JAMMU: Principal Secretary to Horticulture Department, Navin Kumar Choudhary, on Friday inaugurated compact Modified High Density Plantation of imported varieties of Guava, Pink, Mango, Alphonso and Kesar at Kadyal Brahma (Kullian), R.S.Pura by planting a Guava sapling on the eve of birthday of Prime Minister, Narendra Modi, during his extensive tour to the area. Director Horticulture Jammu, Ram Sevak, Joint Director Horticulture, Jammu, and the farmers should also lay thrust on cultivation of exotic fruit

C L Sharma, Sarpanches and other officers of the department were present on the occasion.

Navin asked the farmers to adopt diversification of crops in their fields so that they can earn throughout the whole year. He informed them that apart from apple, ultra high density plantation of sub-tropical fruit crops like mango, citrus, guava and litchi was also introduced in Jammu division this year. He said that apart from these fruit crops, the department and the farmers should also lay thrust on cultivation of exotic fruit

crops especially dragon fruit.

He further informed that the department is going to establish first of its kind, Mega Horticulture Nursery at Chakro, R. S. Pura, in 805 kanal of land which will produce High Density Fruit Plants thus catering to the demand of farmers of Jammu division. He impressed upon the farmers to sell their produce through e-commerce thereby getting rid of exploitation by middlemen, ultimately enhancing their income manifold.

He stressed upon the officers to cover 200 acre of land with

plantation of fruit crops in clusters as there is great potential for Horticulture in the area. He added that the process for formation of FPO should be initiated so that after 2-3 years the farmers can get good returns after proper value addition of their produce.

Further, Principal Secretary handed over the keys of Farm machinery including Tractors, Power Tillers besides distributing sanction letters of Custom Hiring Centres among the beneficiaries.

Director Horticulture apprised the Principal

Secretary of progress being made in respect of plantation in sub tropical areas of Jammu division. He informed that for the first time in Jammu division 1600 guava fruit plants are being planted in 20 kanal of land of farmer Sukhdev Singh.

Principal Secretary was accompanied by Director Horticulture, Jammu, Ram Sevak, Joint Director Horticulture, Jammu, C L Sharma, Chief Horticulture Officer, Jammu, S Sarabjit Singh, district level officers and other block level officers and officials of the department.

JAMMU: Chairman, J&K Pollution Control Committee, Suresh Chugh on Friday presided over a felicitation ceremony for volunteers of Disha organization, Trikuta Nagar Welfare Society, students of Government Degree College Marh and GGM Science college for their active participation in the intensive awareness drive regarding use of eco-friendly Ganesha idols to celebrate Ganesh Chaturthi 2021. The awareness drive was conducted with the support of Jammu Municipal Corporation from September 10. The focus was on providing training to artisans for making eco-friendly clay idols using natural herbal colors, creating awareness among common masses regarding harmful environmental impact of using POP made idols, chemical based colors and motivating devotees to make eco-friendly idols themselves using innovative natural ingredients. Chugh, Chairman, JKPCC was the chief guest on the occasion. The felicitation ceremony was attended by B. M. Sharma, Member Secretary, J&K Pollution Control Committee, Dr. Syed Nadeem Hussain, Regional Director JKPCC, Jammu; Rajinder Prasad Kakkar, President, Trikuta Nagar Welfare Society; Dr. Deepali Mahajan of GGM Science college; Professor Anjana Chib of GDC and Professor Shakun Sharma both from GDC Marh and the students of the twin Colleges and volunteers of Disha Organization. In his address, the Chief Guest appreciated the initiative taken by Regional Director JKPCC, Jammu, Dr. Syed Nadeem Hussain and Anuradha, Scientist, JKPCC to organize such awareness drives by involving development societies, NGOs, students and implementing authorities. He encouraged students for their active participation during ten days long awareness drive during COVID Pandemic and expressed gratitude towards all volunteers for their selfless efforts.
