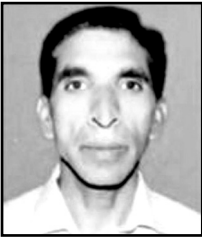

CRIME REPORT

Police arrests two extortionists

SRINAGAR: Police in a series of action in Kulgam and Bandipora arrested 02 extortionists involved in extorting money from gullible people. Extorted cash and a knife also recovered from their possession.

In Kulgam, Police received a written complaint from one Shabir Ahmad Bhat resident of Bachroo stating that a person namely Mohammad Iqbal Bhat, resident of Bachroo extorted money from him in the name of Police department. The accused person threatened him that Police will arrest him as he was earlier involved in drug peddling and demanded Rs 50,000 from him to avoid arrest. The complainant paid him Rs 20,000 in advance as he was frightened that he may be arrested by Police for the unknown crime.

Accordingly, a case vide FIR No. 205/2021 under relevant sections of law was registered in Police Station Kulgam and started investigation into the matter.

A special investigating team led by SHO Kulgam under the supervision of DySP Hqrs Kulgam Shri Ghulam Muhammad Bhat swung into action and arrested the accused & also recovered the extorted money from his possession. During questioning, the accused confessed about his involvement into the pre-planned crime. Further investigation of the case is in progress.

In Bandipora, Police received information that some miscreants impersonating as terrorists were extorting money from people during evening hours in different areas of Bandipora town. Accordingly, a case under relevant sections of law was registered at Police Station Bandipora and investigation was initiated.

During the course of investigation, officers taking assistance of modern techniques and human leads were able to zero in one suspect namely Aejaaz Ahmad Sheikh, resident of Bandipora. Subsequently, he was arrested and during questioning he confessed his involvement in the commission of crime. On his disclosure, weapon of offence (knife) used in the commission of crime was also recovered. Further investigation into the matter is in progress.

Drug peddler arrested; contraband substances recovered

KULGAM: Acting tough against the drug dealings in Kulgam, Police on Tuesday arrested a drug peddler and recovered contraband substance from his possession. Besides, 15 kgs of poppy straw was also recovered on disclosure of an already arrested drug peddler. As per the details, a party from Police Station Qazigund during patrolling in the jurisdiction of Police Station Qazigund intercepted a suspicious person carrying a bag. He has been identified as Aabid Ahmad Shah, son of Mohd Yousuf Shah, resident of Churatt. During checking, officers recovered 400 grams of Charas from his possession. He has been arrested and FIR No. 217/2021 under relevant sections of law was registered against him in Police Station Qazigund.

In another action, officers during the investigation of case FIR No. 202/2021 of Police Station Kulgam, the arrested accused namely Aashiq Hussain Mir alias Sikander, son of Abdul Hameed Mir, resident of Okey Kulgam further disclosed the presence of additional contraband substance in a vehicle at his native village Okey. Subsequently, a police party led by DySP Hqrs Kulgam Ghulam Muhammad Bhat along with SHO Kulgam raided the specific location and recovered 15 Kgs of Poppy Straw loaded in a vehicle (Load carrier). The vehicle used in the commission of crime has also been seized.

Police carries bung destruction drive

SRINAGAR: Continuing its efforts to eradicate the menace of drugs from the society, Police on Tuesday destroyed bung cultivation in Trigam Sumbal, Narayan Bagh, Dab, Shalhar & Khan Mohalla areas of Bandipora and Ganderbal.

In Bandipora, a police team from Police Station Sumbal under the supervision of SDPO Sumbal Shri Surender Mohan-JKPS have destroyed wild bung in Trigam area.



Similarly in Ganderbal, a party of Police Post Shadipora under the supervision of DySP Hqrs Ganderbal carried out a bung destruction drive along with Revenue Department in Narayan Bagh, Dab, Shalhar and Khan Mohalla areas of Ganderbal.

Bootlegger held with 4 bottles of illicit liquor

KATHUA: In its drive against the trade of illicit liquor menace in the district, Kathua Police under the overall supervision of SSP Kathua R C Kotwal on Tuesday seized 4 bottles of illicit liquor Katli and arrested a bootlegger.

As per the details, a police team led by SHO Malhar Inspector Tariq Ahmed under the supervision of SDPO Billawar Arvind Kumar during special checking duty in its jurisdictional area near Katli apprehend one suspicious person who was asked to stop for checking. During checking, 04 bottles of JK Excise Whisky (illicit liquor) 750ml each were recovered from his possession. The accused namely Jeet Kumar, son of Sita Ram, resident of Malad teh. Lohai Malhar was arrested and FIR No 27/2021 under section 48(F) Excise Act was registered against him at Police Station Malhar.

