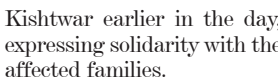

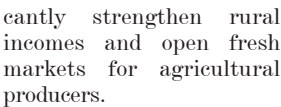
During the programme, Prof. Rai formally launched a new initiative in collaboration with Power Grid Corporation of India Limited, aimed at enhancing university infrastructure and
