
Shri Prem Nath Khan (Bhat), son of Late Shri Narayan

CRIME REPORT

3 shops gutted at Ganderbal

GANDERBAL: At least three were shops gutted in a massive blaze in Barosa village of Kashmir's Ganderbal district late last night. As per an official spokesperson, fire broke out from a shop in the area on intervening night of Sunday and Monday.

He said that soon fire spread and engulfed nearby shops, due to which three shops were gutted. On receiving information, fire tenders rushed to the spot and contained the fire to prevent further damage. The official further said that cause of fire is said to be due to an electric short-circuit, while police have taken cognizance of the matter.

15 bovines rescued, vehicle seized

KATHUA: In a major action against bovine smuggling, Kathua Police under overall supervision of SSP R C Kotwal against bovine smugglers has rescued 15 bovines besides seizing a vehicle near Rajlgah. As per details, a team led by Insp Amit Sangra SHO Police Station Rajlgah under the supervision of SDPO Border Pankaj Soodan, during Naka/Checking duty at NHW Rajlgah noticed a suspicious truck bearing registration number JK02ATP-6085 and signaled it to stop for checking. But on seeing Naka party, the driver fled away from spot leaving truck. During checking, 15 bovines were found laden in the truck, which were rescued. The vehicle was seized and FIR No. 192/2022 under section 188 of IPC, 11 of PCA was registered at Police Station Rajlgah.

6 arrested, 6 vehicles seized for illegal extraction, transportation of minerals

AWANTIPORA: Acting tough against elements involved in illegal extraction and transportation of minerals, Police in Awantipora has arrested 6 persons and seized 6 vehicles involved in crime. As per details, Police Station Awantipora received information about illegal extraction and transportation of minerals from river Jehlum at Padgampora Awantipora. Accordingly, a police party raided the spot and seized six vehicles (Dumpers) and arrested six accused drivers, who were identified as Manzoor Ahmad Dar, resident of Lathpura; Mushtaq Ahmad Bhat, resident of Patalbagh Pampore; Parvaiz Ahmad Bhat, resident of Patalbagh Pampore, Sajjad Ahmad Bhat, resident of Wouan Khrew; Ajaz

Ahmad Bhat, resident of Nilnag Chadoora and Bilal Ahmad Ganie, resident of Patalbagh Pampore. They were shifted to police station where they remained in custody. Accordingly, FIR No. 209/2022 under relevant sections of law was registered at Police Station Awantipora and investigation started.

Woman among three die under mysterious circumstances

JAMMU: Three persons, including a young woman, died under suspicious circumstances in different incidents at Jammu. As per details, 18-year-old Riya Kumari, daughter of Govinda, resident of Sheikh Basti of Bagh-e-Bahu, died under suspicious circumstances at her house. She was immediately taken to the hospital, where doctors declared her as brought dead. Police has taken body into custody for post-mortem to ascertain real cause of death. Meanwhile, a worker fell down from roof of an under-construction building at Govindpura Chatta.

He was immediately taken to hospital where he succumbed to injuries. The deceased was identified as Gurmel Singh, resident of R S Pura. Moreover, an elderly woman also died in a road mishap, when she got hit by an unidentified vehicle, while crossing road, in Trikuta Nagar.

Two thieves arrested, 7 stolen bikes recovered

JAMMU: Police has busted a gang of motoreycle thieves by arresting two thieves besides recovering 6 motor-cycles and a scooter from their possession in Miran Sahib area.

As per details, Police on September 17, received a complaint from a resident of Simbal area regarding theft of his motoreycle, after which a special team was constituted and two suspects were rounded up for interrogation. On questioning, they confessed their crime and on their disclosure, 7 two-wheelers were recovered. The accused were identified as Rohit Kumar, resident of Chak Salam, R S Pura and Manish Kumar, resident of Kir Pind.

Drug-peddler nabbed with 1 Kg Ganja

Supwal attack: One accused arrested, search for others continues

JAMMU: Police has arrested an accused in connection with attack on a youth in Sapwal area on Monday while search is on to trace other his other associates.

According to information, a youth namely Balvinder Singh, son of Harpal Singh resident of Randhawa Colony, Vijaypur was attacked by some youth with sharp-edged weapons in which his arm got completely amputated. He was then shot in leg also. The accused fled from the spot after attack. It was told that a dispute between two groups was going on for a long time due to which the youth was attacked.

Five arrested with country-made pistol

JAMMU: Five people were arrested during vehicle checking here on Monday after a country-made pistol and three sharp-edged weapons were found in their car, police said.

Amandeep Singh, Sagar Singh, Arun Singh, Ajay Singh and Ajay Partap Singh were in the car when it was stopped for checking at the Satwari chowk, a police spokesperson said.

He said a search of the vehicle led to the recovery of a countrymade pistol, two 7.62 mm live cartridges and three 'tokkas'.

All five were arrested and booked under relevant sections of the Arms Act, the official said.

Leopard captured after attacking elderly man in Reasi

JAMMU: A leopard which had ventured into a village and injured an elderly person was captured by a team of wildlife department in Reasi district on Monday, officials said.

Nasib Chand (70) was attacked and injured by the big cat while he was outside his house in remote Charjute Kotli Manotriyan village. However, he was rescued by the villagers who chased the leopard into a nearby forest from where it was later captured.

The injured villager was shifted to hospital, the officials added.

Grenade found in Poonch
