Subject: Prohibition on the sale of Meat, other Non-Vegetarian foods/Items and Liquor in Katra and surrounding areas-reg.

ORDER

Whereas, the sale of meat and liquor was prohibited in Katra town and Vaishno Devi Bhawan by virtue of notification "Prohibition of Sale of Meat and Liquor" issued vide No. 19 by the then Prime Minister under endorsement No. G.B.211 dated 21 January, 1933, to upkeep the sanctity and sacredness of the Holy Shrine and its adjoining areas; and

Whereas, the yatra to the Holy Shrine has increased manifold, over the years, with thousand of devotees from all over the country and abroad visiting the shrine every day, throughout the year and this has necessitated the enforcement of said prohibition, from time to time; and

Whereas, the requirement to further continue with said prohibition on sale/possession/consumption of liquor and non-vegetarian foods in Katra and its adjoining areas is felt quite strongly to honour and uphold the religious sentiments of yatriss and to maintain holiness of the pilgrimage; and

Whereas, the opinion of the public on the subject has been regularly solicited and it is understood that there is unanimity among most of the inhabitants to prohibit the sale of meat and liquor in Katra and its surrounding areas; and

Whereas, earlier orders, on the subject have been assailed before the Hon'ble High Court, J&K, Jammu, which has been pleased to direct affording of an opportunity of being heard to the affected people; and

Whereas, this office has also received quite a few representations, requesting modifications/alterations in the orders, in the interest of families solely dependent on meat selling business for their livelihoods; and

Whereas, the issue has been thoroughly considered afresh touching an aspects and all out efforts to strike a balance between religious sentiments and right to livelihood of people have been made by inviting and accommodating views of all stakeholders; and

Whereas, the said exercise has made the undersigned believe that a prohibition on the sale of meat/non-vegetarian items and liquor in Katra and some areas around it shall serve a larger public interest and will be highly helpful in maintaining public order, tranquillity and harmony in the Holy town and its adjoining areas.

Therefore, in suppression of all previous orders on the subject. I Piyusy Dhotra (JKAS), Sub-Divisional Magistrate, Katra by virtue of powers vested in me under section 163 Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS) do hereby, prohibit sale/possession/consumption of liquor and non-vegetarian food such as eggs, chicken, meat, mutton, sea food, fish, prawns, lobster etc. in Katra and following given areas in the territorial jurisdiction of Sub-Division, Katra:-

- On the track from **Katra to Holy Cave** and and in villages within a distance of upto both sides of the track.
- Villages:-** Ari, Mansal and Matyal.
- Katra-Tikri Road:-** Within 200 meters on both sides of the road Including villages Chamba, Setli and Bhagta.
- Katra-Jammu Road:-** Within 200 meters on both sides of the road Including villages Kundrorian, Kotli Bajallian, Nomain and Maghal.
- Katra-Reasi Road:-** Within 200 meters on both sides of the road from Katra to Nau Devian and Aghar Jitto and Nau Devian markets.
- Railway Station Katra-Sool Road:-** Within 200 meters on both sides of the road.
- Panthal-Domail Road:-** Within 100 meters on both sides of the road.

This order shall remain in force for two months from the its issuance unless revoked earlier.
