CRIME REPORT

Woman among two drug peddlers nabbed with 15 Kg Ganja

KATHUA: In its decisive action against drug menace, Kathua Police under the overall supervision of SSP Kathua R C Kotwal on Friday nabbed 2 drug peddlers including a woman with 15 Kilograms of Ganja.

As per details, a police team led by Insp Sumeet Sharma SHO Police Station Lakhampur under the supervision of DySP DAR Kathua Sukhdev Singh during Naka /checking duty noticed two suspects who were directed to stop for checking. On thorough checking, approximately 15 kilograms of Ganja like contraband was recovered from their possession. They were identified as Ravi, son of Suresh, resident of Narwal Bye-Pass, Qasim Nagar Jammu and Rakhi, wife of Surinder, resident of Bari Shani Rajasthan at present staying at Sector 56, Chandigarh. The duo was arrested and FIR No. 100/2021 under sections 8/20 of NDPS Act was registered against them at Police Station Lakhampur.

Smuggler on bail re-arrested with drugs

Police has again recovered drugs from him and sent it to the Forensic Science Laboratory for examination. A case has been registered against accused under NDPS Act at Nowabad Police Station.

road on Thursday night for checking. Seeing police Naka, a man coming on a two-wheeler stopped some distance away from the Naka, turned back his vehicle and started running back. Suspecting his activities, the policemen chased him and overpowered him. During frisking, police recovered a packet from his pocket containing powder which was sent to Forensic Science Laboratory for examination. He was arrested and a case has been registered against him.

Missing woman's body found from Chenab

Pertinent to mention here that the woman went missing last week, as she didn't return back home from fields.

Rs 26,900 fine recovered from SoP violators in Ramban

RAMBAN: Continuing the enforcement drive to implement COVID protocol across the district Ramban, the Enforcement teams on Friday fined scores of violators for roaming without wearing face masks and not maintaining physical distance. The enforcement teams, during the inspection in their respective jurisdictions, recovered a fine of Rs 26,900 taking total amount fined since April 1, 2021 to Rs 54,38,200.

The Enforcement officers urged the people to wear face masks and maintain physical distance besides taking COVID vaccination doses at their nearest CVC. District Immunization Officer, Ramban, Dr Suresh informed that as many as 3,416 persons were administered first and second COVID vaccine doses across Ramban district. As per daily bulletin issued by the Chief Medical Officer, Ramban, Dr Mohammad Fareed Bhat, the Health Department has collected 1,494 samples including 352 RT-PCR and 1,142 RAT samples besides administering COVID vaccine to 3,416 persons at dedicated Vaccination Centres in the district.
