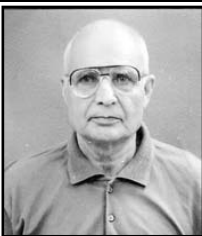

CRIME REPORT

3 drug-peddlers arrested, contraband recovered

SOPORE: Continuing its efforts to eradicate menace of drugs, police on Wednesday arrested three drug-peddlers and recovered contraband from their possession.

As per details, a party led by SHO Police Station Sopore under supervision of SDPO Sopore Furqan Qadir during checking at Butpora intercepted three suspects, who tried to flee but were apprehended tactfully. During checking, officers recovered 31 gm Brown Sugar like substance from their possession. They accused were identified as Mushtaq Ahmad Gazi, son of Ghulam Mohd, resident of Shahabad Sopore; Ajiaz Ahmad Ganie, son of Bashir Ahmad Ganie, resident of Hathishah and Zubair Ahmad Lone, son of Mohd Rafi Lone, resident of Khawaja Gilgat, Sopore. The accused were arrested and shifted to police station where they remained in custody. Accordingly, FIR No. 246/2022 under relevant sections of law was registered at Police Station Sopore and investigation started.

Abducted girl recovered, accused arrested

BARAMULLA: Police on Wednesday recovered an abducted girl within 6 hours by arresting accused person involved in crime. As per details, Police Post Palhallan received a complaint from a person stating therein that his daughter has been abducted by one Mohammad Afzal Chopan (Bilal), son of Gh Hassan Chopan, resident of Palhallan, Pattan. Accordingly, a case under relevant sections of law was registered at Police Station Pattan and investigation started. On receipt of information, SDPO Pattan Mohammad Nawaz Khanday constituted a team led by Incharge Police Post Palhallan. After putting strenuous efforts, Police recovered abducted girl and arrested accused from Hajin area of Bandipora. After completing all medico-legal formalities, the girl was handed over to her legal heirs. Further investigation of case is going on.

Three narco smugglers nabbed; 12 gm heroin recovered

JAMMU: Continuing its drive against drug trafficking and substance abuse, Police on Wednesday nabbed three narco smugglers at three different Nakas, viz Bagh-e-Bhour Park, Miran Sahib, Raipur Satwari and Valmiki Chowk and recovered 12 gm heroin from their possession.

As per details, a team of Police Station Miran Sahib constituted under supervision of SDPO R S Pura Surinder Singh and led by SHO Miran Sahib Inspr Zaheer Mushtaq rounded up a suspect who was coming from Gadigarh towards Bagh-e-Bhour Park on a motorcycle without registration number. During search, 5 gm heroin was recovered from accused, identified as Kishore Kumar alias Shunna, son of Banarsi Lal, resident of Bhour Kotha, Tehsil Gadigarh. The accused was arrested and FIR No. 118/2022 under sections 8/21/22/60 of NDPS Act was registered against him at Police Station Miran Sahib.

Similarly, teams of Police Stations Satwari and Gandhi Nagar, constituted under supervision of SDPO South Sachit Sharma led by SHO Satwari Inspr Sameer Jeelani assisted by PSI Saddam Hussain and SHO Gandhi Nagar Inspr Pankaj Sharma, laid special Nakas at Raipur Satwari Chowk and Valmiki Chowk under their respective jurisdictions and rounded up two suspects at above mentioned Naka points. During search, 7 gm heroin i.e., 4 gm heroin from Vikas Jaikhani, son of Late Maharaj Krishan Jaikhani, resident of House no 63, Lane-2 Muthi, was

recovered by Satwari Police while 3 gm heroin was recovered from Mukul Matto, son of Manga Matto, resident of H.No 119, Valmiki Colony by Gandhi Nagar Police. Duo was arrested and two different cases i.e., FIR No. 174/2022 under sections 8/21/22 of NDPS Act was registered at Police Station Satwari and FIR No. 241/2022 under sections 8/21/22 of NDPS Act was registered at Police Station Gandhi Nagar.

