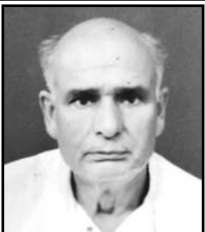

16 bovines rescued, vehicle seized

JAMMU: Acting tough against bovine smugglers, Police Station Nagrota rescued 16 bovines during Naka checking point at Ban Toll Plaza Nagrota from a vehicle (JK02CQ-9787). The vehicle was seized while the smuggler managed to flee from the spot. Accordingly, FIR No.346/2022 under sections 188 of IPC, 11 of PCA 50/52/54/56/Transport of Animal Rule Act 1978 Act was registered at Police Station Nagrota. The recoveries were made by SHO Nagrota Inspr Vishav Partap Singh under the overall supervisions of SDPO Nagrota Pardeep Kumar.

8 vehicles seized for illegal mining

JAMMU: In a quest to stern menace of illegal mining, a multi-pronged strategy was devised by Jammu Police in which police team of Police Station Domana, Police Posts Jourian, Chinore and Pargwal acted stringently on the specific inputs and raided at different locations in their respective areas and seized 8 vehicles involved in illegal mining. The seized vehicles included a tractor-trolley without registration number seized by Domana Police; two JCBs, four tractor trolleys without registration number seized by Jourian Police and a tipper (JK02CM 3790) seized by Chinore Police. Anjana was also in process of establishing a 'Sewa Niketan'- an old-aged home at Batote, which was allotted to them by Social Welfare Department, J&K UT. A staunch devotee of Guru Granth Sahib, Miss Harnam Kour Anand was a social, polite and helpful person always ready to help poor and needy people. She breathed her last on September 19, 2022 in a tragic road accident at Ramban. 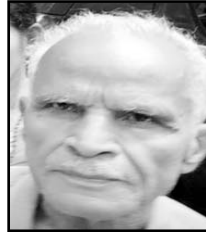

CRIME REPORT

Notorious female drug-peddler arrested

BANDIPORA: Continuing efforts to eradicate menace of drugs, Police on Wednesday arrested a notorious female drug-peddler.

As per details, Police arrested a notorious female drug-peddler namely Posha Begum, who was evading her arrest after she managed to escape on September 25, 2022 during a raid on house of one Khurshed Ahmad Waza alias Mandaila, resident of Ward-5, Bandipora. FIR No. 148/2022 under relevant sections of law was registered in Police Station Bandipora and investigation started. Keeping in view the sensitivity of matter, a special investigation team was constituted by SSP Mohd Zahid under supervision of DySP Hqrs Bandipora Shafat Mohd. Accordingly, different teams of Police Station Bandipora were deputed and after getting specific information regarding her presence in Bandipora, she was arrested from Nusoo area of Bandipora and produced before the Court for obtaining a judicial remand.

One arrested, vehicle seized for illegal extraction & transportation of minerals

BUDGAM: Acting tough against elements involved in illegal extraction and transportation of minerals, Police on Wednesday arrested a person & seized a vehicle in Budgam.

As per details, a party from Police Station Chadoora intercepted a dumper loaded with illegally extracted soil at Magraypora Chadoora, which was extracted from Government land at Magraypora. The driver was arrested and Dumper was seized on the spot.

The arrested driver was identified as Suhail Abbas Sofi, son of Ashiq Hussain Sofi, resident of Rakh Shalina Tengen. FIR No 162/2022 under relevant sections of law was registered at Police Station Chadoora and investigation started.

Narco smuggler arrested with heroin

RAJOURI: Police on Wednesday arrested a narco-smuggler and recovered heroine like substance from his possession. Intensifying its drive against drug abuse, Rajouri Police arrested a notorious drug peddler and recovered 16 gm heroin from his possession. A party headed by SHO Police Station Rajouri and assisted by Incharge Police Post City Danish Maqbool apprehended an accused namely Mohd Amir, son of Mohd Sharief, resident of Ward-2 Rajouri. During search, 16 gm heroin like substance was recovered from his possession. FIR No. 515/2022 under section 8(A)/21/22 of NDPS Act was registered at Police Station Rajouri and investigations started.

Hardcore criminal detained under PSA

SAMBA: In order to cheek activities of a hardcore criminal / drug-peddler namely Mohd Yousaf, son of Lal Hussain, resident of Manohar Gopala, Samba who is involved in a number of criminal activities and emerging as a threat to life and liberty of people, a special team of Police Station Samba under the supervision of Dy SP Hqrs Samba, Mohd Usman headed by SHO Police Station Samba, Inspr Deepak Jasrotia under overall supervision of SSP Samba Dr Abhishek Mahajan was constituted and the criminal was arrested. The accused is a habitual criminal and involved in a number of heinous cases registered against him at Police Station Samba and other Police Stations of District Kathua which include 7 FIRs registered at Police Station Samba including 3 in 2018; 1 in 2019; 2 in 2021 and 1 in 2022. Police Station Rajbagh, District Kathua 1 FIR (in 2018); Police Station Hiranagar, District Kathua 1 FIR (in 2022)

Keeping in view of his repeated involvement in criminal activities, a dossier was prepared by SSP Samba and forwarded to District Magistrate Samba who formally issued order of his detention under PSA.

The detention warrant was executed by a Police team headed by SHO Police Station Samba and the accused was lodged in District Jail Kathua. Pertinent to mention here that Samba Police is taking every possible step to eradicate drug menace from society under 'Nasha Mukht Bharat Abhiyan.'
