# Bootlegger arrested with 28 bottles of illicit liquor

 JAMMU: Police on Monday arrested a bootlegger and recovered 28 bottles of illicit liquor from his possession.

As per details, team of Chowki Choura Police led by Inspector AnkaJ Bhagat Incharge Police Post Chowki Choura arrested a bootlegger namely Vicky Kumar; son of Vijay Kumar; resident of Village Rah Siyote Tehsil Chowki Choura Jammu along with 28 bottles of illicit liquor: FIR No. 251/2021 under section 48 (A) of Excise Act was registered against him.

## Inter-state peddler nabbed with over 2 Kg Ganja

 JAMMU: Police on Monday nabbed a narco-smuggler and recovered 2 Kg 400 gm Ganja from his possession.

As per details, during special Naka was by team of Police Station Satwari led by SHO Satwari Insp Deepak Jasrotia under the supervision of SDPO South PK Mengi, rounded up a suspect namely Biru Chandra, son of Saheb Chandra, resident of Navagaon, Tehsil Malkharoda District Janjgir Champa (Chattisgarh) and on search, 2 Kg 400 gm Ganja was recovered from his possession. He was arrested and FIR No. 225/21 under section 8/20 NDPS Act was registered against him at Police Station Satwari. The overall arrest and recovery was made under the supervision of SP City South Deepak Digra.

## Man arrested for taking class-X exam on behalf of relative

The arrested youth was identified as Rohit Kumar; son Ramesh Kumar; resident of Janipur Jammu. He was taking exam on behalf of his relative namely Chandra Kumar; resident of Vijaypur.

According to the information, Principal of school, Fateh Singh, got information that a youth namely Rohit Kumar is taking paper on behalf of one Chandra Kumar. Principal engaged the staff including the supervisor who was taking the examination for investigation, who found that on Chandra Kumar's roll number; his

lookalike relative is present.

Principal informed Vijaypur police about the matter who reached the school and arrested the impersonator: Principal Fateh Singh has also lodged a written complaint with police in this regard.

## 3 drug peddlers arrested, contraband recovered

 SRINAGAR: Continuing its efforts to eradicate the menace of drugs from the society, Police on Monday arrested 3 drug peddlers in Bandipora & Handwara and recovered contraband substances from their possession.

In Bandipora, acting on specific information, a Police party from Police Station Sumbal under the supervision of SDPO Sumbal Surinder Mohan at a checkpoint established at Bazipora Ajas intercepted a vehicle bearing registration number JK15A-8320 driven by Manzoor Ahmad Rather; son of Mohammad Maqbool Rather; resident of Bazipora Ajas Sumbal. During checking, officers were able to recover 600 Capsules of Tramadol Hydrochloride from his possession. He was arrested and shifted to Police Station where he remained in custody. Vehicle used in the commission of crime has also been seized.

In Handwara, officers from Police Station Vilgam at a checkpoint established at Dolipora junction intercepted a vehicle bearing registration number JK09C-1530 with two persons onboard. They were identified as Abdul Hamid Khan, son of Gh Mohiudin Khan, resident of Dolipora and Nisar Ahmad Khan, son of Showkat Ahmad Khan, resident of Nelipora Magam. During checking, officers recovered 20 grams of Brown Sugar from their possession. They were arrested and shifted to Police Station where they remain in custody. Vehicle used in the commission of crime has also been seized. Accordingly, cases under relevant sections of law have been registered in respective police stations and further investigations have been initiated. During preliminary investigation it surfaced that the accused drug peddlers are involved in supplying drugs in the area.

## Enforcement teams recover Rs 20,500 fine from SoPs violators

## CBI conducts raid at EPFO Jammu, seizes record for scrutiny

 JAMMU: After receiving a series of complaints regarding alleged misappropriation of funds by officials and management of Employees Provident Funds Organization (EPFO), a team of officers from the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) raided EPFO office in Jammu on Monday and seized huge quantity of records and relevant documents for detailed scrutiny.

As per an official spokesperson of the investigating agency, the sleuths of CBI carried out raid in the premises of Employees

Provident Funds Organization (EPFO), Jammu, as numerous complaints were pouring in regarding malpractices of officials and embezzlement of huge funds, especially done during lockdown period. "Some complainants also alleged that huge funds, amounting to crores, have been misappropriated by the officials in the name of false claims, thereby causing huge damage to Government exchequer. During the raid, the team seized relevant records and documents for detailed scrutiny besides interrogating officials for the allegations," he added. The spokesperson further added stern action will be initiated against all those found guilty, after scrutiny of the relevant documents.

## Man run over by train in Jammu

 JAMMU: A 42-year-old man died after being run over by a train on outskirts of Jammu on Monday, an official said. Baldev Raj, a resident of Dewan village, was reportedly crossing track at Ratnuchak at around 8 AM, when he was run over by the train, the official said. He said that body of deceased was shifted to the hospital for post-mortem and would be handed over to family after completion of legal formalities.

## Two drug peddlers arrested with heroin, Rs 50,300 cash

 KATHUA/SURANKOTE: Police on Monday nabbed two drug peddlers and recovered heroin and cash from their possession.

As per the details, a police team led by Insp Om Parkash Chib SHO Kathua under supervision of DySP Headquarters Kathua Shammii Kumar during patrolling duty at Kullian Chack Drab Khan noticed two suspects on a Scooter (JK08-6266), who was directed to stop for checking. Sensing danger; the rider turned back and managed to flee while other person was arrested. On thorough checking, 8.50 gm heroin like contraband and cash amounting to Rs. 50,300 was recovered from possession of pillion rider namely Amar Kumar; son of Ashok Kumar; resident of Kullian Chack Drab Khan, Kathua who further disclosed the name of rider as Shehzaad alias Chottu, son of Akhter Khan, resident of Upper Mohalla Chack Drab Khan Kathua. The vehicle was seized and FIR No. 425/2021 under sections 8/21/22/29 of NDPS Act was registered against accused at Police Station Kathua.

Meanwhile, a party led by SHO Surankote Jatinder Singh Sambyal laid a Naka at Link Road Jaranwalli Gali to conduct checking of vehicles. The team intercepted one Parvaiz Iqbal, son of Mohd Rashid, resident of Village Gursai Mohri Tehsil Mendhar; District Poonch and on thorough search, recovered heroin like substances weighing about 13 grams from possession of accused. He was arrested and FIR No 339/21 under sections 8/21/22 NDPS of Act was registered against accused at Police station Surankote.
