JAMMU: Eminent actor/director and senior alumni of National School of Drama New Delhi, K.K Raina brightened Natrang's International Theatre Talk Show with his inspirational and thought-provoking 'Vision of Theatre' live on Facebook page of Natrang today.

Introducing K K Raina, Natrang's senior actor Anil Tickoo informed that Raina is a senior graduate from National School of Drama and has also pursued Film Appreciation Course from FTII, Pune organized by NSD.

As an actor, he said, Raina did many important characters in the plays under the direction of eminent directors. Other than acting, he has immensely contributed in the field as director also.

In a session, Raina expressed his vision of theatre and also narrated his long, eventful and substantial journey of theatre.

For him, theatre has to provoke, it has to ask questions and it has to show to the society which is not normally seen, moreover, it has to speak to the society by consistently raising relevant issues.

He exemplified how theatre can highlight the things which are not generally visible.

Being himself fascinated by the folk, culture, traditions we inherit, Raina advocated that theatre has to be rooted with the use of our own cultural/folk traditions and most importantly, the language.

Acknowledging the edifying contribution of his gurus and co-artists in shaping his vision, Raina asserted that formal training at NSD proved very beneficial for him to understand different aspects and elements of the theatre and it also opened his



vision.

But suggests to the young aspirants that if they possess strong determination to learn, they may learn from anywhere.

A practitioner, Raina believed in thorough study and understanding of the subject we choose to work on, 'Study before you Start' is Raina's mantra for meaningful work and to understand what we are doing is very important. Recalling his initial theatre endeavours at Kashmir, Raina proudly highlighted the beauty and versatility of 'Bhand Pather'.

He considers theatre to be a dynamic art which changes with the changing times. An everlasting theatre artist at heart, Raina proudly asserts that "Even while acting in films and television, I never left theatre for a single day". Theatre gives immediate response from the audience which has its own charm. He also admits that being a theatre actor is a very difficult thing.

For the sustenance of theatre artists, he suggests that the audience needs to be encouraged to understand that theatre is not a free entertainment and shall come forward for its support.

Raina very logically expressed the importance of theatre in society he believes that theatre does not happen on stage, it happens in the mind of the audience thus rendering a unique creative stimulus to them and to actors, theatre provides the possibility to understand different perspectives of a situation and also to live many lives in a single life.

It is hereby notified that the decision taken regarding promotion of candidates who have already passed two or more subjects in respect of the candidates of Kashmir Division and Winter Zone Areas of Jammu Division and notified vide No:- F (Acad-C) BA-Pvt/19-20/X/II/20 dated:31-08-2020 shall be equally applicable to the candidates who have submitted the Permission cum Admission Forms for SSE (Class 10th) & HSE-II (Class 12th) Annual/Bi-Annual (Pvt.) 2020 Examination of Summer Zone Jammu Division, as per the following mechanism.

- The marks in 5th subject shall be awarded by taking mean of the marks scored in the already passed four subjects.
- The marks in 4th subject shall be awarded by taking mean of the marks scored in the already passed three subjects and marks in the fifth subject shall be awarded by taking Mean of four subjects .
- The marks in 3rd subject shall be awarded by taking mean of the marks scored in already passed two subjects, marks in 4th and 5th subjects shall be awarded by taking mean of the marks scored in three and four subjects respectively.
- All such candidates, who are declared successful in class 10th under the said mechanism, shall be eligible to seek admission in class 11th as Regular Students for the Academic Session 2020-2021.

The candidates who have failed in all Subjects or who have been placed under Reappear Category in four subjects/ Fresh (Private) /English only category of both the 10th and 12th examinations and Subject Change /Additional subject/Divisional Improvement of 12th class shall have to appear in the examination, which shall be conducted after 2nd week of October 2020. The candidates of class 10th under this category shall be granted provisional admission in class 11th Session 2020-21 and in case they fail to qualify 10th class examination their provisional admission to class 11th shall be treated to have been cancelled.

Financial package to help revive businesses, says Kashmir industry

SRINAGAR: Kashmir Chamber of Commerce and Industries (KCCI) on Saturday welcomed the financial package announced by Lieutenant Governor Manoj Sinha for the revival of business in the Union Territory, saying it will give a push to the economy.

"First of all, it is a very good beginning because it was on our demand that the LG formed a time-bound committee. We appreciate the work done by the committee and appreciate their efforts that they could deliver their report in time," KCCI president Sheikh Aashiq told PTI. He said the financial package was the need of the hour. "For the last 14 months, the business fraternity was in a very bad shape and the economy was in big turbulence. This will at least give a push to the economy, if not wholly support it," Aashiq said.

On the government's decision to provide an interest subvention of 5 per cent for six months, the KCCI president said the business fraternity in the UT had demanded it for a period of one year. "Though it has been

announced for six months, it still is good," he said.

Aashiq said the business fraternity appreciates the LG's remarks that this was not the end, but a beginning.

"We expect the Centre will also come out with the support to the demands that we have raised, so that it becomes a comprehensive package," the KCCI president said.

The BJP's Kashmir unit said it is a big relief for the people during the COVID-19 crisis.

The party's Kashmir media-incharge Manzoor Bhat, in a statement, expressed hope the package will boost the ailing business sector in the region.

"On behalf of every BJP worker in Kashmir, I extend my thanks to LG Manoj Sinha administration and central leadership for this package. It will provide relief to poor, farmers, businessmen and citizens. The initiative will help JK to become self-sufficient, he said.

Manzoor said the announcement of the package was the need of the hour. It will bring much-needed relief to several stressed sectors and industries, especially small scale industries, he said.
