The beneficiaries, whose houses have been completed and inaugurated by the

DDC, include Mohammad Fayaz, son of Mohammad Din, and Mohammad Aijaz, son of Mohammad Din. They expressed their gratitude to the Government for providing them pucca houses under the scheme and appealed to the Government to continue such initiatives for the welfare of the poor and needy. Later, the Deputy Commissioner chaired a meeting of the concerned officers to review the implementation of the Scheme in all Urban areas of the district.

The meeting was attended by ADC Nowshera, Kartar Singh; CPO, Mohammad Khurshid; ACR, Imran Rashid Kataria; EOs and other concerned officers.

## BLOs imparted training on Special Summary Revision

RAMBAN: A day-long training program on Special Summary Revision and SVEEP activities was held on Tuesday for Supervisors and Booth Level Officers (BLOs) of Ramban and Banihal Assembly constituencies here at Conference Hall Maitra.

As many as 400 officers/officials attended the daylong program in two sessions.

Interacting with the participants, Deputy Commissioner, Ramban, Mussarat Islam, who is also the District Election Officer, said that the ECI has initiated varied measures to fine-tune the electoral rolls for which ERO-NET is being used to make error-free voters list, besides lessening the paper-work as correct forms filled at the entry-level will be accepted through the system.

Dy. District Election

Officer, Lal Chand, and Resource Person, Akhlak Ahmed explained the processing of prescribed forms under the Special Summary Revision. Explaining the updating of the data, they said that the Form 6 is meant for registering as Elector/Voter, Form 6b for seeding of Aadhar number by existing electors, Form-7 for deletion, and Form 8 for correction/ shifting of voters and process on ERO-NET by respective BLO. They also explained the role of supervisors and BLOs in checking the prerequisite formalities before processing the prescribed forms.

The participants were also explained about various steps involved in the ERO NET including the online processing of forms. During the training, an interactive session was also conducted to clear the doubts of participants.

Regarding SVEEP activities, the Dy. DEO asked the BLOs concerned to undertake the task of spreading awareness along with the current Special Summary Revision exercise. Among others, Additional Deputy Commissioner, Harban Sharma, EROs, AEROs, Supervisors, BLOs of AC-54-Ramban and AC-55 Banihal, besides Election Naib Tehsildar Mohan Lal attended the training programme.
