HC upholds detention orders under PSA

JAMMU: Justice Sanjay Dhar of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh High Court has dismissed two habeas corpus petitions challenging detention orders issued under the Jammu & Kashmir Public Safety Act (PSA), thereby upholding the preventive detention of two residents of District Anantnag.

The petitions were filed by Mohd. Rafi Najar, resident of Arwani Bijbehara, and Zameer Ahmad Shah, resident of Nambal Mattan, who had sought quashing of detention orders passed by the District Magistrate, Anantnag. The orders, bearing No. 06/DMA/PSA/DET/2024 dated 01.04.2024 (Rafi Najar) and No. 22/DMA/PSA/DET/2024 dated 20.05.2024 (Zameer Shah), were challenged on grounds of vagueness, non-supply of documents, and alleged non-consideration of representations.

After hearing counsel for both sides and perusal of the detention records, Justice

Sanjay Dhar observed that in both cases, the detainees were supplied with all relevant documents forming the basis of detention orders, which were read over and explained to them in languages they understood. The representations filed by the detainees were duly placed before the Advisory Board, considered on April 24, 2024 (Rafi Najar) and June 27, 2024 (Zameer Shah) respectively, and rejected after granting personal hearings. Preventive detention can be ordered on the basis of credible

material and suspicion, even if the evidence is insufficient for prosecution in a criminal court. The Court further noted that the detention orders were passed after proper application of mind by the detaining authority and were based on activities prejudicial to the security of the State. Accordingly, both writ petitions were found to be without merit and were dismissed. The PSA detention of the two petitioners has thus been confirmed and upheld.

Court convicts accused in 11-year-old blind murder

JAMMU: In a significant judgment, the Court of Additional Sessions Judge Jammu, presided over by Ritesh Dubey, on Monday convicted Rahim-ul-Din for the 2014 blind murder of Mohammad Abdullah alias Dulla.

The Court held that the prosecution, led by Additional Public Prosecutor

Sunil Sharma, had successfully proved a complete chain of circumstantial evidence, establishing beyond reasonable doubt that the accused slit the victim's throat with a knife on the night of March 30, 2014. The body, wrapped in a grey blanket and weighed down with sand and stones, was recovered from the Garkhal Khad (Kofli Fattu River) on April 14,

2014. The case began when a police patrol team from PP Garkhal noticed a suspicious gathering near the river and recovered a male body later identified as Mohammad Abdullah.
