

Performance of Polytechnic College, ITI in Shopian reviewed

SHOPIAN: The District Magistrate (DM) Shopian, Sachin Kumar Vaishya on Sunday reviewed the performance and working of Polytechnic College and ITI Shopian.

During the meeting, the DC emphasised on the officers to focus on restoring the normal life in the College and ITI as it used to be few years earlier.

He maintained that polytechnics are meant to provide the middle level workers in the industry and engineering sector. He termed the workforce

very important in terms of quality output of projects and industrial products.

Vaishya asked the officers to inculcate the necessary engineering acumen among the students in the college so that they come up as best executives of works being entrusted upon them.

The DM asked the Principal Polytechnic College for increasing enrolment by conducting awareness programme in Schools. He urged to expose them to the actual industrial environment and devise plans for providing them the neces-

sary training in industrial houses and project sites where they would get to know the nuances and niceties of their trade.

He also emphasised on inclusion of latest trends and working of latest machinery in the curriculum of the courses offered in polytechnics. He asked them to train the students instead of only handing them with certificates.

The DC exhorted upon them to bring out quality engineers out of the polytechnics so that they find gainful jobs locally and nationally. He asked them to conduct placement drives for the pass outs and establish placement cells in the college in association with the industrial partners. He further said that industrial partnership for each college should be envisaged for better functioning and outcome of the polytechnics on the analogy of Institute Management Committee (IMC) in ITI. He also emphasised the need for creating more branches in polytechnic colleges.

Thakur lays foundation of ZPEO, playfield; inaugurates PMGSY road

GANDERBAL: Union Minister for Information and Broadcasting and Youth Affairs and Sports, Anurag Singh Thakur on Sunday laid foundation stone of ZPEO and Zonal Play Field and inaugurated PMGSY road at Kichpora Kangan.

The Minister visited Kichpora Kangan where he laid foundation stone of Zonal Physical Education Office (ZPEO) and Development of Zonal Level Playfield approved at a cost of Rs 1.14 crore.

Addressing the gathering, the Minister maintained that there is no dearth of talent in the UT of J&K but the need is to channelize that talent. The youth of J&K need facilities and Central Government will ensure all the facilities making sure that talent flourishes in the region, he added.

He maintained that the Union Government is committed to further strengthen the existing sports infrastructure and facilities for the UT so that more and more youth join sports and represent J&K at various levels.

In order to do so the Central Government has earmarked an amount of Rs 200

crore under PM Development Plan for the development of playfields and indoor stadiums, he said. He further said that Rs 33 crore more are approved for preparing synthetic turfs, hockey and football grounds in J&K.

He also urge the gathering to join the country wide month long "Clean India Mission" starting on October 01, 2021.

Welcoming the Minister, Advisor to Lieutenant Governor, Farooq Ahmad Khan lauded the efforts of Union Government for organising this mega outreach programme to the UT of J&K. He expressed hope that this visit of Union minister will give impetus to the sports activities of the region.

Deputy Commissioner Ganderbal Kritika Jyotsna, Director Youth Services and Sports, SSP Ganderbal and other officials of the department were also present on the occasion.

Later, the Minister distributed certificates, mementos and sports kits among the students during a colourful function held at Kichpora Kangan.

On the occasion, the Minister also witnessed cultural program and demo of

various sports competitions in Marshall Arts, Tug of War, Kabbadi and Volleyball.

The Minister also interacted with the students and urged them to actively participate in sports activities and asked them to bring laurels to the J&K by proving their mettle in national and international events.

Earlier, the Minister also inaugurated the 1.5 km

PMGSY road constructed at the cost of Rs 136.67 lakh at Bonibagh Kangan connecting Bonibagh Bala habitation to the highway.

Dedicating the road to the people of the village, the Minister congratulated the concerned Sarpanch, BDC and DDC member who were present on the occasion for putting in their strenuous efforts for removing impediments in finishing the road held up for more than a decade.

Meanwhile, he also interacted with locals of Bonibagh and enquired about the development needs in the area. The locals complemented the Minister for visiting the area and inaugurating the said road which was long pending demand of the locals.
