

SSP Jammu chairs crime, security review meeting

Vows for zero tolerance against drugs trafficking

JAMMU: Senior Superintendent of Police (SSP) Jammu, Joginder Singh, chaired a comprehensive crime and security review meeting at District Police Lines, Jammu. The meeting was attended by Zonal SSPs, SDPOs, DySP DAR, SHOs, and In-Charges of Police Posts from across the district.

Key discussions included crime control strategies and measures to maintain peace and stability. The SSP reviewed the quality of investigations, crime disposal rates, verifica-

tion processes, handling of NDPS and UAPA cases, inquest proceedings, tracking of history-sheets, absconders, and missing persons. Special emphasis was laid on time-

bound disposal of cases under both old and new criminal laws, focusing on the 60- and 90-day resolution timelines.

Progress on digital policing platforms like COTNS, e-

Sakshaya, e-summons, and SID's was assessed, alongside the mandatory use of Forensic Science Laboratory (FSL) services.

SSP Joginder Singh empha-

sized zero tolerance towards drugs, directing officers to identify and take strict action against drug peddlers. He stressed the importance of qualitative and timely disposal of cases, ensuring justice for victims, and reducing case pendency.

He also reiterated a strict stance on corruption, crime concealment, and indiscipline. The SSP urged officers to provide efficient, legally sound, and people-friendly policing, with quick response times, polite behavior, and empathetic handling of public grievances.

890 Central Laws extended to J&K since abrogation of Article 370: Balbir

JAMMU: BJP senior leader and former Vice Chairman Balbir Ram Rattan stated that since the abrogation of Article 370 on August 5, 2019, as many as 890 central laws have been extended to the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir. Speaking during a discussion on post-Article 370 developments, he emphasized that this historic move brought J&K in line with the rest of India in terms of governance, justice, and socio-economic progress. Balbir highlighted that the Jammu & Kashmir Reorganisation Act, 2019 enabled full application of the Indian Constitution and various central laws, including rights-based legislations that were previously not applicable. These include the SC/ST (Prevention

of Atrocities) Act, Dowry Prohibition Act, Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, Forest Rights Act, and Indian Penal Code (IPC).

He stated that these laws have empowered marginalized communities, including women, Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, forest dwellers, and economically weaker sections, ensuring transparency, inclusivity, and access to legal protections. The implementation of the Right to Education Act and Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act has further expanded access to essential services and opportunities.

Balbir reiterated the Modi government's commitment to holistic development, national integration, and equal rights for all citizens of J&K.

HC seeks status on evictions from forest land, questions delay in action

JAMMU: In a Public Interest Litigation (PIL) filed by inhabitants of village Hari seeking direction to the respondents to initiate eviction proceedings against those who have encroached kanals of forest land falling in Compartment 51-A at village Hari in Surankote tehsil, the High Court of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh has expressed concern over the lack of follow-up action on encroachment removal in Surankote, despite a scheduled eviction drive against 30 identified encroachers. Hearing a Public Interest Litigation filed by the inhabitants of village Hari, the Division Bench comprising Chief Justice Arun Palli and Justice Rajnesh Oswal noted that although the Range Officer Surankote had coordinated with the Sub-Divisional Magistrate for eviction on July 21, 2025, no further steps were reported. The Division Bench observed that no material had been placed on record to confirm whether the eviction was actually carried out. In response, the government counsel sought time to obtain instructions and file a short affidavit regarding the status of the drive.

CB arrests two individuals for cheating

JAMMU: The Economic Offences Wing (EOW) of Crime Branch Kashmir on Wednesday arrested two individuals namely Majid Nazir Najar, son of Nazir Ahmad Najar, resident of Batamalo, near Mehboob Public School Srinagar and Mubarak Ahmad Rather, son of Nissar Ahmad Rather, resident of Gulshan Nagar, Gulposh Colony in case FIR No. 11/2025 under Section 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC of P/S EOW (Crime Branch Kashmir) for cheating a complainant on the

pretext of investment in various deposit schemes. The accused individuals had promised high returns on investment in Adarsh Cooperative Society, SBI Life insurance and HDFC Insurance companies and provided the complainant with deposit certificates.

However, during verification, the certificates were found to be fake and forged. The accused individuals projected themselves as authorized representatives and agents working with various financial institutions and lured complainant to make investments in various deposit schemes. A case was registered under relevant sections of law, and during the course of investigation, evidence confirmed the involvement of the accused. Both individuals were taken into custody and are being questioned further. CB Kashmir continues its efforts to investigate economic crimes and bring fraudsters to justice. The general public is advised to stay cautious and verify credentials before making any financial investments.
