Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016, Amended 2021

- Polythene Carry Bags below 75 microns have been banned by GoI w.e.f. 30th September 2021.
- Non-Woven Plastic Carry Bags below 60Gram Per Square Meter (GSM) are also banned by GoI w.e.f. 30th September 2021.
- Units already consented by JK PCC which manufacture Polythene Carry Bags (above 50 microns) and Non-woven carry bags, are advised to switch over to 75 microns thickness instead of 50 microns and Non-woven plastic carry bags to more than 60 GSM, immediately, failing to comply the Rules shall attract strict legal action.
- Each Polythene Carry Bag and Non-woven Carry Bag must have stamp of 75 microns or more thickness and 60 GSM respectively, with name of manufacturer etc. as per Rules.

 General Public is also advised to stop purchase and use of Polythene Carry bags below 75 microns and Non-woven Plastic Carry Bags below 60 GSM w.e.f. 30th September 2021, to reduce plastic foot-prints for clean and pollution free Jammu and Kashmir.