8 vehicles seized for illegal mining

JAMMU/KATHUA: In a quest to stern menace of illegal mining, a multi-pronged strategy was devised by Jammu Police in which teams of Police Stations Arnia, Domana, Gharota and Police Post Panjirthi acted stringently on specific inputs and raided at different locations in their respective areas and seized 6 vehicles involved in illegal mining. The seized vehicles included a tractor-trolley bearing Chassis No T052380728HE seized by Arnia Police; two tractor-trolleys without Registration number seized by Domana Police; two tractor-trolleys (JK02DA-6422 and JK02AX-0926) seized by Ghrota Police and a tipper (JK02CW-4533) seized by Panjirthi Police. The recoveries were made by SHO Arnia Inspr Sumit Sharma, SHO Domana Inspr Tilak Raj, SHO Gharota Inspr Rajesh Khajuria, Incharge Police Post Panjirthi PSI Rahul Sharma in their respective jurisdictions.

Meanwhile, a police team headed by Insp Sunil Sharma SHO Hiranagar under the supervision of SDPO Border Pankaj Soodan during Naka checking seized 2 tractor-trolleys found carrying illegal mining material without any permission. Both the vehicles were seized and immediately handed over to officials of Geological and Mining department Kathua for further legal proceedings.

Missing person traced, reunited with family

On this, a team of Police Station Satwari under supervision of SDPO South Sachit Sharma led by SHO Satwari Inspr Sameer Jeelani, after putting in strenuous efforts, recovered the missing person. Subsequently, family of missing person was informed and he was handed over to family members after completing all legal formalities.

14 bovines rescued, vehicle seized

The recoveries were made by SHO Jhajjar Kotli Inspr Samson Bhatti assisted by Incharge Police Post Manwal PSI Sanjeev Sharma under overall supervision of SDPO Nagrota Pardeep Kumar.

Snatcher arrested; gold chain, cash recovered

JAMMU: Police on Wednesday nabbed a snatcher and recovered stolen gold chain worth Rs 1,40,000 along with Rs 43,000 cash from his possession.

As per details, on September 16, 2022, a complaint was lodged at Police Station Gandhi Nagar by one Sagar Gupta, son of Chander Shekhar, resident of 104/105 Shastri Nagar, Jammu stating that two persons snatched his gold chain during

morning walk in Shastri Nagar and ran away. On this, FIR No. 234/2022 under section 382 of IPC was registered and investigation started. After this, a team of Police Station Gandhi Nagar under supervision of SDPO South Sachit Sharma led by SHO Gandhi Nagar Inspr Pankaj Sharma, after putting in strenuous efforts, rounded up a suspect namely Ashwani Kumar alias Patty, resident of Nanak Nagar. During sustained questioning, accused confessed his involvement in crime and on his disclosure stolen gold chain worth Rs 1,40,000 and Rs 43,000 cash was recovered.

Bus driver among two arrested with 45 Kg poppy straw

SAMBHA: Continuing its drive against narcotics smugglers, District Police Samba under overall supervision of SSP Dr Abhishek Mahajan, on Wednesday arrested two drug peddlers and recovered approximately 45 Kg Poppy-straw (Bhukki) like substance from their possession under jurisdiction of Police Station Vijaypur.

According to report, during routine Naka checking of a Volvo bus (UP17 AT 5594) coming from Jammu towards Chandigarh at AHMS Naka, Vijaypur, approximately 45-50 Kg poppy-straw like substance in 2 sacs were recovered from Dikki of bus.

The accused, identified as Gharu Ram, son of Om Parkash, resident of Bhour camp (driver) and Ashwani Kumar, son of Sham Lal, resident of Bhore Julian were arrested on the spot and contraband along with vehicle was seized. FIR No. 144/2022 under sections 8/15/29 of NDPS Act was registered against them at Police Station Vijaypur.



Jawan dies under mysterious circumstances