Kidnapped woman traced after 8 years

KATHUA: In its efforts to minimise crime of the district, Kathua Police under the overall supervision of SSP Kathua R C Kotwal on Tuesday traced out one kidnapped woman after 08 long years.

As per the details, a police team led by SHO Malhar Insp. Tariq Ahmed under the supervision of SDPO Billawar Arvind Kumar managed to recover a kidnapped woman namely, resident of Lohai, Tehsil Lohai Malhar after 08 long years. In this connection a case vide FIR No. 20/2013 under section 363/109 RPC dated November 12, 2013 already stands registered at Police Station Malhar. The aforesaid woman was produced before JMFC Billawar for recording statement under section 164 CrPC and after completing legal formalities handed over to family members while further investigation is underway.

Rs 45,200 fine recovered from violators in Ramban

RAMBAN: Continuing the drive to implement Covid protocol across the district Ramban, the Enforcement teams on Tuesday fined scores of violators for roaming without wearing face masks and not maintaining physical distance.

The enforcement teams, during the inspection in their respective jurisdictions, recovered a fine of Rs 45,200 taking the total amount fined since April 1, 2021 to Rs. 49,34, 850.

The Enforcement officers urged the people to wear face masks and maintain physical distance besides taking Covid vaccination doses at their nearest CVC.

District Immunization Officer, Ramban, Dr, Suresh informed that as many as 1789 persons were administered first and second Covid vaccine doses across Ramban district on Tuesday.

As per daily bulletin issued by the Chief Medical Officer, Ramban, Dr. Mohammad Fareed Bhat, the Health Department has collected 1440 samples including 400 RT-PCR and 1040 RAT samples besides administering Covid vaccine to 1789 persons at dedicated Vaccination Centres in the district.

2 notorious drug peddlers caught with drugs, cash

JAMMU: Tightening its noose against drug peddlers, police on Tuesday caught two drug peddlers with drugs and money generated after selling drugs. As per the details, an alert Naka of Miran Sahib Police at ring road after generating a specific input of travelling of drug peddlers intercepted a Maruti Alto car (JK02CM -2895) for checking.

Instead of stopping at the Naka, the duo in the car tried to flee but were tactfully overpowered by the Police Party of Miran Sahib Police Station led by SHO Miran Sahib Mirza Sultan under the supervision of SDPO RS Pura Shabir Khan.

After disclosing their identity as Sanjeev Kumar alias Chotu and Jagdeep Kumar, both sons of Gulzari Lal, residents of Ban Sultan Miran Sahib, police searched the car and also personal search was conducted.

During search a sharp edged weapon, 30 gms heroine like substance and Rs 1,62300 cash was recovered from their possession.

Duo was arrested and FIR no 105/2021 under section 8/21/22/27/29 NDPS Act, 353 IPC and 4/25 Arms Act was lodged at PS Miran Sahib against them. Whole operation was conducted under the supervision of SP Hqrs Jammu Rammish Gupta.



Man killed, 3 injured as 2 trucks fall into gorge after collision

BANIHIAL: A man was killed and three others injured when two trucks collided and fell into a deep gorge along the Jammu-Srinagar National Highway in Ramban district here, police said on Tuesday.

Both the vehicles were on their way to Srinagar and the accident took place near Monkey Morh in Ramban district at around 5.15 am, they said.

Preliminary investigation revealed that the truck driven by 30-year-old Raju Ram of Rajasthan hit the other due to rash and negligent driving, as a result of which both vehicles fell into a 250-ft-deep gorge, they said.

The rescuers, including police, Army and local volunteers, recovered the body of Anuj Kumar (40), a resident of Kartholi area in Uttar Pradesh who was driving the other truck, officials said.

They said Ram and two others were rescued in an injured condition and shifted to the district hospital in Ramban.

A case under relevant sections was registered at Ramban police station, officials said.

Fraudsters dupe woman of Rs 40,000 by changing ATM card

JAMMU: A woman was duped by two fraudsters of Rs 40,000 by changing her ATM card at Ghummat area of Tuesday.

As per the details, Parvesh Kumar, son of Taramani, resident of Pata Bohri, Talab Tillo lodged a complaint with police that on September 2, his mother went to ATM for withdrawing money in Ghumanat area. "Two youths which were already in the ATM offered her help and fraudulently changed her ATM card with fake one" he said adding that later the fraudsters, withdrawn Rs 39,500 by using my mother's ATM card". Police has registered a case and started investigation. CCTV footage of the ATM is also being scrutinized to identify the accused persons.

Thieves burgled Jawan's house, decamp with jewellery
