BHADERWAH: In a major relief for stranded travelers, the Bhaderwah-Doda highway was partially restored for oneway traffic at Sanai area of JK's Bhaderwah on Thursday afternoon, three days after a 100-meter stretch of the road was washed away. The vital road link was

damaged at Sanai area on Tuesday when the rising waters of the Neeru Riverswollen due to torrential rains and a cloudburst-swept away a section of the highway.
