Advisory for fruit growers of Jammu Division for August

Important message for fruit growers of Jammu Division

The fruit growers of Jammu Division are hereby advised to adopt the following cultural and protective measures during the month of **August 2023** for better management of their orchards.

- 1) Continue plantation for new orchards of Mango, Litchi, Guava, Citrus etc and gap filling in old orchards.
- 2) Keep the orchards free from weeds.
- 3) Drain out excess rain water from the orchards and provide staking to the young fruit plants.
- 4) Use insect traps such as light traps, yellow pan sticky traps and pheromones to check insect-pests attack.
- 5) Continue harvesting of Mango and Lemon fruits.
- 6) Prune the overcrowded, diseased & dried twigs, leaves and branches in Mango tree followed by spray of Copper Oxychloride @ 3gm/ litre of water to control diseases like Die back, Blight and Anthracnose.
- 7) Deep ploughing the orchards immediately after harvest to expose the eggs of Mealy Bugs.
- 8) Spray Dimethoate @ 1ml/ litre against Citrus Psylla, Leaf Miner, White Fly and Lemon cater pillar in Citrus plants.
- 9) Spray Streptomycin sulphate@ 0.5g or Copper Oxychloride @ 3gm in 1 litre of water against Citrus Canker after pruning/ destroying the infected shoots. Repeat spray at 10-15 days interval in Citrus plants.
- 10) Spray Zinc Sulphate+ lime (600gm + 300gm) per 100 litre of water if Zinc deficiency symptoms are observed in summer flush of Citrus at tender foliage stage.
- 11) For the control of Fruit Fly in Guava, destroy the fallen fruits and apply Bait spray at 10-15 days interval with Dimethoate 30EC @ 1ml+ Gur 10g. in 1 litre of water. Harvest the fruit when still hard.
- 12) Spray Chloorpyrifos 20EC @ 2ml or Imidachloprid 18.75@ 3gm in 1 litre of water against Chaffer Beetle in Ber at week-ly interval during evening.
- 13) Half dose of Urea and MOP be applied in the Aonia orchard.
- 14) Spray Hexaconazole 5EC @ 30ml/100 litres of water or tridemeton 25WP @ 50g/100 litres of water against scab during fruit formation in Apple fruit tree.
- 15) 6-7 days after spray against scab/ alternaria, spray with Phosalone 35EC @ 140 ml or Methyl Dimeton 25EC @ 80ml/100 litres of water.
- 16) 10 days after insecticidal spray, Apple fruit trees be sprayed with Mancozeb @ 300gms/ 100 litres of water against sooty blotch and fly speck.
- 17) Post harvest spray of Copper Compound @ 3gm/litre of water be conducted to control future inoculum of Leaf Curl and Blight in stone fruits like Peach, Plum etc.

FRUIT PLANT NURSERIES:

- 1) Continue air layering in Guava and Litchi and budding operation in Ber.
- 2) Burying of green manuring crops in vacant nursery areas to be completed.
- 3) Use compatible and disease free root stock.
- 4) Disease free bud wood from healthy plants should be used.

The Revenue Department, J&K Civil Secretariat has issued the Notification vide No. 10 Rev. (LAJ) of 2023, Dated:- 17-07-2023 under Section 6 of Land Acquisition Act and under Section 7, this collectorate has also been authorized to take orders for Acquisition of the said land after giving prescribed notice to the interest person (s) as required Land Acquisition Act/Rules.

Now, accordingly, the notice under section 9&9A of the land Acquisition Act.1990 BK is hereby issued there by inviting objections from the interested person (s) as well as Indenting Department with regard to the measurement of land and rates to be adopted for payment of compensation and also with regard to the title of the land under acquisition.

1. INTRODUCTION:

These proceedings are under provisions of Section 23 of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 for determination of compensation in respect of net area of land proposed to be acquired measuring 04 kanals -09 ¼ Marlas for Construction of Link Road Takeoff Point at Kuleed to Balashram via H/o Bansilal and Govt. Girls Middle School Bhoop Nagar Linking Panditgam Road link Road H/o Chuni Lal to Zelna via Wasser also linking S.K.S.H near Tourist Complex via HarijanBasti Bun Kuleed Kishtwar, Tehsil and District Kishtwar. The land acquisition proceedings were initiated with the publication of Preliminary Notification under section 11 of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013.

The Chief Engineer PW(R&B) Department, Jammu Vide No. CEJ/DB/8165-68 Dated;13-09-2019, submitted proper letter of indent for acquisition of land for Construction of Link Road Takeoff Point at Kuleed to Balashram via H/o Bansilal and Govt. Girls Middle School Bhoop Nagar Linking Panditgam Road link Road H/o Chuni Lal to Zelna via Wasser also linking S.K.S.H near Tourist Complex via HarijanBasti Bun Kuleed Kishtwar, Tehsil and District Kishtwar. Accordingly, the Tehsildar Kishtwar Vide No. 19/OQ/LA Dated;04-07-2020, had submitted the land acquisition papers to this office duly completed in all respect for further necessary action.

2. PUBLICATION OF NOTIFICATIONS AND ISSUE OF NOTICES:

The local SIA team was notified as Social Impact Assessment Team (SIA) u/s 4 of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 for conducting Social Impact Assessment Team (SIA) Vide No.ACR/LA/2022-23/288-94 Dated;21-07-2022. Accordingly, the concerned committee members had submitted the Social Impact Assessment Study report within a time bound manner and the same was submitted to the District Collector Kishtwar for appraisal under u/s 7 of the RFCTLARR Act, 2013 Vide No ACR/LA/2022-23/509 Dated;21-09-2022.

