UDHAMPUR: A conclave on "Nidhi Aapke Nikat" for the UT of Jammu & Kashmir was organized at Udhampur by Ram Parkash District President of J&K Private Schools Association (JKPSA), Jammu in which Rizwan Uddin Regional PF Commissioner-I EPPFO Jammu was the Chief guest. The main purpose of this programme was to highlight the problems/grievances of employees / stakeholders etc, having financial crunches due to continuous closure/lockdown.

While speaking members/proprietors said that, schools authorities are unlucky to pay PF contribution due to non-availability of adequate funds. Due to the closure of the schools in the beginning of the two successive years, there is a

shortfall in revenue. In such circumstances to pay emoluments to teaching and non-teaching staff along with other liabilities has become big challenge. They also highlighted number of differences in their deposit which was made prior to October 2019 in JKEPFO. In response to the queries, Regional PF Commissioner along with Ajit Kumar Mishra (RPFC-II) and Harinder Singh (RPFC-II) said those defaulters are liable to pay interest. Department can only
