On the basis of the results of the J&K Prosecuting Officer (Main) Examination, 2021, held by the J&K Public Service Commission from 14.02.2022 to 24.02.2022, the candidates with Roll Numbers as per Annexure-A to this notification have qualified for Personality Test for selection to the post of J&K Prosecuting Officer (G) in Home Department.

Candidature of these candidates is provisional subject to their being found eligible in all respects. The candidates who are not able to download e-Summon Letter for Personality Test, should immediately contact at the J&K Public Service Commission office, Jammu/Srinagar. No paper Summon Letters will be issued for the Personality Test/Interview by the Commission. The date and time of Personality Test will not be intimated to the qualified candidates individually.

No request for change in the date and time of the Personality Test intimated to the candidates will be entertained.

At the time of filling up of application forms for J&K Prosecuting Officer (Main) Examination, 2021, all the particulars were not obtained from the candidates who qualified for J&K Prosecuting Officer (Main) Examination, 2021. Accordingly, all the candidates, who have qualified for Personality Test (Interview), are required to fill up the Detailed Application Form (DAF), forming Annexure-B to this notification and same is to be submitted at J&K Public Service Commission office at Srinagar/Jammu by or before 23.09.2022, in person, to the Assistant/Deputy Controller of the Examinations who are hereby designated as the Nodal Officers for the purpose.

No request for any type of change/modification of information already supplied in DAF would be entertained by the Commission.

The marks sheets of all the candidates who appeared in the J&K Prosecuting Officer (Main) Examination, 2021, will be put on the Commission's Website i.e. [www.jpsc.nic.in](http://www.jpsc.nic.in) within one month from the date of publication of the final result and will remain available on the Website for a period of 30 days.

JAMMU: Kashmiri Pandit Sabha (KPS) Jammu convened a meeting on Wednesday to observe Martyrs Day on death anniversary of Tika Lal Taploo, who was martyred by terrorists in Srinagar; 33 years back. A number of members of the Sabha led by its President, K K Khosa expressed utter disappointment over the fact that despite of passage of three decades, conditions in Kashmir are still not conducive for return and rehabilitation of Kashmiri Pandits. The members passed a condolence resolution and vowed to make all efforts to fight for restoration of peace and harmony in valley so that Kashmiri Pandits can return to the valley and live there safely. Members also urged Government of India and UT administration to keep the issue of return and rehabilitation of the community on the front burner and create conducive conditions for dignified return and rehabilitation of KPs back in valley.

## Verma inspects afforestation, dev works in Chowki Choura

JAMMU: Commissioner Secretary Forest, Ecology and Environment, Sanjeev Verma, on Wednesday inspected afforestation and other development works in Chowki Choura belt of Jammu Forest division. He was accompanied by Director Social Forestry, Director Soil and Water Conservation, Chief Conservator Forests, Jammu, Conservator Forests East Circle, Divisional Forest Officers, Jammu and Social Forestry Jammu, Chairman, Block Development Council, Chowki Choura and other PRI members besides SDM and Tehsildar Chowki Choura. While interacting with Chairperson, Village Panchayat Plantation Committee, Chowki Choura and PRI members, Commissioner Secretary asked them to identify available common, community, Shamlat areas and their private land for raising plantation of short rotation hybrid species of Poplar and Eucalyptus which would yield good economic returns as many Plywood Industries are coming up in Jammu in coming days. He issued directions to the Department of Social Forestry to raise and distribute good quality hybrid clones of Poplar and Eucalyptus among the interested farmers of the area. He also asked for construction of more Check dams in the suitable locations as projected by various Sarpanchs of the area. While inspecting the afforestation work of Jammu Forest Division in village Shaura, Commissioner Secretary asked the concerned to cover more and more degraded area by planting local species as per prescription of working plan. Later, he planted saplings of Peepal and Bargad in CAMPA closure in Compartment number11/K at Shaura.

At Compartment number 38/K, Commissioner Secretary inspected felling of trees on forest land being diverted to BRO for construction of Road from Akhnoor to Poonch.

The Election Commission of India has ordered Special Summary Revision of Photo Electoral Rolls with reference to 01-10-2022 as qualifying date in UT of J&K w.e.f **15-09-2022 to 25-10-2022** for the UT of J&K. Accordingly, all the Kashmiri Migrants are hereby informed that the Commission has appointed three AEROs (Migrant) one each at Jammu, Udhampur and Delhi viz. Assistant Commissioner (Migrant) Jammu at Jammu, Collector Land Acquisition Northern Railways, Udhampur/Reasi at Udhampur and Deputy Director, Horticulture Planning and Marketing to operate from office of Resident Commissioner, JK House 5-Prithiviraj Road, New Delhi for facilitating the Kashmiri Migrants.

All migrants who are 18 years of age or above as on 01-10-2022 can get their names enrolled in the electoral rolls of their respective constituency by filing Form No. 6 used for registration of new electors, Form-7 used for objections to proposed inclusion/for deletion of name in existing electoral roll, Form-8 used for multiple purposes, viz; correction of any particulars in the roll, shifting of residence (within or outside Constituency), Replacement of EPIC, and Marking of person with disability and Form 6B used for capturing Aadhaar number of the existing electors.
