# Shah reviews security situation, development projects in J&K

NEW DELHI: In the wake of Taliban capturing power in Afghanistan, Union Home Minister Amit Shah on Thursday reviewed the security situation in Jammu and Kashmir, which has been witnessing prolonged Pakistan-sponsored terrorism, official sources said.

Shah's meeting with top functionaries of the central government and the Union Territory administration came two days after the Taliban announced its intergovernment Afghanistan.

There have been reports that Pakistan-based terror groups Jaish-e-Mohammad and Lashkar-e-Taiba -- both active in Jammu and Kashmir and involved in a large number of terror attacks in the past -- have shifted their bases to Afghanistan with a friendly Taliban regime in place.

SRINAGAR: Jammu and Kashmir recorded 170 fresh cases of coronavirus on Thursday, taking the infected number of persons to 3,26,480 while no fresh death due to the virus was reported from the Union territory in the past 24 hours, officials said.

Of the fresh cases, 23 were from Jammu division and 147 from Kashmir division of the UT, the officials said.

They said Srinagar district recorded the highest number of 80 cases followed by 22 cases in Baramulla district.