The District Collector Kishtwar, constituted a committee of expert group for appraisal of Social Impact Assessment Study report. Accordingly, the Multi-Disciplinary Expert Group for appraisal constituted Vide Notification No. DCK/LA/22/F.No.102/34 Dated;19-10-2022 submitted its recommendation.

The SIA report and the recommendation of Multi-Disciplinary Expert Group was then approved and a Preliminary Notification No. ACR/LA/2022-23/372-78 Dated;19-01-2023 was issued u/s 11 of the Act stating that the land described in the schedule thereto (hereafter referred to as the said land) was needed or likely to be needed for the public purpose. The notification issued for inviting objections within 60 days.

No objections were received against the Preliminary Notification. The proposal was then submitted to the Appropriate Government i.e Deputy Commissioner (District Collector) Kishtwar, seeking approval to proceed with acquisition process and the same was approved: and

Further, on approval of Appropriate Government i.e Deputy Commissioner (District Collector) Kishtwar, Vide Declaration No. 04 of 2023 Dated;27-03-2023 read with endorsement No. DCK/LA/23/F.No.294/566 Dated;27-03-2023, it was declared under the provisions of Section 19 of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 that the land was required for the public purpose namely construction of Construction of Link Road Takeoff Point at Kuleed to Balashram via H/o Bansilal and Govt. Girls Middle School Bhoop Nagar Linking Panditgam Road link Road H/o Chuni Lal to Zelna via Wasser also linking S.K.S.H near Tourist Complex via Harijan Basti Bun Kuleed Kishtwar, Tehsil and District Kishtwar. To facilitate causation of the above requirements, Notice Vide No. ACR/LA/2023-24/25-32 Dated;07-04-2023 was served u/s 21 of the RTFCLARR Act, 2013, stating that all persons having interest in the said land may submit their objections within 30 days and may appear personally or through an agent.

Under Section 21 of the RTFCLARR Act, 2013, the Government intended to take the possession of the land in 30 days from the date of issue of the Notice and claims to compensation for all interests in the land, had to submitted to the collector for disposal within 30 days from the date of issue of the Notice. No objections were received against the Notice u/s 21 of the Act.

The case file was as such submitted to the Deputy Commission (Appropriate Government) Kishtwar in the shape of Tentative award Vide No. ACR/LA/2022-23/246 Dated;14-07-2023 for approval of rates. The rates so recommended have been approved by the Deputy Commission (Appropriate Government) Kishtwar and conveyed to this office Vide No.DCK/LA/2023/F.No. 297/168 Dated;20-07-2023.

3. OWNERSHIP:

Name of the persons of whose land under acquisition is standing in the record of rights was ascertained from the revenue records and the same are shown in Award statement.

4. SITUATION, DESCRIPTION AND LOCATION OF THE LAND:

The total acquired land measuring 04 kanals -09 ¼ Marlas, under acquisition is un-irrigated agricultural land and situated in village Lachkhazana of Tehsil Kishtwar District Kishtwar.

5. VALUATION OF THE LAND:

The Principal for assessing the amount of compensation to be awarded has been laid down under section 26(1) of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 read with endorsement No. REV/LAJK/254/2020 Dated; 26-08-2020 and accordingly the market value of the land was determined for further determination of compensation.

6. DETERMINATION OF COMPENSATION:

As per the provisions of the Section 30 of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013, 100% of the Compensation Amount (including market value multiplied by Multiplication Factor) is to be awarded as Solatium as has been determined in the Award statement.

7. COMPENSATION OF LAND:

The compensation of land is to be paid to land interested persons. The total amount of Award Workout to be Rs.1,79,10,952/- (Rupees One Crore Seventy Nine Lakhs Ten Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty Two Only).

8. SUMMARY OF THE AWARD:

The award is summarized as under:-

The details of compensation of the land acquisition as per the Annexure-I is enclosed herewith.

9. MUTATION OF OCCUPANCY IN RESPECT OF THE SAID LAND BEING ACQUIRED:

The acquiring department shall ensure that the record of right and all the relevant documents related to the ownership/occupancy of the said land are accordingly modified and show the transfer of the said land solely in the name of Government consequent to taking over possession of the said land and the payment of the compensation to the concerned interested parties.

10. CORRECTION OF THE RECORD IN THE RECORD OF RIGHTS:

The Tehsildar, Kishtwar shall carry out necessary mutation in the Record of Rights in the name of Indenting Department in respect of land so acquired as per the enclosed Award statement.

11. APPORTIONMENT:

The amount of compensation payable to interested persons as shown in the apportionment Statement is in accordance with the provisions of Agr. Reform Act, 1976 and the guidelines given by the Rev. Dept. Vide No. REV (LB) 10/80 Dated:- 23-02-1980 & the latest Giridawari entries in the Field Book as well as in Giridawari Copies. However, in case of any dispute, which is not settled within reasonable time, the amount of compensation will be remitted to the court under section 64 of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 for jurisdiction.

12. ENCUMBRANCES:

The land under acquisition is free from all encumbrances and it has been mentioned in the Award statement.
