Three SHOs among five Inspectors transferred

JAMMU: Senior Superintendent of Police (SSP) Chandan Kohli on Wednesday transferred three Station House Officers (SHOs).

According to the order, Inspector Ajeet Singh has been transferred from Police Station Pacea Danga and posted at DPL Jammu, Inspector Raghubir Singh has been transferred from Police Station Gangyal and posted at Police Station Pacea Danga as SHO and Inspector Pardeep Kumar has been transferred from DPL Jammu and posted at Police Station Gangyal as SHO.

Meanwhile, DIG JKS Range transferred two inspectors to Kathua district.

According to the order, Inspector Balram Sharma posted in Jammu district has been transferred to District Police Lines Kathua while Rakesh Singh posted in Samba has also been transferred to Kathua district.

Court rejects bail of Narco Smuggler

JAMMU: Additional Sessions Judge Kathua Kamlesh Pandit rejected the bail application of one Mohd Imran Khan who was facing trial in NDPS Case. According to the police case that accused person is involved in case under FIR No. 64/2019 for commission of offences under sections 8/15/29 NDPS Act for carrying bukki(poopy straw) to the tune of 470 kg which is much much beyond even the commercial quantity as notified under NDPS Act .

Additional Sessions Judge Kathua Kamlesh Pandit after hearing both the sides observed that court is conscious about the precious right to liberty of the accused person, but at the same time the action of the accused person is also to be taken into consideration while balancing between individual interest and the public interest. The illegal trafficking and trade in Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic substances has posed potential threat to the whole society as it is eating the very vitals of the society and

the menace of traffickers is spreading its tentacles to every nook and corner of the U.T of Jammu & Kashmir cannot be ignored when the recovery of contraband is on the higher side. The release of accused person at this stage will definitely have its adverse affect on the trial. The drug traffickers like accused person are spreading the addiction of Narcotics & Psychotrpic substances among the human race especially youth section of society making them slaves of the same, who when become addicts not only spoil their lives but also ruin the lives of their family members. Therefore, the release of such accused person at this stage will not meet the ends of justice. Consequently in the facts and circumstances of the instant case, the apprehension of the prosecution appears to be reasonable that once the accused person is admitted to bail, he will not debar himself from tampering with evidence, repeating the offence and hindering the further trial in the case also. With these observations Court rejected the bail application.

Court directs DC to attach property of Ex-MLA

JAMMU: Chief Judicial Magistrate Jammu Amarjeet Singh Langeh today directed Deputy Commissioner Jammu to attach moveable property of Radhey Sham Sharma (Ex-M.L.A) to the tune of amount in the award under execution as mentioned herein above and submit compliance report by or before next date of hearing. CJM Jammu Amarjeet Singh Langeh observed that Eight petitioners entered into settlement with respondent no. 1 who, as per execution petition and Memorandum of Settlement is proprietor of M/S Shanker Ice Factory & Cold Storage. In terms of said settlement, respondent no. 1 was obliged to deposit aforesaid amount with Assistant Labour Commissioner, Jammu by or before 23.05.2016 but

he failed. Thereafter, on 31.12.2016 Assistant Labour Commissioner, Jammu who is authority under the Payment of Wages Act, 1936, presented this execution petition under section 15(5) of the Act seeking realisation of aforesaid amount from the respondent no. 1 for disbursement to the petitioners.

CJM Jammu observed that there is a clear obligation undertaken by Radhey Sham Sharma (Ex-M.L.A), proprietor of M/S Shanker Ice Factory & Cold Storage in terms of Settlement Deed supra that he would make payment to eight petitioners to the tune of Rs 11,12,000/- (rupees eleven lac twelve thousand only) as mentioned in Memorandum of Settlement which is annexed with this petition. 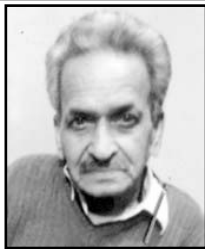

DC Doda asks NHIDCL to install crash barriers; evict encroachments along NH

DODA: To take the first hand appraisal of the implementation of the Road Safety measures, Deputy Commissioner Doda, Vikas Sharma on Wednesday conducted extensive inspection along the National Highway (NH) 244, besides, discussed other public issues with the concerned authorities.

En-route from the Doda town towards Assar, the DC inspected vulnerable/black-spots at Pul Doda, Khaleni, Malhori, Kanderi, Jathi and Assar area which require immediate attention of the concerned quarters.

He directed the NHIDCL authorities to widen the identified spots to avert the mishaps and to ensure the safety of the commuters. Besides, he asked them to install crash barriers and milestones at all the required spots.

The DC also directed the ACR Doda to evict the encroachments along the National Highway in coordination with the NHIDCL authorities.

The ARTO and Revenue Officials were asked to identify land as per the required specification for the construction of the Driving test institute.

The DC informed the Road Safety Committee that the road safety measures and public safety is the top most priority of the LG which needs to be implemented in letter and spirit in the district.

Earlier, the DC convened a meeting in his office chamber with NHIDCL and Revenue Officials to discuss the issues pertaining to the construction of alternate Sudhamahadev Khaleni, Thathri highway and Thathri to Chamba highway.

The DC directed the mediating Committee to take up all the issues projected by NHIDCL with the concerned authorities to resolve the same at the earliest so that hassle free construction of the ambitious project shall be carried out in the district.

Among others ACR Doda, GM NHIDCL, Tehsildar Headquarter, ARTO Doda accompanied the DC during the inspection, besides the meeting was attended by ASP Doda, DTI Doda, and other officers of NHIDCL.

etor of M/S Shanker Ice Factory & Cold Storage undertook to make said payment in five installments with minimum interval of two months and this obligation he made on 25.04.2016. He had to clear this amount by June 25, 2021 but he failed to clear it till date.

Having undertaken to discharge obligation as aforesaid, now respondent no. 1 cannot play hide and seek to the utter disadvantage of petitioners and that too not only against the binding award but also in brazen contravention of statute like Payment of Wages Act. This recalcitrant disposition of respondent proprietor has the propensity to only derive petitioners to great deal of hardship, for over five years to be precise. He cannot play along like this.

Upon this Court ordered

that let an attachment warrant be issued against respondent no. 1, the Proprietor, authorising therein District Collector (Deputy Commissioner), Jammu to attach moveable property of respondent no. 1, the proprietor to the tune of Rs. 8,62,000/- (rupees Eight lac sixty two thousand only) and submit compliance report by or before next date of hearing.

It however is clarified that should respondent no. 1, the proprietor deposit an amount of Rs. 8,62,000/- (rupees Eight lac sixty two thousand only) during execution of attachment warrant in question, in that eventuality District Collector (Deputy Commissioner), Jammu shall cause that amount to be received and deposited in this court for onward disbursement to petitioners.

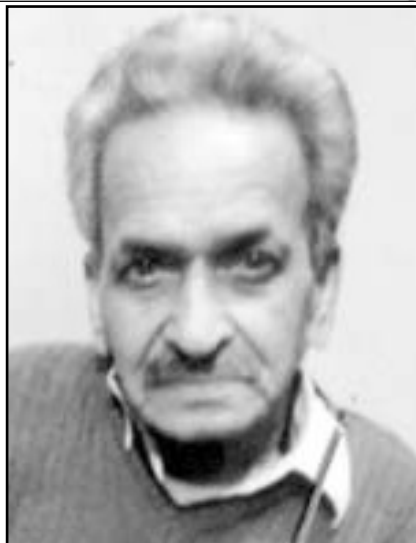
