CRIME REPORT

Four burglary cases solved, 8 arrested

SRINAGAR: Police has solved 4 burglary cases by arresting 8 accused persons



involved in crime besides recovering stolen property worth lakhs of rupees. As per details, four burglary cases were reported at Police Station Ganderbal and accordingly, FIR Nos 257/2022, 146/2022, 216/2022 and 240/2022 under relevant sections of law were registered. A special team led by SHO Ganderbal was constituted by SSP Ganderbal under supervision of Dy SP Hqrs Ganderbal.
The investigating team swiftly cracked all four burglary cases and arrested 8 accused involved in crime, who were identified as Zahoor Ahmad Najar, son of Gh Mohd, resident of Fethapora Ganderbal; Asif Hussain Yattoo, son of Gh Hassan, resident of Sultanpora Baramulla; Muneer Ahmad Fmda, son of Ghulam Younis, resident of Sarafraw Kangan; Mohd Shabir Magray, son of Mohd Shafi, resident of Sahardhaka Udhampur; Shaheel Ahmad Bijad, son of Mohd Ishaq, resident of Judiylal Rajouri; Rubul Mestry, son of Shams-ud-Din, resident of Gurgaon Haryana, at present Beehama Ganderbal; Safikul Islam, son of Umer Ali & Kutab-ud-Din, son of Mannan, both residents of Delhi, at present Beehama Ganderbal. On their disclosure, stolen property including 12 batteries, a gold coin, 3 cows and a calf were recovered. Moreover, a vehicle (Auto) bearing registration number JK01P-4078, used in commission of crime, was also seized.

Two drug-peddlers arrested with contraband

SRINAGAR: Continuing its efforts to curb menace of drugs, Police has arrested 2 drug peddlers in Anantnag and recovered contraband substance from their possession. As per details, Police Station Srigufwara received information through reliable sources that one Javid Ahmad Bhat, son of Gh Mohi-ud-din Bhat, resident of Sirhama Srigufwara is indulged in drug peddling and has hoarded a large quantity of narcotics in his house. On receipt of information, a party from Police Station Srigufwara along with Executive Magistrate concerned raided the location and recovered 6.2 Kg Bhang Bhoosa. The accused was arrested and shifted to Police Station where he remained in custody. Meanwhile in another action, officers from Police Post Janglatmandi, at a checkpoint established at Ashajipora bridge, intercepted a suspect, later identified as Hashim Mushtaq Bhat, son of Mushtaq Ahmad Bhat, resident of Dabruna, Anantnag. During search, 800 gm Bhang Bhoosa was recovered from his possession. He was arrested and shifted to Police Station where he remained in custody. Accordingly, cases under relevant sections of law were registered at respective Police Station and further investigation is going on.

3 bootleggers arrested, illicit liquor recovered

REASI: Intensifying its action under drugs and illicit liquor, under the Nasha Mukht Bharat Abhiyan in district Reasi, teams of District Police under supervision of SSP Amit Gupta nabbed 3 bootleggers from Jyotipuram, Chassana and Tulli Banna and recovered illicit liquor from their possession.
As per details, Police Station Chassana received information that one Chain Singh, son of Lachman Singh, resident of Dandakote Tehsil Chassana, at present

Manjikote Tehsil Mahore is indulged in illegal business of preparing illicit (Desi) liquor at his house. Accordingly, a team led by SHO Chassana Parmodh Singh raided the house and recovered about 10 lts Lahan & utensils used for manufacturing illicit liquor. FIR No. 65/2022 under section 48 (A,D,E) of Excise Act was registered at Police Station Chassana and accused was arrested.
In another incident, a team from Police Post Jyotipuram led by PSI Rajat Sahni laid a surprise Naka near Jyotipuram and during checking, recovered 3 lts illicit (Desi) liquor from one Uttam Singh, son of Chajju Ram, resident of Bakkal, Reasi.
The accused was arrested on the spot and FIR No. 226/2022 under section 48 A of Excise Act was registered at Police Station Reasi. A team from Police Post Banna led by PSI Mayank Jamwal laid a surprise Naka near Banna area, apprehended a suspect namely Tasbir Singh, son of Kartar Singh, resident of Tulli Tehsil Chassana District Reasi. On search, 1.5 lts illicit (desi) liquor was recovered from his possession. Accordingly, FIR No. 66/2022 under section 48 A of Excise Act was registered at Police Station Chassana and investigation initiated. Meanwhile, Reasi Police also carried on Bhang destruction drives at Arnas, Mahore and Reasi areas, besides imparting awareness among people against drug menace.

Two narco-smugglers nabbed with 10 gm heroin

JAMMU: Continuing its drive against drug trafficking and substance abuse, Jammu Police has recovered 10 gm heroin at Partap Singh Pura (Lalyana) in Bishnah and arrested to drug-peddlers in this regard.
As per details, a team from Police Station constituted under the supervision of SDPO R S Pura Surinder Singh and led by SHO Bishnah Inspr Vikram Sharma, while on Naka duty at Partap Singh Pura (Lalyana), Bishnah rounded up two suspects, on vehicle (PB06AC9487). During search, 10 gm heroin was recovered from their possession. FIR No. 154/2022 under sections 8/21/22 of NDPS Act was registered at Police Station Bishnah and accused got arrested, who were later identified as Sahil Sharma, son of Kewal Sharma, resident of Keso Manhas, Samba and Amit, son of Bishan Dass, resident of Pakhari Keso Morh, Samba. Further investigation is going on. Police has urged people to come forward and share information about drug peddling or consumption on 9086100100 or 100 without any fear as their identity will be kept confidential.

