interested persons. The total amount of Award Workout to be Rs. 1,79,10,952/= (Rupees One Crore Seventy Nine Lakhs Ten Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty Two Only).

8. **SUMMARY OF THE AWARD:**
The award is summarized as under:-

9. **MUTATION OF OCCUPANCY IN RESPECT OF THE SAID LAND BEING ACQUIRED:**
The acquiring department shall ensure that the record of right and all the relevant documents related to the ownership/occupancy of the said land are accordingly modified and show the transfer of the said land solely in the name of Government consequent to taking over possession of the said land and the payment of the compensation to the concerned interested parties.

10. **CORRECTION OF THE RECORD IN THE RECORD OF RIGHTS:**
The Tehsildar, Nagseni shall carry out necessary mutation in the Record of Rights in the name of Indenting Department in respect of land so acquired as per the enclosed Award statement.

11. **APPORTIONMENT:**
The amount of compensation payable to interested persons as shown in the apportionment Statement is in accordance with the provisions of Agr. Reform Act, 1976and the guidelines given by the Rev. Dept. Vide No. REV (LB) 10/80 Dated:-23-02-1980 & the latest Girdawari entries in the Field Book as well as in Girdawari Copies. However, in case of any dispute, which is not settled within reasonable time, the amount of compensation will be remitted to the court under section 64 of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 for jurisdiction.

12. **ENCUMBRANCES:**
The land under acquisition is free from all encumbrances and it has been mentioned in te Award statement
