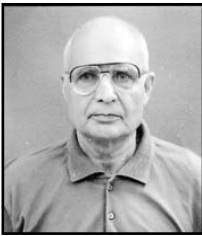

CRIME REPORT

8 injured as cab overturns in Rajouri

RAJOURI: Eight people got injured when a taxi-cab (Tata sumo), they were travelling in, skidded off the road and overturned in Rajouri district on Thursday.

As per details, a vehicle (JK11-8884), which was on its way to Rajouri from Buzfliaz, met with an accident near Magi Morh. Passersby immediately shifted injured to nearby hospital where condition of all is stated to be stable.

SDPO Thansamandi Dr Intiaz Ahmed along with police party visited the injured in the hospital. He confirmed that eight people suffered injuries in the accident and a case has been registered with the concerned police station while further investigation is going on.

Illicit timber seized

HANDWARA: Police on Thursday seized illicit timber at Bakihakar area of Handwara.

As per details, acting on specific input regarding illicit timber lying in premises of one Showkat Ahmad Sheikh, son of Gull Sheikh, resident of Bakihakar, a party from Police Station Handwara raided the location and seized approximately 13 cfts illicit timber. Accordingly, FIR No. 253/2022 under relevant sections of law was registered at Police Station Handwara and further investigation started.

2 LeT terrorists conspiring attack on security forces, civilians arrested

SRINAGAR: Two Lashkar-e-Taiba (LeT) terrorists were arrested by Sopore police after a joint cordon and search operation was launched by police, Rashtriya Rifles and CRPF in Botingoo village. LeT terrorists, namely Intiyaz Ahmad Ganai and Waseem Ahmad Lone, were arrested and a pistol, a pistol magazine, eight rounds and a Chinese hand-grenade were recovered from their possession, said a police official, adding, "During preliminary questioning, the duo revealed that they were working as hybrid terrorists and OGW (Over Ground Workers) for banned terrorist group - LeT. The two, at behest of active LeT terrorist Bilal Hamza Mir were planning to attack security forces and civilians in and around Sopore area." The arrest of two LeT terrorists comes a day after the State Investigation Agency raided several locations linked to a head constable arrested on fraud charges to ascertain if he was also involved in terror financing.

Man booked for kidnapping, raping minor girl

JAMMU: Police on Thursday nabbed a man from Uttar Pradesh (UP) who had kidnapped and raped a minor girl and later left her at Saharanpur Railway Station.

As per details, a complaint was lodged at Police Station Janipur by a person stating that his minor daughter went missing from her home.

Accordingly, FIR No 42/2022 under section 363 of IPC was registered and investigation started. After this, a team of Police Station Janipur under the supervision of SDPO West Rahul Nagar led by SHO Janipur Inspr Ajaz Haider, after putting in strenuous efforts and with help of CDR location of suspect, generated input regarding presence of suspect in UP. Finally, a special team of Police Station

Janipur led by PSI Anil Kumar traced the girl and arrested the accused namely Amar, son of Azhar Miyan, resident of Mohalla Sadar, Sahabad District Rampur (UP) from Sahabad. During further investigation, it came to fore that accused left the girl at Saharanpur Railway Station from where she contacted her family. After which, police team recovered her from Saharanpur and brought her to Jammu, where she was medically examined at Govt Hospital Sarwal, Jammu.

Subsequently, offences under section 376 of IPC, 3/4 of POCSO Act have also been added in instant case.

Woman drug-peddler booked under PIT NDPS Act

JAMMU: Police on Thursday booked a notorious woman drug-peddler under PIT NDPS case.

As per details, information was received through reliable sources at Police Station Satwari regarding a notorious woman drug-peddler namely Ravinder Kaur alias Neetu Bhabhi, wife of Iqbal Singh alias Vicky Langra, resident of Ward-1, Bhour Camp. On this, a team of Police Station Satwari under the supervision of SDPO South Sachit Sharma led by SHO Satwari Insp Sameer Jeelani along with a team of woman constables reached suspected place and arrested drug peddler. Finally, warrant under section 3 of Prevention of Illicit Traffic in Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (NDPS) Act of 1988 (PITNDPS) was executed and accused woman was shifted to District Jail Amphalla, Jammu after completion of all legal formalities.

CRPF Inspector among two die under mysterious circumstances

JAMMU: A CRPF Inspector among two persons died under mysterious circumstances on Thursday.

As per details, one Goverdhan Singh, resident of Haryana, posted at Group Centre Bantalab was found unconscious and was shifted to hospital, where doctors declared him as brought dead.

Meanwhile, a man was found dead in Sidhra area. Police was informed which rushed to the spot and shifted body to morgue for identification.

Youth attacked over rivalry, 2 arrested

JAMMU: A youth was attacked over an old rivalry on Thursday at Gho Manhasa, however police has arrested two accused.

As per details, Anshu Bagotra, resident of Gho Manhasa who was on his way to home, was attacked by a group with sharp-edged weapons over an old rivalry. In attack, he got injured and was shifted to hospital for treatment. On statement of vic-



tim, police has detained two accused identified as Rohit Singh and Sahil Singh. A case has been registered in this regard.

Rohingya booked for human trafficking

NAGROTA: Police on Thursday arrested a Rohingya who used to cheat people and bring them to Jammu. Apart from accommodating them, he used to make other arrangements for them also. A case of human trafficking has been registered against him. According to information, Nagrota police got information that a Rohingya has smuggled some people from Bangladesh after luring them to provide work and thereafter has kept them at different places. The matter was investigated by the police and accused was arrested, later identified as Shakhoo. Old Indian currency notes were recovered from him.

Woman among three die in mishaps

JAMMU: A woman among three persons dies in separate mishaps on Thursday. As per details, a man was hit by an unknown vehicle near Nonath bridge at Chouki Choura and was shifted to hospital, where he succumbed. His body has been kept in morgue for identification.

In another instance, one namely Rajesh Sharma, resident of Sunderbani died after he was hit by an auto in Dharamsal. Meanwhile, Vishnu Devi, wife of Babu Ram, resident of Manda, Akhnoor was also died after she was hit by a bike.
