## No subsidy for solar roofs installed by unregistered vendors under Surya Ghar: KPDCL advisory

SRINAGAR: Kashmir Power Distribution Corporation Limited (KPDCL) on Monday advised its domestic consumers to approach empanelled solar PV vendors only for installation of solar roof-tops under the PM Surya

Ghar Scheme.

In a statement issued, KPDCL spokesperson stated that some consumers are being approached by solar vendors for SRTs, who are not registered with KPDCL under the PM Surya Ghar Scheme. "The list of

empanelled vendors is available on National Portal of PM Surya Ghar with contact details, which can be accessed for choosing vendors of choice," he advised.

The spokesman further clarified that those consumers who get their solar

roof-tops installed by vendors who are not empanelled with KPDCL shall not be eligible for Central or UT subsidy. "KPDCL has been issuing advisories through its social media handles warning customers not to get deceived by unregistered vendors," he added.

Subject:- Permission for organizing of political rallies / events in view of upcoming Legislative Assembly Elections of UT of J&K-2024 adherence to Model Code of Conduct thereof.

**ORDER**

Whereas, the Election Commission of India has announced dates for holding of Legislative Assembly Elections of UT of J&K-2024 and already the Model Code of Conduct has come into force on 16-08-2024; and Whereas, the Model Code of Conduct is a set of guidelines issued by Election Commission of India to ensure fair and ethical conduct during the electoral process; and

Whereas, in view of upcoming Legislative Assembly Elections of UT of J&K-2024, all political parties or organizers who intend to hold political rallies / events in the district are required to obtain prior permissions for organizing political rallies/events which are issued from this office or offices of concerned RO'S; and

Whereas, concerned political parties can also apply for permission online on Suvidha application; and Whereas, it has come forth before the undersigned that some representatives of political parties do apply for permissions very casually and in haste manner either through whatsapp message or through email and are not applying permissions in written form with legible contents mentioning date, timing, designated venues etc.; and Whereas, any permission sought through whatsapp message / email, not properly applied in due time is not allowed and hence can't be processed for further appropriate action; and Whereas, organizers and rally participants are required to comply with safety regulations adhering the Model Code of Conduct in letter and spirit.

Therefore, it is hereby enjoined upon all the political parties to seek permissions for organizing political rallies / events at designated locations in prescribed way, well in advance at least two days before holding of their rallies/events.

Any violation of the same shall entail further action against the erring person/organizers in terms of "The Representation of the People Act, 1951 read with provisions of Model Code of Conduct. The details of designated locations for holding of Rallies/ events in respect of (49. Kishtwar/ 48-Inderalwal/50-Padder-Nagseni) are hereby enclosed as Annexure-A,B & C.
