KP leaders urge political parties to address migrants' issues in election manifestos

JAMMU: Kashmiri Pandits, displaced for over three decades and living in migrant camps across Jammu and other parts of India, are urgently seeking permanent rehabilitation in the Kashmir Valley and resolution to their daily struggles. In a recent statement, key leaders from the community, including Rakesh Koul, Vinod Pandita, Sanjay Dhar, Vijay Raina, and Anita Chand Puri, urged political parties to address these issues prominently in their election manifestos for the upcoming Jammu and Kashmir assembly elections.

Rakesh Koul and Vinod Pandita have called on the Government of India and the Lieutenant Governor to develop a concrete rehabilitation policy for the Kashmiri Pandits, with input from all relevant stakeholders.

They emphasized that political parties must fulfill their roles in this process. They also recommended increasing the monthly cash

assistance for displaced families from Rs 13,000 to Rs 25,000 to cope with rising living costs, and proposed creating 10,000 new jobs for educated unemployed youth within the community. Sanjay Dhar and Vijay Raina highlighted the urgent need to address the severe potable water shortage in Jagti and other camps and called for improvements in sanitation, safety, and security. They also suggested replacing the current nomination quota with reserved seats for the displaced community.

Anita Chandpuri appealed to the Prime Minister and Home Minister to ensure the implementation of all centrally sponsored schemes for the Kashmiri Displaced community, which have been largely inaccessible to them so far. She also urged the community to unite beyond party lines, stressing that collective effort is crucial for addressing their plight effectively.
