42 Route Permits approved under Mission Yuva

Stress laid on strengthening Public Transport Network, Traffic Regulation

POONCH: Deputy Commissioner Poonch Ashok Kumar Sharma on Tuesday chaired a meeting of the Regional Transport Authority (RTA) in his office chamber to deliberate on the issues concerning the public transport system in the district.

During the meeting, the Deputy Commissioner, who also serves as the Chairman of the RTA, along with other members, conducted a thorough review of various applications seeking



road permits. Assistant Regional

Transport Officer (ARTO) Basharat Mehmood, briefed the DC on the cases presented for consideration.

After detailed discussions and scrutiny, 42 cases were approved for fresh route permits under the Mission Yuva initiative, aimed at enhancing youth participation in the transport sector.

The Deputy Commissioner directed the Traffic Department to ensure effective traffic regulation across the district and to take stringent action

against violators. He stressed the importance of maintaining discipline on the roads to ensure safety and smooth transportation for the public.

DC Doda reviews situation along Chenab River

Appeals public to remain vigilant, avoid venturing near water bodies

DODA: Deputy Commissioner (DC) Doda Harvinder Singh on Tuesday conducted a visit to assess the situation along the Chenab River in view of the continuing spell of heavy rains across the region.

During the inspection, the DC reviewed the water levels, possible threats of erosion and the overall impact of rains on adjoining habitations and infrastructure.

He directed the concerned departments to maintain strict vigil and ensure round-the-clock monitoring of the river to prevent any untoward incidents.

The DC Doda emphasized preparedness, instructing officials to keep emergency response teams on alert, reinforce vulnerable embankments and issue timely advisories for the safety of residents living near riverbanks.

He appealed to the gener-

al public to remain vigilant, avoid unnecessary movement near the river and strictly adhere to safety advisories issued by the district administration during the ongoing adverse weather conditions.

The District Administration Doda assured that all precautionary and restoration measures are being taken on priority to safeguard lives and property amidst the continuous rains.
