CRIME REPORT

Rs 38,100 fine recovered from SOPs violators

KISHTWAR/RAMBAN: The enforcement teams on Tuesday recovered Rs 5100 fine from Covid SOP violators during surprise checking of business establishments and market places here in Kishtwar Township.

On the directions of Deputy Commissioner, a team of officers comprising Naib Tehsildar Executive Magistrate (Hq) Mohammad Abass, Naib Tehsildar Kishtwar/Executive Magistrate Javed Iqbal Khanday along with Police Officers conducted random checking of COVID-19 vaccination certificates, wearing of masks in the market and also in passenger vehicles plying on the link roads of Tehsil Kishtwar regarding Covid Appropriate Behaviour (CAB).

During the random checking, a fine of Rs. 5100 was imposed on the violators.

The officers visited the public places near the bus Stand and Tehsil Office Kishtwar and asked street vendors, shopkeepers, drivers, people on the road and those inside shops without wearing masks to comply with the government directions on COVID-19.

Meanwhile, Continuing the enforcement drive to implement Covid protocol across the district Ramban, the Enforcement teams also fined scores of violators for roaming without wearing face masks and not maintaining physical distance.

The enforcement teams, during the inspection in their respective jurisdictions, recovered a fine of Rs 33,800 taking the total amount fined since April 1, 2021 to Rs. 53,57,950.

The Enforcement officers urged the people to wear face masks and maintain physical distance besides taking Covid vaccination doses at their nearest CVC.

District Immunization Officer, Ramban, Dr, Suresh informed that as many as 3626 persons were administered first and second Covid vaccine doses across Ramban district today.

As per daily bulletin issued by the Chief Medical Officer, Ramban, Dr. Mohammad Fareed Bhat, the Health Department has collected 1579 samples including 376 RT-PCR and 1203 RAT samples besides administering Covid vaccine to 3626 persons at dedicated Vaccination Centres in the district.

Three booked for threatening man on gun point

15 years old girl found hanging, family alleges murder

The actual cause of death will be ascertained after her autopsy report.

Srinagar Admn busts racket involved in producing forged/fake documents; 4 arrested

SRINAGAR: Srinagar Administration on Tuesday busted a racket involved in producing forged/fake documents and arrested four accused persons.

As per the details, acting on a tip off and on the directions of Deputy Commissioner Srinagar, Mohammad Aijaz Asad, a team of the District Administration Sringar headed by Tehsildar Eidgah, with the assistance of SHO Police Station Zadibal laid a successful raid on a Computer Center at Alamgiri Bazar chowk and busted a racket involved in producing forged and fake documents viz income certificates under the fake signatures and seals of Tehsildars of Eidgah, Khanyar and Srinagar Central. Magistrate confiscated the all seals including the seals of CMO and other offices.

During the raid, dozens of fake income certificates, Laptops and cash around Rs 40,000 were also confiscated.

The man accused Zeeshan along with three more accused were arrested and FIR stands registered in Police Station Zadibal in this regard.

Meanwhile a spokesperson of District administration said that matter will be referred to Crime Branch Kashmir.

Two arrested with pistol, rounds
