

CSIR PI Chek Health Camp concludes at CSIR-IIIM Jammu

JAMMU: CSIR-Indian Institute of Integrative Medicine (CSIR-IIIM), Jammu concluded the four-day Phenome India - CSIR Health Cohort Knowledgebase (PI-CheK) health check-up camp, held from 2nd to 5th August 2025.
