CRIME REPORT

3 arrested, distillation unit seized; 27 lts illicit liquor, 17 quarters of whisky recovered; 320 lts Lahan destroyed

REASI: Continuing Nasha Mukht Reasi Abhiyan and intensifying drive against drug abuse and illicit liquor smuggling, teams of District Police Reasi under supervision of SSP Amit Gupta nabbed 3 illicit liquor smugglers and recovered 27 lts illicit liquor, 17 quarters of Whisky from their possession and destroyed 320 lts of Lahan besides seizing a distillation unit.

As per details, a team of Police Post Tote Sarhi led by ASI Baldev Singh under supervision of DySP Headquarters Iftkhar Ahmed during patrolling duty received information that one Jambal Ram, son of Amar Nath, resident of Sarote Kote, Mohra Gabber Tehsil Bhomag, District Reasi is indulged in manufacturing illicit liquor. Accordingly, a raid was conducted and a distillation unit along with 320 lts Lahan, 22 lts illicit liquor was recovered from possession of Jambal. Pertinent to mention here that Jambal, a history-sheeter of the area and notorious illicit liquor smuggler, is involved in many other cases and arrested on the spot. FIR No. 234/2022 under section 48 (a)(e) of Excise Act was registered at Police Station Reasi.

In another incident, a of Police Post Jyotipuram led by PSI Rajat Sahni intercepted a illicit liquor smuggler namely Kuldeep Raj, son of Suram Chand, resident of vilage-Saranapur, Tehsil-Bhomag, Reasi and recovered 5 lts illicit liquor from his pos-session. FIR No. 235/2022 under sections 48(a), Excise Act was registered at Police Station Reasi and investigation started.

In another incident, acting on a specific information, District Special Branch under supervision of SP Katra Amit Bhasin, a party of Police Check Post Balini intercepted and apprehended one Sanjay Kumar, son of Girdhari Lal, resident of Kadmal Tehsil Katra along with 17 quarters (250 ml each) of JK Special Whisky. FIR No. 260/2022 under sections 188 of IPC was registered at Police Station Katra.

23 bovines rescued, 4 smugglers arrested

REASI: Continuing drive against bovines smuggling in District Reasi, Police on FRIDAY arrested 4 bovine smugglers and rescued 23 bovines from their possession.

As per details, a team of Police Post Talwara led by PSI Sunil Singh and Insp Sunil Sharma SHO Reasi under supervision of DySP Headquarters Iftkhar Ahmed foiled a bovine smuggling attempt in Talwara area by arresting a smuggler namely Shubam Verma, son of Rattan Lal, resident of Kot Ghari, Tehsil and District Jammu while smuggling four bovines in a Tata mobile (JK 02 AP 0805). Theft case solved within 24 hrs; 3 arrested, stolen items recovered

BARI-BRAHMANA: Police on Friday worked out a theft case with arrest of 3 accused and recovered stolen items. As per details, on September 22, 2022, a com-plaint was lodged at Police Station Bari-Brahmana by complainant namely Swarn Krishan Kumar (owner of Tractor repairing shop), son of Milkhi Ram, resident of Tarore Patli, Morh, Tehsil Bari Brahmana, District Samba regarding theft of spare parts of generator and cylinder etc from his shop by some persons. Accordingly, FIR No. 177/2022 under section 457/380 of IPC was registered at Police Station Bari-Brahmana and investigation started. During investigation, a team of Police Station Bari-Brahmana led by SHO Bari Brahmana, Inspr Inderpal Singh under supervi-sion of Mohd Usman, DySP Hqrs Samba (Incharge SDPO Bari-Brahmana) after arduous efforts, developed some lead in case and succeeded in arrest of 3 suspects namely Vipan Sharma, son of Satpal Sharma; Deepak Sharma, son of Dev Raj Sharma, both residents of Patli Morh, Tehsil Bari Brahmana, District Samba and Amit Sharma, son of Kamal Kumar, resident Tarore, Tehsil Bari Brahmana, District Samba. On their disclosure, stolen items were recovered from the accused.

Thieves flee with Rs 3 lakh cash from scooty

JAMMU: Thieves on Friday fled with Rs 3 lakh cash from a scooty in Chakroi area of Tehsil R S Pura.

As per police, a complaint was lodged by a woman namely Asha Devi, resident of Rangpur Sidhra with Police Station R S Pura stating that some unidentified per-sons decamped with cash from her scooty, which she had parked in Chakroi area of Tehsil R S Pura. Acting over the complaint, FIR Number 180/2022 under section 379 of IPC was registered at Police Station R S Pura and investigation started.

Theft case solved; tractor-trolley recovered

KATHUA: In continuation to drive launched by District Police Kathua against active theft cases/vehicle-lifters in Kathua, the police achieved another success under overall supervision of SSP R C Kotwal by recovering a stolen tractor along with trolley.

As per details, on August 3, 2022, a complainant Maskeen Ali, son of Noor Mohd, resident of Domar Tehsil & District Kathua lodged a complaint at Police Station



Lakhanpur stating therein that during intervening night of August 1-2, 2022, thieves decamped with a Splendor Black Coloured Motor cycle which he has parked outside his house near Satwain. FIR No. 69/2022 under section 379/IPC was reg-istered at Police Station Lakhanpur and investigation started. During investigation, one Mohd Alkaz, son of Peer Mohd Shah, resident of Dungara was arrested. On his disclosure, a tractor along with Trolley was recovered by team of Police Station Lakhanpur while Kathua Police has launched a manhunt for other persons involved.

During investigation of FIR No. 69/2022 under section 379 of IPC of Police Station Lakhanpur, another tractor along with trolley, stolen from jurisdiction of Police Station Billawar made by Incharge Police Post Basantpur SI Sanjeet Singh, SHO Lakhanpur Insp Vijay Kotwal under guidance of DySP DAR kathua Sukhdev Singh. Pertinent to mention here that 3 motorcycles were also seized under sections 102 of CrPC in jurisdiction of Police Station Lakhanpur.
