

HC Jammu wing celebrates 79th Independence Day

JAMMU: Under the guidance and patronage of Chief Justice, High Court of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh, Justice Arun Palli, Jammu Wing of the High Court, on Friday celebrated the 79th Independence Day with patriotic zeal and joy in a grand function at High Court Complex, Janipur, Jammu

The celebrations commenced with unfurling of the National Flag by Justice Sanjeev Kumar, Senior most Judge, High Court of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh who took salute presented by a contingent of CRPF personnel in presence of companion Judges of the High Court and dignitaries. These included Justice Rajnesh Oswal, Justice Vinod Chatterji Koul, Justice Sanjay Dhar, Justice Mohd. Akram Chowdhary, Justice Wasim Sadiq Nargal, Justice Rajesh Sekhri, Justice Sanjay Parihar, Additional Advocate General, Senior Advocates, Yash Paul Bournay, Principal District and Sessions Judge, Jammu and all Judicial Officers Headquarters at Jammu.

Sandeep Kour, Registrar Judicial, Jammu Wing, Meyank Gupta, Joint Registrar Judicial/Protocol, Jammu Wing, Jeevan Sharma, Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee besides Vishal Sharma, Deputy Solicitor General of India, J&K Nirmal Kotwal, President, J&K High Court Bar Association, Jammu along with office bearers and members of the Bar Association and the officers and officials of the High Court Registry and District Judiciary were present on the occasion.

It is pertinent to mention that the main Independence Day function was held at High Court complex, Srinagar, where Chief Justice High Court of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh, Arun Palli hoisted the National Flag.

Explosives used to blast giant boulders to speed up rescue efforts in cloudburst-hit village

KISHTWAR/JAMMU: Explosives were used to blast giant boulders hampering the ongoing rescue and relief operations in the disaster-hit Chisoti village in Kishtwar district on the third day on Saturday, officials said.

Army has also deployed additional troops to intensify the efforts, they said.

A total of 60 persons, including three CISF personnel and a Special Police Officer, have died and 82 people were reported missing in the cloudburst and the resultant flash floods that struck the remote village in Padder sub-division on Thursday afternoon. Around 167 people have been rescued so far, some critically injured.

Union Minister Jitendra Singh, accompanied by Jammu and Kashmir Director General of Police Nalin Prabhat, also visited the devastated village late on Friday night and reviewed the ongoing rescue and relief efforts jointly carried out by the Police, Army, National Disaster Response Force, State Disaster Response Force, Border Roads Organisation, civil administration, and local volunteers. So far, 50 bodies have been identified and handed over to their next of kin after completion of legal formalities.

Racing against time since the chances of digging out the survivors alive fade with every passing hour, the rescuers expedited the operation in the evening by using explosive substances to blast the oversized boulders that could not be shifted with earth-movers or other equipment.

Chief Secretary Atal Dulloo, General Officer Commanding of Army's Delta Force Major General A P S Bal, and CISF Deputy Inspector General M K Yadav also visited the village, while Jammu Divisional Commissioner Ramesh Kumar, Jammu Inspector General of Police Bhim Sen Tuti, Kishtwar Deputy Commissioner Pankaj Kumar Sharma and Kishtwar Senior Superintendent of Police Naresh Singh are camping in the area to supervise the operation. The annual Machail Mata yatra, which began on July 25 and was scheduled to conclude on September 5, remained suspended for the third consecutive day on Saturday. The 8.5-kilometre trek to the 9,500-foot-high shrine starts from Chisoti, located about 90 kilometres from Kishtwar town.

Rescue efforts were intensified with the deployment of nearly a dozen earth-movers by the civil administration and the use of specialised equipment and dog squads by the National Disaster Relief Force.

3 drug peddlers arrested, 60 grams of heroin recovered

JAMMU: Continuing its drive against drug trafficking and substance abuse, Police Station Gandhi Nagar achieved a major success by recovering approximately 60 grams of Heroin (Chitta) like substance from three drug peddlers in two separate incidents near Tawi River Front, Ware House Jammu under the jurisdiction of Police Post Nehru Market of PS Gandhi Nagar.

On 14.08.2025, a police team of Police Post Nehru Market, led by I/C PP Nehru Market,PSI Sumil Singh assisted by police officials, under the close supervision of SHO Police Station Gandhi Nagar, Inspector Jai Paul Sharma, while on routine patrolling duty, apprehended the accused persons.

The arrested drug peddlers have been identified as Mohd Akram S/o Mohd Sadiq R/o Rehari Colony, Jammu; Talib Gul S/o Gul Mohd Shah R/o Qaimoh, Kulgam and Manga S/o Gurmat Chand R/o Valmiki Colony, Gandhi Nagar, Jammu

In this connection, cases have been registered at Police Station Gandhi Nagar FIR No. 175/2025 U/S 8/21/22/29 NDPS Act dated and FIR No. 181/2025 U/S 8/21/22 NDPS Act.

The accused persons have been arrested and investigation is underway.

The entire operation was carried out by Police Post Nehru Market under the supervision of SHO PS Gandhi Nagar,SDPO Sout and overall supervision of SP South.

Two bovine smuggling attempts foiled; 2 bovine smugglers arrested, 16 bovines rescued

SAMBA: Continuing its drive against bovine smugglers and their propagators, Samba Police has successfully foiled two bovines smuggling attempts in the jurisdiction of Police Stations Samba and Ghagwal, arrested two bovine smugglers and rescued sixteen (16) bovines from the clutches of bovine smugglers. The vehicles used in the illegal transportation of bovines were also seized.

Acting on reliable information, a Police team of PS Samba intercepted a Swift Desire car bearing registration No. JK02AV-2142 at Sambyal Chowk, Samba and during checking, a bovine was found inside the vehicle which was stolen and tied in cruel manner. The bovine was being transported illegally without any valid permission. The bovine smugglers identified as Anwar Ali S/o Anyat Ali R/o Dawara district Jammu and Irfan Ali S/o Mohd Hanief R/o Thathar district Jammu have been arrested and the vehicle has also been seized.

A case FIR No. 217/2025 u/s 303(2)/299/223/3(5) BNS, 11 PCA Act has been registered at Police Station Samba and investigation started.
