

Central Ministers on sabbatical in J&K at public expense: Harsh

KUD: "With rest of the states of the country facing turmoil and disturbances in the wake of raging inflation and farmers agitation, the Union Ministers appear to have chosen the peaceful and calm environs of J&K for a pleasant break. These Central Ministers are on a sabbatical in J&K on govt expense far away from the heat generated by the protesters across the nation over anti people policies of Govt and other issues. The places of visit have been randomly selected by the said Ministers in consultation with their local party colleagues ensuring that troublesome areas are omitted from their itinerary and disgruntled people are avoided".

This was stated by Harsh Dev Singh, JKNPP Chairman and former Minister while addressing NPP's Leadership Training and Public Awareness Camp

Pointing towards the media reports that the Union Ministers were visiting J&K to aware the people about benefits of abrogation of Art 370 and withdrawal of special status, Singh said that people of J&K knew more about the after effects of Art 370 than the visiting Ministers.

"The said Ministers were indulging in inaugurations of some petty development works having nothing to offer to the people of J&K with their speeches full of tired shibboleths. It was not

understandable as to how the same could help them achieve their objective of educating people. It was further not clarified as to what prompted them to visit J&K with the aforesaid motive two years after the scrapping of Art 370 and downgrading of the state into UTs", asserted Singh. Taking a pot-shot at the Ministers for making announcements of some development schemes, Singh said that majority of them were already ongoing projects. And several other announcements were only a repetition of the promises

made earlier, said Singh. Asserting that Ministers' sojourn to J&K under the name and style of "Public outreach programme" was only an eyewash,

Singh said that it had nothing to do with the aspirations of the people. The people were being hardly taken on board during the said programmes. It was a one way communication from the Ministers who believed in monologues only. The people in general were not allowed to ventilate their feelings or to project their grievances during the programmes of Ministers. And such being the nature of the so called Public outreach programmes, they had evoked more of a cynicism than appreciation. These sojourns to J&K had in essence proved as pleasure trips of Central Ministers who had opted for a peaceful J&K as against the all other disturbed states of the country bearing the brunt of opposition's onslaughts and protests over multifarious issues", maintained Singh.

Yashpaul Kundal exhorted the people to strengthen the Panthers Party as it alone could navigate the people of Jammu region. He said that NPP indulging in equitable treatment to both the regions of J&K without any bias or ill will against the region.

DC Reasi pulls up banks over pendency in clearance of self-employment scheme proposals

REASI: Deputy Commissioner Reasi, Charandeep Singh on Monday pulled up banks over pendency in clearance of self-employment scheme proposals. He issued strict instructions to all the banks to clear the pendency on a fast-track basis.

The Deputy Commissioner was chairing a meeting to review the progress of Self-employment schemes & quality of credit extension to various employment generation schemes in the district.

At the outset, the Deputy Commissioner took a serious note of the non-serious approach of some banks regarding non-achievement of the previously conveyed targets. He made a number of observations including reports of improper crowd management in some Bank branches, delay in disposal of the pending cases of beneficiaries under various self-employment

schemes, pendency in Aadhar seeding of beneficiaries' bank accounts etc. He highlighted that banks have a very crucial role to play in ensuring the success of the welfare schemes being implemented by the government including the self-employment schemes.

"The financial component in government schemes requires dedicated efforts on part of banking institutions. The schemes like MUMKIN, PMEGP, PMAY etc. that have provision of financial assistance for the identified beneficiaries will be successful only if the pending cases are disposed of in a time bound manner," he added.

The DC also reviewed the performance of banks in organising Financial Literacy Camps (FLCs) in places identified by the district administration in the previous meeting and took a serious view of non-achievement of these targets. He issued directions to the

bank representatives to complete the targets by September 30th and submit the progress report in this regard.

Additional District Development Commissioner, Reasi, Jyoti Slathia; ACD, Dr. Anirudh Rai; CPO, Sumita Kanchan; GM DIC, Gurudev Kumar; among other District Officers and representatives from various banks were present in the meeting.

It is pertinent to mention here that PLCs/SDLCs have already been notified in the district which shall submit the claims to DLC in a time-bound manner after proper verification. The meeting decided to organise special panchayat level

awareness camps to educate the stakeholders about the Forest Rights Act.

The Deputy Commissioner directed the concerned to conduct mapping of the forest areas in the district. He urged the officers to work with added zeal for effective implementation of FRA in the district.

The meeting also finalised the arrangements for district-level training under Forest Right Act to be held on the 28th of Sept.

The meeting was attended by DFO Rajouri, Arshdeep Singh; DFO Nowshera, Neelima; Warden Wildlife.
