

Dr Rameshwar meets CM, seeks special package for Bani

JAMMU: Dr. Rameshwar Singh, the Member of Legislative Assembly (MLA) from Bani constituency, met with Jammu and Kashmir Chief Minister Omar Abdullah today to highlight the deteriorating condition of the Bani region and to demand a special rehabilitation package for the area.

During the meeting, Dr. Singh briefed the Chief Minister in detail about the hardships faced by the people of Bani due to recent natural calamities and years of administrative neglect. He expressed serious concern over the damaged infrastruc-

ture, poor road connectivity, shortage of medical facilities, and lack of basic services such as electricity and clean drinking water in the region.

The MLA pointed out that several villages in the constituency remain cut off due to landslides and washed-out roads, causing immense trouble to residents and hampering relief efforts.

Dr. Singh demanded an immediate and comprehensive relief and rehabilitation package for Bani. He urged the government to deploy special teams to assess the damage and ensure swift restoration of essential services. He also stressed the

need for long-term development plans tailored to the geographical challenges of the region.

"People in Bani are suffering due to repeated natural disasters and the lack of timely support. I have requested the Hon'ble Chief Minister to treat this situation on priority and provide a

special package that addresses both immediate relief and long-term rehabilitation," Dr. Singh said after the meeting.

Chief Minister Omar Abdullah assured Dr. Singh that the government is committed to the welfare of the people of remote and border areas like Bani. He instructed concerned departments to

take immediate stock of the situation and prepare a proposal for necessary assistance.

The meeting has raised hopes among the residents of Bani that their issues will finally be addressed, and much-needed help will reach the region in the coming days.

Subject: Closure of All Government and Private Schools Across Jammu Division Due to Inclement Weather Conditions

ORDER

In view of the continuous and heavy rainfall being experienced across various parts of Jammu Division, the region has witnessed multiple weather-induced disruptions which have significantly impacted day-to-day life and the safe functioning of educational institutions.

Reports received from various districts have highlighted:

- Severe waterlogging and accumulation of mud in school premises, making them unfit for physical classes.*
- Flooding in low-lying areas, restricting access to schools.*
- Heightened risk of landslides, mudslides, and shooting stones in hilly and mountainous regions, posing serious threats to the safety of students and staff.*
- Damage to road infrastructure, including blocked and eroded roads, which has made travel unsafe.*

Additionally, numerous representations and requests are being received from civil society members, parents, and stakeholders across different districts, urging the administration to continue the closure of schools in the interest of student safety and security.

In light of the above circumstances, and keeping the safety and well-being of students, teachers, and school staff as the highest priority, it is hereby ordered that:

- All Government and Private Schools across Jammu Division shall remain closed up to 30th August 2025.
- Heads of Institutions (Hols) are advised to assess the feasibility of conducting online classes, especially for students of Classes 9 to 12, wherever suitable infrastructure and internet connectivity are available.
- It is reiterated that all Chief Education Officers (CEOs) and Hols shall ensure strict compliance with the Standard Operating Procedures (SoPs) for safe reopening of schools, as outlined in this office's circular instructions vide No. DSEJ/Genl/43727-51 dated 20-08-2025 (Copy Enclosed), before resuming physical classes.
- Parents and students are requested to stay informed through official school communication channels for updates regarding the resumption of academic activities.
- All School Authorities must ensure thorough cleaning, sanitation, and safety inspections of school buildings and premises prior to reopening.
- CEOs and Hols shall consult the local administration before opening the Schools.

The situation is being continuously monitored. Any further directions will be issued as per evolving weather and ground conditions. This order shall come into effect immediately and shall remain valid till 30th August 2025.