5 vehicles seized for illegal mining

JAMMU: In a quest to stern the menace of illegal mining, a multi-pronged strategy was devised by Jammu Police in which police team of Police Station R S Pura, Police Posts Chinore and Kahnachak acted stringently on the specific inputs and raided at different locations in their respective areas besides seizing 5 vehicles involved in illegal mining.
The seized vehicles included a tractor-trolley bearing registration number JK02V 6682 seized by R S Pura police, 2 tractor-trolleys bearing Chassis Nos. MBNBG55AAKCP87625 and MBNBG55AAKCK82497, seized by Chinore police and 2 tractor-trolleys bearing Chassis Nos. MBNBG53AGMCM29091 and MBNBG55AENCE37198 seized by Police Post Kahnachak. DMO Jammu was also intimated about the same. The recoveries were made by SHO R S Pura Inspr Pawan Kumar, Incharge Police Post Chinore PSI Amit Singh and SHO Police Station Kahnachak Inspr Rahul Mahajan in their respective jurisdictions.

Notorious burglar arrested

Theft case solved; accused arrested, stolen cash recovered

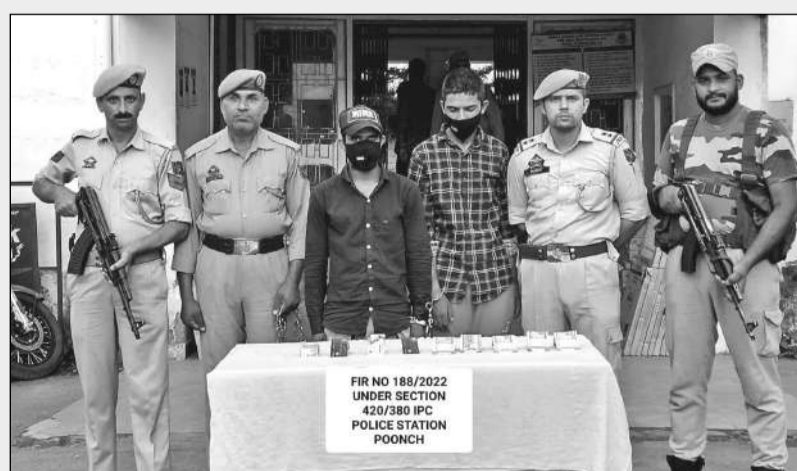

JAMMU: Police has solved a theft case by arresting the accused besides recovering stolen cash, amounting to Rs 1,10,000 from his possession.
As per details, a complaint was lodged at Police Station Janipur by one Amit Kumar, son of Sukhdev, resident of Punjab and presently staying at Shiwalikpuram, Janipur Jammu stating that some unknown thieves struck his office and decamped with Rs 1,50,000 cash. Accordingly, FIR No. 457/380 was registered at Police Station Janipur and investigation started. After this, dedicated teams from Police Station Janipur under the supervision of SDPO West Rahul Nagar were constituted. A team led by SHO Janipur Inspr Ajaz Haider, assisted by ASI Ghulam Mohi Din, after putting in strenuous efforts, rounded up a suspect namely Baljit Singh, son of Gher, PO Fatehpur, Pathankot who confessed his involvement in crime. He was arrested and on his disclosure, Rs 1,10,000 stolen cash and a iPhone was recovered. Further investigation is going on.

Youth arrested with sharp-edged weapon

R S PURA: A youth was arrested by Police with a sharp-edged weapon in R S Pura. He was arrested and FIR No 107/2022 under section 4/25 of Arms Act was registered at Police Station Miran Sahib. Further investigation is going on.

ATM fraud case solved; Rs 30,000 recovered, two accused arrested

POONCH: Police has solved an ATM fraud case and arrested two accused in this



regard. As per reports, a complaint was lodged at Police Station Poonch by one Mohd Jahngir, son of Fiaz Hussain, resident of Shahpur, stating that his ATM card of JK bank was swapped by two unknown persons, on the pretext of helping him to withdraw cash and thereafter Rs 40,000 was fraudulently withdrawn from his account. Accordingly, FIR No. 188/2022 under section 420 of IPC was registered and investigation started.
After putting in strenuous efforts and scrutinizing CCTV footage obtained from bank, a team from Police Station Poonch rounded up some suspects for questioning. Two suspects namely Mohd Shabeer, son of Zakir Hussain, resident of Mangnar and Sarfraz Ahmed, son of Sakhi Mohd, resident of Sakhi Maidan Mendhar were apprehended from Bus-stand Poonch, who during questioning confessed their crime and on their disclosure, Rs 30,000 cash was also recovered. Both accused were arrested instantly. The recovery and arrest was made by SHO Poonch Inspr Ranjeet Singh Rao assisted by PSI Rohit Kumar Bhagat under supervision of DySP Hqrs Poonch Nawaz Ahmed and overall supervision of SSP Poonch Rohit Baskotra.
