JAMMU: Senior social activist Sukesh C Khajuria has urged J&K administration to implement the Government order no. 43-HME of 2013 dated January 17, 2013, which bars private practice by the Heads of Departments of Government Medical Colleges and Dental colleges of J&K.

In a press statement issued on Monday, Sukesh said that despite Govt order, all HoDs are still practicing at the cost of health of the general public and administrative department is keeping a



blind eye towards the same. "Private practice by government doctors particularly senior doctors including Head of Departments has impacted healthcare adversely as common people are not getting adequate and specialised medical care as doctors encourage patients to get treated

form them privately in their clinics and private hospitals where they work," he added. He further asked the Government to ensure proper compliance of Government order banning private practice by HoDs and implementation of Chawla committee recommendations in letter & spirit for improving efficiency in hospitals. He urged LG Manoj Sinha, who is working tirelessly for upliftment of common public to take the issue on priority and issue necessary directions so that general public may not suffer anymore.

of oppressive orders & salary stoppages by DDOs. The employees appealed to LG Government for revocation of oppressive orders issued by Kashmir administration, forcing employees to join their duties back, especially by Sales Tax Department Kashmir, who has specially pin pointed PM package

employees. "Salaries of employees have been stopped by their DDOs, who are indirectly supporting terrorism," the members asserted.

"Kashmiri Pandit employees working in valley fled from Kashmir because of fear-psychosis and security concerns as 75 per cent families out of 5,000, who were provided jobs under Return & Rehabilitation Scheme were living there on rental basis. To raise our genuine demands, we started indefinite agitation from June 13, 2022 at Relief Commissioner's Office Jammu but nothing has been done for mitigating our sufferings," they added.
