DRONE RULES, 2021

- Number of forms reduced from 25 to 5.
Types of fee reduced from 72 to 4.
- Digital sky platform being developed as a single-window system.
- Interactive drone airspace map to be released on 24 September 2021.
- No permission required for operating drones in green zones.
- No security clearance required before issuance of any registration or licence.
- Time-bound issuance of remote pilot licence by DGCA.
- Drone promotion council to be formed with members from academia and industry.

PLI SCHEME FOR DRONES AND COMPONENTS

- PLI of INR 120 crore to be provided over three financial years
- PLI calculated as one-fifth of the value addition made
- PLI rate kept constant at 20% for all three years
- Minimum value addition fixed at 40% of net sales
- Sales turnover criteria for PLI eligibility kept at low levels
- List of eligible components to be expanded from time to time
- Developers of drone-related software are also eligible for PLI
