**Farooq, Omar condole demise of NC Women Wing Distt President Kishtwar**

JAMMU: National Conference President Dr Farooq Abdullah, Vice President Omar Abdullah and senior leaders have expressed deep grief and shock over the death of NC Women Wing District President Kishtwar Hajan Mariam and her sister in a tragic road mishap and conveyed condolences to the bereaved family.

In a press statement issued here J S Sudan, President AWSC said that medical services in Jammu require immediate attention as people are suffering a lot during ongoing crisis. "Few days back, even Advisor to Lt Governor R R Bhatnagar had visited the GMC Hospital to review the facilities but it seems that nothing has improved on ground level and COVID-19 patients are left at the mercy of God. In a recent case, which went viral on social media, an elderly patient was seen stuck up in an ambulance outside GMC, waiting for hours to get admission even after being referred by DH Gandhi Nagar, on an excuse that patient bed is not available," he added.

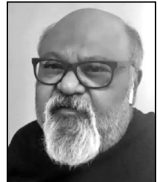
Sudan further said that we very well understand that due to sharp rise in number of corona positive patients in Jammu, shortage of beds was expected but why and where the authorities had been sleeping earlier? Why no preparation was made to create more facilities when it was being done all over the world, he questioned.

The AWSC appealed to the Lt Governor and Advisors to take emergency measures for arranging more beds for corona positive patients, by making necessary arrangements in spacious banquet halls lying vacant or constructing emergency shelter hospitals through Army on war-footing basis to save human lives. If required, another lockdown of 15 days should be imposed in Jammu province forcing people to strictly follow the precautions for containing the rapid spread of COVID-19, he suggested.

In an interaction, Saurabh narrated his humble journey from being an instinctive actor to an accomplished and multi-faceted artist. When he started doing theatre, he recalls nostalgically

that, though acting was not generating money for him but he used to feel a unique satisfaction from it and the feeling was just like a dream to him. A rational thinker, Saurabh felt that the economics of theatre is not so rewarding and the sustainability of theatre and theatre artists is a real complex issue and a large number of theatre practitioners are surviving just because of their sheer passion and commitment to the field. Speaking about acting, he suggested that 'If you want to be a complete actor; you have to know about all the elements and associated arts, theatre is not a singular art, it is an amalgamation of all arts and an actor should have a sense and understanding of everything. Theatre for him is a versatile art which gives freedom to do and learn many things. He also suggested actors to write as writing is imagination and imagination is

what is required to become an actor. He suggested that rather than finding theory or philosophy of life, just live a human life. Speaking about the scope of theatre, he brilliantly asserts that theatre is supposed to do everything that life is supposed to do, theatre is life, so live it. Giving a suggestive distinction between theatre and films, Saurabh said that it is not wise to label some medium as purest and the other as less pure, films have their own culture and purity; there is great work in cinema, moreover art is art, medium of expression may be different. **Advisor Bhatnagar reviews arrangements for COVID-19 patients**

JAMMU: Advisor to Lieutenant Governor, Rajeev Rai Bhatnagar on Saturday chaired a high level meeting to review the arrangements and other facilities for the treatment of COVID-19 patients in Government Medical College (GMC) and Associated Hospitals here. The meeting was attended by Financial Commissioner, Health and Medical Education, Atal Dulloo; Director Health Services, Jammu, Dr. Renu Sharma; Principal GMC, Dr. Nasib Chand Digra; Medical Superintendent GMC, Dr. Keerti Sharma; Medical Superintendent, Govt. Hospital Gandhinagar; Dr. L.D Bhagat; Medical Superintendent Chest Disease Hospital, Dr. Rajeshwar Sharma; HODs of different sections of GMC and other concerned officials. The Advisor directed the officials that Plasma Therapy as approved by the ICMR can be started at the earliest at GMC so that better patient care is provided to the general public. Advisor Bhatnagar asked the officers that dedicated medical teams with specialists from anaesthesia, general medicine and other medical specialities should be constituted and given clear responsibility for proper and effective treatment

of the patients for which they would also be held accountable. Advisor Bhatnagar directed them to ensure that these guidelines are also followed across all the district hospitals and other dedicated COVID health centers of Jammu and Kashmir: He stressed upon the officers that proper patient attendant protocol should also be followed across all hospitals. Advisor Bhatnagar impressed upon the officers that oxygen supply in the hospitals should be properly maintained and effectively used. He asked them to provide oxygen as per the required protocols to

the patients besides the run time control of flow of oxygen should be maintained by experts. Stressing on the effective monitoring of COVID patients and other general patients, the Advisor directed the officials to install CCTV cameras immediately besides the Public Address System should also be installed for better coordination of hospital administration. Advisor Bhatnagar instructed the Principal, GMC to ensure that sufficient medical staff is available there for managing the COVID patients in the Hospital.
