- Availability of Bid Document and mode of submission: The bid document is available online and bid should be submitted online on website <https://www.pmgstendersjk.gov.in>. The bidder would be required to register in the website which is free of cost. For submission of bids, the bidder is required to have valid Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) from one of the authorized Certifying Authorities (CA). "Aspiring bidders who have not obtained the user ID and password for participating in e-tendering in PMGSY may obtain the same from the website: [www.pmgstendersjk.gov.in](https://www.pmgstendersjk.gov.in). Digital signature is mandatory to participate in the e-tendering. Bidders already possessing the valid digital signature issued from authorized CAs can use the same in this tender.
- Bids must be uploaded along with scanned copy of cost of Tender Document as mentioned in column 3 in shape of e-challan/ treasury challan/ receipt favouring Accounts Officer to Executive Engineer PMGSY Division Mahore by crediting the requisite charges to MH 0059-PWD (Revenue) and Scanned copy Earnest Money/Bid security should be in the form of CDR/FDR/BG from scheduled commercial Bank as mentioned in Column 8 of above table in the form as specified in the Bidding Document. The Bid security for the schemes listed shall be pledged in favour of Executive Engineer PMGSY Division Mahore payable at Mahore and shall be valid for minimum 45 days beyond the validity of bid as referred to in the Appendix to ITB.
- The original documents, when submitted by L1 for the cost of tender document, Bid security declaration form should be same as uploaded online (scanned copies) otherwise the allotment will not be issued. The tenders will be cancelled and the bidder will not be allowed to participate in any further/ future tendering process in PMGSY for a period of one year.

The technical qualification part of the bids will be opened online at 10 A.M on 26-09-2022 by the authorized officers. If the office happens to be closed on the date of opening of the bids as specified, the bids will be opened online on the next working day at the same time. The date and time of opening of Financial Bids shall be notified on website <https://pmgstendersjk.gov.in>. This is conveyed to the bidders automatically through an e-mail message on their e-mail address. The Financial-bids shall be opened accordingly online on same website at the Office of the Executive Engineer, PMGSY Division Mahore.

Subject: Disposal of representation of Dr Taseen Gul regarding select list of Assistant Professor (Bio-Technology).

## Notice

Dated: 13.09.2022

Whereas, on the requisition of Higher Education Department, 10 posts (OM-07; RBA-01; SC-01, ST-01) of Assistant Professor in the discipline of Bio-Technology were notified vide Notification No.IO-PSC (DR-P) of 2017 dated 27.10.2017. In response, 333 application forms were received, and after scrutiny, 30 eligible candidates including Dr Taseen Gul were called for interview which was conducted w.e.f. 20.09.2021 to 21.09.2021, with the assistance of subject matter Experts from outside the State (now UT); and,

Whereas, the provisional select list was issued vide Notification No. 84-PSC (DR-S) of 2021 dated 03.11.2021, inviting objections, if any, from the candidates; and,

Whereas, after the notification of the select list, primarily it came to the notice of the Commission that three candidates including one provisionally selected candidate, namely, Mr. Asif Amin has inadvertently been awarded points for JRF at the time of shortlisting when they were not in possession of the CSIR-UGC JRF certificate; and,

Whereas, this inadvertent mistake meant change in the merit for three candidates two in OM category and 01 in SC category; and,

Whereas, the candidates in OM category, namely, Mr Pankaj Sharad (short listed for interview) and Mr Asif Amin (selected candidate) were deleted from the shortlisting as well as interview notice. However, the third candidate, namely, Ms Usha Kiran (selected under SC category), was still within the cut of merit even without JRF points; and,

Whereas, in consequence to above, a revised select list for OM category was issued vide Notification No. 84-PSC (DR-S) of 2021 dated 03.11.2021, wherein Mr Asif Amin was deleted and in his place, the candidate next in merit was selected; and,

Whereas, the applicant filed an OA No. 430/2022 before the Hon'ble Central Administrative Tribunal Srinagar. The Hon'ble CAT while considering the matter vide its order dated 18.05.2022 directed as under:

"Meanwhile, the respondents are directed to dispose of the pending representation of the applicant".

Whereas, in her representation the applicant has alleged that some candidates have been given weightage for conferences and publications, when they do not have any such publications/conference attendance. However, the allegations have been made without any supportive evidence. The applicant has not even mentioned any specific name, as such, the allegations are vague and without proof; and,

Whereas, as regards, her allegation that her conference points and teaching experience have not been counted, it is stated that she had submitted 05 International conference papers at the time of interview, out of which 04 have been accepted. Besides, she had also submitted one National conference paper which has also been accepted, and for both the conferences she has been awarded 2.25 points. Assuming but not admitting that even her 5th international paper is also accepted she would be entitled to 0.5 additional points which could make her grade 61.95 i.e. still less than the last selected candidate. As regards the counting of teaching experience is concerned, she had submitted 02 experience certificates related to the period 09.11.2016 to 31.03.2017 and 10.04.2017 to 31.12.2017. The total experience comes to 01 year, 01 month & 19 days, for which 01 point has been awarded to the applicant (petitioner). Thus, the allegations that conference & teaching experience have not been counted is also baseless; and,

Whereas, as regards the allegation that candidates who did not possess JRF have been given weightage, it is to state that due to an inadvertent error some candidates who did not possess the JRF were shortlisted. However, as soon as the mistake was noticed, the same was rectified and only such candidates who fulfilled the eligibility criteria were recommended for appointment to the Government; and,

Whereas, the candidate has also filed application seeking information under RTI Act 2005 which has been disposed off and the relevant information stands provided.

Now, therefore, in compliance to the orders of the Hon'ble Central Administrative Tribunal dated 18.05.2022 passed in OA No. 430/2022 titled Dr Taseen Gul Vs UT of J&K, the case has been examined and found that the applicant has failed to make it to the select list as she has secured 61.45 marks, whereas, the last selected candidate, under OM category had secured 62.08 marks. Therefore, the applicant's prayer for re-conducting the interview by cancelling the select list cannot be accepted. Hence, the claim of the applicant being devoid of any merit is hereby rejected.
