**PARKING SLOTS FOR PASS HOLDERS**

**PARKING FOR GENERAL PUBLIC WITH OUT PASSES**

**CUT OFF POINTS FOR VEHICULAR MOVEMENT:**

- Shakuntala Crossing

**RESTRICTED AREAS**

- Fly Over (Arterial Express Way) both the tubes.
- TAWI BRIDGE
- Dogra Chowk to J.P Chowk / Vinayak Bazar / stretch between Bhagat Singh Chowk and Jewel Chowk

**FERRY VEHICLES BY CIVIL ADMINISTRATION TO DE-BOARD AT CUT OFF POINTS**

All ferry vehicles from North/South/Rural if any shall de-board the participants at the respective Cut off Points wherefrom, they shall proceed on foot upto Venue (MA Stadium).

**TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS /DIVERSION**

- During the celebration of the National festival till 1300 Hours strict diversions shall be applied on ground. All general vehicular movement and vehicles shall terminate accordingly from nearest routes and get their vehicles parked in appropriate parking slot to avoid any inconvenience.
- All the PSVs/ Buses/ Mini Buses operating from Kathua , Samba, Srinagar, Udhampur, Katra, Doda, Banihal, Rajouri, Poonch, R.S.Pura, Miran Sahib Bari Brahmana, BishnahGangyal, Miran Sahib, Mandal Phyllan, will be diverted accordingly from alternate routes viz, TCP Nagrota , Narwal, Bagh-e-Bahu Crossing , Kunjwani Chowk, Satwari Chowk , Main stop Gandhi Nagar , Asia Crossing via 4<sup>th</sup> Tawi Bridge, Bhagwati Nagar Rotary, Bakshi Nagar , Canal Head and Toph Bridge.
- For the convenient movement of General Public Gujjar Nagar Bridge, Sidhra Bridge and 4<sup>th</sup> Tawi Bridge Bhagwati Nagar is kept free from restrictions but shall follow the diversion restrictions and plan their travel accordingly.
- All Vehicles carrying students coming from Akhnour/Talab Tillo side shall be diverted from Bakshi Nagar Pulli towards Maheshpora-Vigilance Rotary-via Fly over to Bikram Chowk and shall turn back towards Dogra Chowk, drop students there and shall be parked at Early Time Parking grounds.
- General Public who intends to go from City North towards Railway Station/ Airport / South side of Jammu city shall opt following routes during the restriction period:
  - Panjtirthi to Circular Road towards Gujjar Nagar Bridge and vice versa. Same routes can be adopted by people willing to go from South to North side
  - Moreover, people who intend to go Akhnour, Talab Tillo, Paloura etc shall adopt 4th Tawi Bridge via Bhagwati Nagar/ Canal headKeeping in view the restrictions/diversions for hassle free passage of National Festival, the public in general is requested to co-operate with the Traffic Police/Local Police and plan their travel accordingly to reach their destinations.
