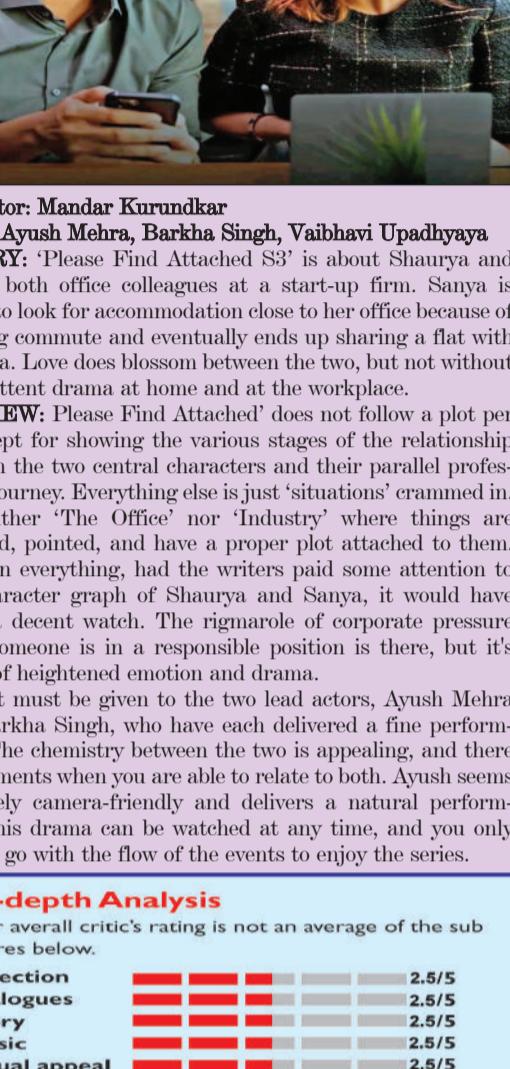

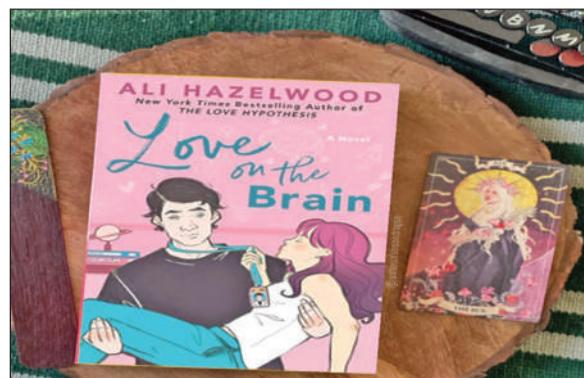

Review: The New York Times bestselling author of 'The Love Hypothesis', Ali Hazelwood, is back with another rom-com about scientists. Titled 'Love on the Brain', the new contemporary romance novel was published on August 23, 2022.

Set in the world of STEM, 'Love on the Brain' follows the story of Bee Königswasser- a neuroscientist, and Levi Ward- an engineer. Bee Königswasser has been through a rough phase in her personal life- her engagement was called off when she found out that her fiance was cheating on her. But now, Bee has finally got something to feel excited about as she is asked to lead a joint project between NASA and the National Institutes of Health to build better and newer technology for astronauts. But her happiness is short-lived as she gets to know that she is required to work with Levi Ward for the project.

Levi was her archenemy from grad school and the two have a long-standing rivalry. And when things start going wrong for Bee at work, she starts to wonder if it's Levi who is sabotaging her work. Light hues are open and airy, giving the impression that a space is bigger and brighter. Dark hues are elegant and cosy, and they make vast rooms appear more intimate," says Gupta.

Here are a few colours and what they suggest

Black: It is the strongest, most mysterious, most dramatic and sophisticated of all the colours. Mystery evokes a sense of potential and possibility, associated with power, elegance, and formality.

Blue: It is a favourite colour for most people. It's nature's colour for water and sky. It gives a sense of cooling and builds confidence. Blue is complex and contradictory. The majority of blues express a feeling of loyalty, cleanliness, trust, and understanding. On the other hand, blue also represents depression. It is said to bring down blood pressure and slow heart rate and respiration. Because of this, it is seen as tranquil, relaxing, and serene and is frequently suggested for bedrooms. Be careful, a pastel blue that looks pretty can come across as unpleasantly chilly when it is on the walls and furnishings, especially in a room that receives little natural light. To encourage relaxation, consider warmer blues, bright blues, cerulean or turquoise.

Brown: It is the colour of the earth and can mix into any surroundings. It gives a feeling of solidity and allows one to stay in the background. It conveys a sense of stability and enables one to blend in.

Green: It is universally associated with nature. It symbolises ecology and the environment. It is soothing, restful, and relaxing mentally as well as physically. Helps alleviate depression, nervousness and anxiety. It provides a profound sense of fresh-



ness, restraint, and harmony. Relates to meditation and higher self and is very creative. Green is a colour that works well in practically any room in the house because it combines the reviving qualities of blue and the cheeriness of yellow. While it is relaxing, it is also warm enough to foster cosiness and companionship. It is thought to reduce tension by promoting relaxation. It is an excellent choice for the bedroom because it is said to aid in conceiving.

Neutrals: These are basic to the decorator's tool kit. All-neutral strategies are fad and vogue, but their strength is adaptability. To liven things up, add colour; to calm them down, take them away. Every room, according to experts, needs a little bit of black to anchor the colour scheme and give it depth.

Orange: In nature, it's the colour of vivid sunsets, fire, vegetables, and flowers. It represents life, vitality, cheer, adventure, warmth, and excellent health. It also represents energy and is serene and rejuvenating. Orange is a vibrant colour that conjures up feelings of excitement and vigour. It will help you bring out all the feelings you need to release. Orange was thought to improve energy levels and heal the lungs in prehistoric cultures.

Purple: Purple in its darkest values is rich, dramatic, and sophisticated. It has both a luxurious and creative connotation, and when used as an accent or secondary hue, it provides the depth of a design scheme. It uplifts and calms the mind and the body. The same calming effect that blue has on bedrooms is achieved with lighter shades of purple, such as lavender, and lilac, without the risk of feeling frigid.
