CRIME REPORT

Two women among 5 drug peddlers arrested

JAMMU: Five drug peddlers including two women were arrested along with nearly 3 kgs of Ganja', 21.5 kgs Poppy Straw and 6 gm heroin at different places in Reasi, Udhampur, Kathua and Jammu districts of Jammu and Kashmir, police said on Sunday.

As per the details, during surprise Naka checking at Police Check Post Nomin, police found two women moving in suspicious circumstances and asked to stop.

Accused Rekha Devi , wife of Subash Chander, resident of Railway Road, Kum-Daroorian Katra and Maya Mir, wife of Anwar Mir, resident of Railway Road Katra who were walking from Domail towards Katra were stopped and checked. Both the women were carrying black coloured bags with them. During checking, police recovered 850 gms Ganja like substance from the bag which was carried by Rekha Devi and 1.9 Kg from the bag of other accused Maya Mir. A total 2Kg and 750 gms of Narcotics Ganja like substance recovered from their possession.

Duo was arrested and FIR No 205/2021 under section 8/20 NDPS Act was registered against them at Police Station Katra and.

Another police party recovered 21.5 kgs of poppy straw from a Punjab-bound truck during checking at Jakhani in Udhampur district on Saturday.

The truck was coming from Kashmir when it was stopped for checking, the spokesman said, adding its driver Rakesh Kumar of Kapoorthala in Punjab was arrested and booked under NDPS Act.

Meanwhile, a police team led by SHO Kathua Insp. Om Parkash Chib under the supervision of DySP Headquarters Kathua Shammi Kumar during Naka /checking duty near Sports Stadium Kathua apprehended one suspect namely Sunil Kumar alias Vicky, son of Lt. Mani Ram, resident of Ward No. 02 Tehsil & District Kathua. On thorough checking approx. 06 grams of Heroin like contraband was recovered from his possession. The accused was arrested and FIR No. 418/2021 under section 8/21/22 NDPS Act was registered against him at Police Station Kathua.

In another incident, a Naka was laid by police team of Police Post Sainik Colony led by SHO Police Station Channi Himmat Insp. Karan Chalotra assisted by In-Charge Police Post Sainik Colony Rahul Dogra where they rounded up a suspect who tried to act suspiciously on seeing police. On search, 388 Gms of Ganja was recovered from the possession of accused namely Manoj Kumar, son of Bagh Chand Bansal, resident of Chattarpur MP at present Sector D Sainik Colony Jammu.





## Rs 28,100 fine recovered from SoPs violators in Ramban

RAMBAN: Continuing the enforcement drive to implement Covid protocol across the district Ramban, the Enforcement teams on Sunday fined scores of violators for roaming without wearing face masks and not maintaining physical distance.

The enforcement teams, during the inspection in their respective jurisdictions, recovered a fine of Rs 28,100 taking the total amount fined since April 1, 2021 to Rs. 52,92,850.

The Enforcement officers urged the people to wear face masks and maintain physical distance besides taking Covid vaccination doses at their nearest CVC.

District Immunization Officer, Ramban, Dr. Suresh informed that as many as 2198 persons were administered first and second Covid vaccine doses across Ramban district today.

As per daily bulletin issued by the Chief Medical Officer, Ramban, Dr. Mohammad Fareed Bhat, the Health Department has collected 1017 samples including 269 RT-PCR and 748 RAT samples besides administering Covid vaccine to 2198 persons at dedicated Vaccination Centres in the district.

## Blind murder case solved, accused arrested

Mahesh Sharma did strenuous efforts and with the help of analysis of CCTV footages of different locations along with technical assistance and timely human intervention, identified the driver of the said unknown vehicle and arrested him. The accused driver has been identified as Rakesh Singh, son of Gopal Singh, resident of Doha Thara Dansal, Jammu and the vehicle bearing chassis No. MAT464662MSG09175 involved in the accident has been also recovered and seized. Further investigation of the case is going on.
